BELMONT WRAP-UP GI Belmont S. winner **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) and runner-up **Real Quiet** (Quiet American) both came out of Saturday's race in fine shape. Trainer Elliott Walden said Victory Gallop will return to Kentucky Monday morning. "He'll get a rest, walk for a few weeks and graze a lot," Walden said. The colt may make his next start in Monmouth Park's GI Buick Haskell Invitational August 9 followed by the August 29 GI Travers at Saratoga. For the second straight year, trainer Bob Baffert saw the Triple Crown stolen out from under him at Belmont Park. "What got me through yesterday was my little Savannah, my four-year-old daughter," admitted Baffert Sunday. "When they finally put up the numbers, my wife said we lost. I said, 'Yeah, we lost.' And my daughter looked up and said, 'But Daddy, you still have me.' And she gave me a kiss." Baffert also still has Real Quiet who came out of his narrow Belmont defeat in good order. The Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner arrived at Churchill Downs yesterday morning and is in line for a vacation following his rigorous Triple Crown campaign.

KING OF KINGS RETIRED Following his last-place finish in Saturday's G1 Vodafone Epsom Derby from which he returned lame, the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas winner **King of Kings (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) has been retired. The three-year-old colt, who underwent knee surgery over the winter, aggravated the old injury, according to trainer Aiden O'Brien. "It is a recurrence of his old knee injury," said O'Brien. "The knee is quite bad and he was very lame (Sunday) morning and our vet John Halley has X-rayed him. It seems there is nothing that can be done. The problem seems worse than last year, so it's the end of his racing career." The colt retires with six wins from eight starts and earnings of \$511,881. A two-time Group 1 winner, he scored in the Aga Khan Studs National S. at two in addition to his classic win this year. No stud plans were announced.

Zainta (Ire) extended her unbeaten record to five-for-five and gave her owner-trainer-jockey team their second French Classic success of the season and their third win in the French Oaks in six seasons. The top two finishers lingered near the back of the field early, with Abbatiale (Fr) grabbing the lead and Zainta making her move on the outside at the three-sixteenths pole. At the eighth pole, Zainta appeared to take command, but Abbatiale would not give in and these two fought a great battle to the wire, with Zainta winning on the nod at the wire. The filly's owner, The Aga Khan, missed the race; he is on his honeymoon. Said winning trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre, "My main concern about Zainta was how fresh she might be, having already had three races this season. I prefer to come into big races with fresh horses. But this filly does the minimum in the mornings, saving her energy for the afternoons. She does so little at home that she fooled me last year and I ran her for the first time at Le Croise-Laroche (in the French provinces) because I was convinced she could not win in Paris. Zainta will now be rested and come back for the (G1) Prix Vermeille (at Longchamp Sept. 13) and the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Longchamp Oct. 4)."

Fiji (GB), beaten only once in her career, was undefeated in four 1998 starts coming into this effort, including victories in the March 21 GII Santa Ana H. and in her last outing, the April 18 GII Santa Barbara H. The bay filly, off a step slowly, raced near the back of the pack early, moved up four wide leaving the backstretch, ran down runner-up Kool Kat Katie (Ire) to take the lead at midstretch and inched clear late. "Her race was super," commented winning trainer Neil Drysdale. "She was very relaxed and she's getting more and more professional with each race. Onto the (July 4 GI) Beverly Hills--if the weights are okay."

Jersey Girl brought a perfect four-for-four sophomore season record into her first Grade I race here, including a win over Champion Two-Year-Old Filly COUNTESS DIANA (Deerhound) in the May 13 GIII Nassau County in her prior effort. The filly figured to renew her rivalry with the latter here, but the anticipated showdown never shaped up. Countess Diana took the lead away from the gate and held that lead for a quarter, but Jersey Girl took over there and never looked back under Mike Smith, widening through the stretch while Countess Diana came up short, finishing fifth. "With the outside post, Mike was allowed to sit, then her natural speed took over," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "She likes to train. She's a smart filly and a pleasure to be around. At this point, I'm not committed to a race, but I'd like to take the traditional route," he said, indicating the June 27 \$200,000 GI Mother Goose would be next. Said Bill Mott, trainer of Countess Diana, "I thought she was up for a better race than that. She had no real excuse. (Jockey Shane Sellers) wanted to go on, but didn't have any horse. I was looking for a big effort. I thought she'd done well since her last race."

Without a win since the G2 Prix Noailles in April of last year, Fragrant Mix (Ire) was always in command here, leading from wire-to-wire to beat stable companion Sibling Rival, who had come from the rear of the field in the stretch to finish well for second without looking a serious threat to the winner. Oa Baldixe (Fr), almost last entering the stretch, experienced traffic problems but once he got clear, finished to good effect for third. Roland de Longevaille, Jean-Luc Lagardere's racing manager, said, "Fragrant Mix will now be aimed at the (G1) Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud (1 1/4 miles June 28)."

FILLIES SHINE AT OBS UNDER-TACK SHOW

Juveniles selling at Tuesday's Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Annual June Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training and Horses of Racing Age took to the company's Florida track yesterday. Hip number 329, a filly by Marquetry--Flip the Bird (Storm Bird) and hip number 224, a filly by Vermont--Aby's Jet (Tri Jet) turned in identical quarter-mile works in :22 1/5. Honors for the fastest three-furlong breeze of the session went to hip number 45, a filly by Mercedes Won--London Bridge (Cassalera) who stopped the timer in :34 3/5. Three fillies turned in the fastest eighth-mile trial, working the distance in :10 3/5. They are: hip number 25 (Dispersal-Key to My Dream {Key to the Mint}), hip number 208 (Alydeed--Wellrann {Well Decorated}) and hip number 314 (Phone Trick--Duty Calls {Mr. Leader}). Among the older horses, **Ashikaga** (Forty Niner), selling as hip number 365, posted the fastest quarter-mile, getting the distance in :22. The four-year-old colt is a half brother to champion sprinter Rubiano (Fappiano). The June Sale begins at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday.

EPSOM DERBY WRAP UP Three of the first four finishers in Saturday's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom look set to renew their rivalry in the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh June 28. Of winner **High-Rise (Ire)** (High Estate {Ire}), trainer Luca Cumani said Sunday: "The horse has taken the race at Epsom very well and was in good form when led out for a walk this morning. The Irish Derby is his next target." The Godolphin team confirmed that the Irish Derby is also the target for runner-up **City Honours** (Darshaan {GB}). Racing manager Simon Crisford said: "He's run a fantastic race at Epsom. We were thrilled to bits with him." Of the disappointing 11-4 Derby favorite **Cape Verdi (Ire)** (Caerleon), Crisford said, "We will map out a program for her for the rest of the season, but I am sure she will step down in distance from now on. She was spot on yesterday, everything was right and she had been working well." Trainer Noel Meade confirmed that his Derby fourth, **Sunshine Street** (Sunshine Forever), the 150-1 outsider who led the field for a mile and a quarter, would seek his maiden win in the Irish Derby. The morning after a disappointing Epsom Derby for Aidan O'Brien, which forced the retirement of **King of Kings (Ire)** (see p.1), the trainer announced plans for his other two Derby runners: last year's Irish Champion Two-Year-Old **Second Empire (Ire)** (Fairy King), who finished eighth, and **Saratoga Springs** (El Gran Senor), who was 10th. "It looks like we ran Saratoga Springs too soon after the (May 31) French Derby (where he was fourth)," said O'Brien. "He was a bit flat (Saturday) and we will now give him a little break and possibly bring him back for the Irish Derby. It seems that Second Empire didn't stay the trip in the Derby, so we will revert to a mile or a mile and a quarter with him. The (G1) Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown (over a 1 1/4 miles July 4) is a possible target."

Once in the clear and balanced, he quickened well and drew away from his pursuers for the victory. Winning trainer Pascal Bary said, "Silic will probably have a break now and then return at Deauville in August for the (G1) Prix de Maurice de Gheest (over 6 1/2 furlongs August 9) or the (G1) Prix Jacques Le Marois (over a mile August 16) or both."
