### VICTORY GALLOP SILENCES REAL QUIET'S TRIPLE CROWN BID

Sunday Silence was denied by Easy Goer in 1989. Touch Gold spoiled the chances of Silver Charm in 1997. All in all, six horses in the history of the Triple Crown have won both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness only to finish second in the Crown's final jewel. Make that seven. This year's victim was **Real Quiet** (Quiet American), who pulled away at the top of the stretch toward what looked to be certain victory, then lost it all when **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) closed furiously to pass him in the final stride of the mile-and-a-half event. It was the second straight year that trainer Bob Baffert brought a three-year-old into the Belmont with a chance to capture racing's elusive Triple Crown; both times his charges suffered heartbreaking defeats by less than a length. "I'm getting closer," Baffert said after the race. "Last year I lost by three-quarters of a length (with Silver Charm); this year by a nose. Maybe next year I'll win by daylight." Baffert added, "He ran a hard race, got tired at the end and ran out of gas. It's a letdown. You hate to lose like that. You had it; you were there. We all thought he was home free." Real Quiet's jockey Kent Desormeaux agreed. "It hurts a lot to have come so far," he said. "When you make the lead and there's no one coming, you taste victory. It's a tough pill to swallow." Always a bridesmaid, Victory Gallop finished second behind Real Quiet in both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness before finally making it to the 'altar' yesterday. The first Canadian-bred winner of the Belmont S. was saddled for the race by Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott, who was performing the duty as a favor to Victory Gallop's conditioner Elliott Walden, confined to crutches after breaking his ankle in a non-professional basketball game last Thursday. Walden said of Victory Gallop, "He turned the tables on Real Quiet today and I think it puts him on even footing. It's going to be good for racing to have these two hook up again. I'm looking forward to it." Walden said Victory Gallop will take a short break before pointing to the Aug. 9 Buick Haskell at Monmouth and the Aug. 29 Travers S. at Saratoga. "We feel like this colt possibly could be three-year-old champion if the rest of the year goes right," he added. Winning jockey Gary Stevens acted as the spoiler yesterday in Real Quiet's Triple Crown bid only one year after his own chances for Triple Crown glory aboard Silver Charm were narrowly denied. "My heart goes out to the connections of Real Quiet," Stevens said. "I know what it feels like. This is a bittersweet victory."

Victory Gallop posted strong late rallies in both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, only to finish second to Real Quiet on both occasions. Same tactics, different result this time. The 85-1 longshot **CHILITO** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) set soft early fractions of :23 3/5, :48 3/5, 1:13 2/5 and 1:37 2/5 on the front end, with a bevy of challengers, including Real Quiet, settling in behind him. Rounding the final turn and into the stretch, the Derby and Preakness hero soared to the front and opened a clear advantage. Meanwhile, Victory Gallop had bided his time during the first six furlongs, racing 10th in the 11-horse field. The eventual winner closed ground four-wide on the final turn, split rivals entering the stretch then closed like a freight train in the drive to grab victory in the final stride. A steward's inquiry was posted immediately following the race, as Real Quiet had twice drifted out in the stretch, bumping Victory Gallop. The stewards later issued a statement that said if the noses had been reversed at the finish line, "It probably would have warranted a disqualification. The judgement can't really be interpreted because of the Triple Crown. The facts speak for themselves." Winning trainer Elliott Walden said, "It's been a roller coaster. At the eighth pole I had flashbacks of Churchill Downs that we might not get there. I saw Real Quiet tiring and saw (jockey) Gary (Stevens) coming and I knew this horse was gonna give it all he had to try and get there."

**High-Rise (Ire)**, winner of the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial in his last start May 9, extended his unbeaten career record to four-for-four and his earnings to \$1,039,454. **SUNSHINE STREET** (**Sunshine Forever**), a 200-1 outsider, led the field at a fast pace from the gate and was still in front at the quarter mile mark. But **City Honours** quickly closed the gap while **High-Rise** was flying down the center of the track. At the eighth pole, **High-Rise** looked to have the race at his mercy, but **City Honours** quickened and the pair then raced neck and neck inside the final sixteenth of a mile, with **High-Rise's** jockey **Olivier Peslier** extracting every ounce from his mount (which later earned him a two-day suspension for excessive use of the whip) and gaining the decision. Winning owner-breeder **Sheikh Mohammed Obaid al Maktoum**, who is racing manager to the youngest of the four **Maktoum** brothers, **Sheikh Ahmed**, said, "To win a Derby is a wonderful thing. I'd like to thank the trainer and the jockey for their preparation of the horse and the **Maktoum** family for all their support." Winning trainer **Luca Cumani** added about **High-Rise**, "I knew he was in great shape and working well. We just let the others soak up the hype! But he is an unbeaten colt, who has never lost a battle in his life, and all credit to him. The (G1) **Budweiser Irish Derby** (at **The Curragh** June 28) is probably his next race." **Peslier**, who was race-riding **High-Rise** for the first time, became the first French rider to win the since **Yves Saint-Martin** on **Relko** in 1963. Runner-up **City Honours** is slated to meet **High-Rise** again in the **Irish Derby**. Jockey **Frankie Dettori** said of beaten 3-1 favorite **CAPE VERDI (IRE)** (**Caerleon**), who was attempting to become the first filly to win the race

since 1916, "She didn't handle the track and didn't stay the distance." Irish trainer **Aidan O'Brien**, fresh from his victory with **Shahtoush** in Friday's **Epsom Oaks**, suffered great disappointment this time, with none of his trio--**SECOND EMPIRE (IRE)** (**Fairy King**), **KING OF KINGS (IRE)** (**Sadler's Wells**) and **SARATOGA SPRINGS (El Gran Senor)**--factors at the finish, their cause probably not helped by a nightmare journey from Ireland on the morning of the race, with their flight delayed then diverted due to fog.

A five-time champion in the U.S. and Canada, **Chief Bearhart** closed out 1997 with back-to-back Grade I wins in the **Canadian International** at **Woodbine** and the **Breeders' Cup Turf** at **Hollywood**. After a second in the **Gill Elkhorn** at **Keeneland** in his '98 bow when he sat off a slow early pace, his connections entered a rabbit here, **SKYBOUND** (**Sky Classic**), to ensure a repeat wouldn't occur. **Skybound** led through the first three quarters while his stablemate sat last, but the champion made his move on the turn, had some trouble finding his footing, swung four wide turning for home, and wore down the leaders in the middle of the track. "(**Skybound**) really made the difference," said winning jockey **Jose Santos**. "We had a little trouble finding our stride and I was a little worried at the five-eighths pole because my horse was giving me his everything, but at the eighth pole I was pretty sure we were going to win." Trainer **Mark Frostad** said the **GI Sword Dancer** Aug. 15 at **Saratoga** would be next for **Chief Bearhart**.

**BELMONT STAKES DRAWS 80,162** Yesterday's attendance of 80,162 was the second largest in Belmont Park history and the largest since Canonero II failed to complete his 1971 Triple Crown sweep before 82,694. Yesterday's total commingled handle of \$50,168,550 was a New York record, surpassing the mark of \$46,719,629 set on last year's Belmont S. day. Including non-commingled sources, the total was a new record \$55,613,482. A new commingled record \$24,353,412 was wagered on the Belmont S., while an overall record of \$28,354,418 was established on "The Test of the Champion." Saturday's on-track handle of \$9,351,731 was the second largest in Belmont Park history and a new record for Belmont S. day. The record handle of \$10,577,736 was set on 1990 Breeders' Cup day. "We are extremely grateful for the incredible crowd support shown today for the Belmont Stakes, Belmont Park and the great sport of Thoroughbred racing," said New York Racing Association President and COO Terry Meyocks.

### HANUMAN HIGHWAY, HOT WELLS

**SCRATCHED FROM BELMONT** Yesterday's GI Belmont S. field was reduced to 11 runners after both Hanuman Highway (Ire) (Alzao) and Hot Wells (Go and Go {Ire}) were scratched from the race. Hanuman Highway developed a case of colic Saturday morning. "I got a call at about 3:30 this morning and I came right down here," said the gelding's trainer, Kathy Walsh, before the race. "Everyone's so upset, but it seems like he'll be alright. He tends to get so keyed up; that's probably how he got it. He is resting comfortably in his stall right now and we'll just keep a close eye on him." Hot Wells was scratched from the Belmont after New York State Racing and Wagering Board officials discovered that his owner, Michael Lasky, CEO of the Psychic Friends Network, was not licensed to race horses in the State of New York. Lasky was denied a license in 1982 on the grounds that he was a "professional tout," a ruling that was later upheld by the Supreme Court of New York. According to NYSWRB Chairman Michael Hoblock, Lasky had not reapplied for a license since that time and still had not done so by Friday afternoon when the Board informed him he would not be allowed to run the horse. "Based on the conversation we had with him, it seemed he was going to jump in here at 4 o'clock (yesterday) and play a chicken game with us or send his trainer in with a dummy license application and try

and get it done," Hoblock said. Lasky felt the Board purposely made the decision after working hours Friday so that he would not have time to take appropriate legal action. "I told everyone my intention of running this horse two weeks ago and then they wait until the 13th hour to do something," he said. For his part, Hoblock questioned why Lasky had not made earlier attempts to apply for a license, knowing he planned to run the gelding in the Belmont.

### ROCKINGHAM'S 1998 SEASON OPENS TODAY

Live racing action returns to Rockingham Park today. The Salem, New Hampshire track, which opened in June, 1906, will host a schedule of stakes which includes the GIII \$200,000 New Hampshire Sweepstakes June 20, the \$75,000a Rockingham Breeders' Cup July 5 and the \$75,000 Spicy Living S. Aug. 2. Rockingham will present live racing Mondays, Wednesday, Saturdays and Sundays at 1 p.m. and Friday nights at 7:30 p.m., through Sept. 20.

When asked where the filly will run next, winning owner Bob McBain replied, "We don't know where we're going. Right now, I could retire I'm so bloody happy. I don't have the money, but I'm happy." Primaly, last year's Champion Two-Year-Old Filly in Canada, set all the pace before being outfinished for the win.

A solid sprinter at three, Richter Scale won the GII Jerome H. at Belmont before finishing next-to-last in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, his only poor showing on the year. Transferred from Pat Byrne's barn to trainer Bill Mott's stable, he made his '98 debut in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. May 16, winning by a half-length. Going for another classic undercard victory here, he vied for the lead early, surrendered it to Kelly Kip down the backstretch, retook it on the turn and held off Trafalger nearing the wire. Kelly Kip, the favorite and winner of the Suffolk Breeders' Cup H. just last Saturday, had a burst of speed down the backside but tired to be third. Trainer Bill Mott said the July 5 (GII) Tom Fool H. would be next for the winner.

Coronado's Quest put his usual pre-race antics aside before this event, carrying his jockey Mike Smith to the track with nothing but business on his mind. The talented three-year-old, away from the races since his easy 2 1/2-length tally in the GII Wood Memorial at Aqueduct April 11 and recovered from the bruised foot that kept him out of the May 16 Preakness, pressed the pace early while saving ground, slipped through along the rail to take command leaving the turn then opened up on his six rivals to win like the 2-5 favorite he was. "This is a pretty good horse," understated winning trainer Shug McGaughey. "We just had some bumps in the road, and hopefully the bumps are out of the road. I think the (GII, \$150,000) Dwyer (at Belmont July 12) will be next. It was my plan when we missed the Preakness. Then, hopefully, the (Buick) Haskell (at Monmouth Aug. 9) and the Travers (at Saratoga Aug. 29)."
