**MARYLAND MATCH RACE PROPOSED** Maryland Jockey Club President Joe DeFrancis has confirmed that he has a proposed a \$2 million match race between champions **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) and **Skip Away** (Skip Trial). However, according to DeFrancis, the Silver Charm camp has expressed no interest in such a show-down. "I've talked casually with the connections of both horses about it and I think that the Skip Away people are very interested in it, but trainer Bob Baffert is concerned about running Silver Charm in the heat in the summertime. At this stage, I don't think there's much likelihood that it's going to happen." The proposed race would be run in late July at Laurel Park. Meanwhile, an Internet site reported yesterday that Hollywood Park was trying to put together a match race between the same two horses, but Hollywood's Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer R.D. Hubbard denied the report. "We haven't talked to anybody," Hubbard said. "The first I knew about it was when someone showed it to me on the Internet." Meanwhile, back on the race track, Skip Away, aiming towards the June 28 G1 Hollywood Gold Cup, had his first workout since his win in the May 30 GIII Massachusetts H. yesterday, going four furlongs in :46 4/5 over the main track at Belmont.

### WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

The successful combination of Sadler's Wells and Fairy King over mares carrying Never Bend (giving a duplication of the mare Lalun) is one of the best known of the recent era. It is becoming increasingly clear that the reverse can work quite well too. **Silic (Fr) (c, 3, Sillery--Balletomane {Ire}, by Sadler's Wells)**, winner of the G3 Prix de la Jonchere, is by a sire who carries Never Bend and is out of a Sadler's Wells mare. There have already been at least four other stakes winners bred on this pattern, including Group 1 winner Medaaly and group winner Rouquette.

Unusual inbreeding appears in the pedigree of **Julie Zen (f, 3, Cartwright--Zentoo, by Zen)**, who took Sunday's Lawdy Miss Clawdy S. at Sportsman's Park. She has Bold Ruler and his brother Nasco 4x4 through a son and a daughter. Three-year-old Julie Zen is from the first crop by her sire, the unraced Cartwright. Cartwright is a son of Forty Niner, and with Forty Niner freshman sons Twining, Tactical Advantage, End Sweep and Marked Tree all having juvenile winners already, things are looking promising for sons of Forty Niner.

Usually close, but rarely a winner, Tsukuba Symphony (GB) finally managed a victory as the 5-2 favorite in his third start this year. Unplaced in his last start of 1997, the G1 Japan Cup, he ran third in his 1998 debut at Nakayama April 18th, and improved to second last time out at Tokyo May 2. The winner sat second for most of the race before challenging inside to score by a neck.

On his third start of the season, Tumbleweed Ridge (GB) secured his fifth lifetime win from 26 starts and his first Group race success while denying Wizard King (GB) his second straight win in this race and his fifth Irish Group race success. The runner-up had not run since finishing fourth in December's G2 International Bowl at Sha-Tin in Hong Kong, and the receipt of seven pounds from the race-rusty Wizard King undoubtedly contributed to Tumbleweed Ridge's success. Leading from the gate, he was strongly challenged by Wizard King from the three-eighths pole, but gradually asserted command inside the final eighth of a mile to win by a length. This was a first Group race victory for winning trainer Brian Meehan in his native Ireland.

**Victory Note (Fairy King),** winner of the G1 French 2,000 Guineas at Longchamp, May 10, has been supplemented to run in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot next Tuesday, June 16. Victory Note skipped the G1 Irish 2,000 Guineas at The Curragh May 24 after his owners decided only to be represented by the eventual third-place finisher **Second Empire (Ire)** (Fairy King). Trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam said, "I wasn't disappointed to miss the Irish 2,000 Guineas as it gave us more time to get him ready for this. It will be a tough race, but we are as ready as we will ever be." The supplementary fee will cost connections \$32,525.

Trainer Ian Balding has announced that **Border Arrow (GB)** (Selkirk), third behind **High-Rise (Ire)** (High Estate {Ire}) in last Saturday's Epsom Derby, will have England's final Classic, the G1 Pertemps St. Leger S. at Doncaster September 12, as his long-term target. Balding said, "He is fine but we will not run him again until the (G2 Stakis Casinos) Great Voltigeur S. at York August 18. He is having a nice rest at the moment before a possible crack at the St. Leger later in the season."
