SILVER CHARM FOILED BY 'AWESOME' FOE It was to be a perfectly choreographed event; bring together former Derby-winning owners, trainers and jockeys for Kentucky Derby Alumni Day at Churchill Downs and, as the culmination of the celebration, unleash last year's winner against six seemingly overmatched foes in yesterday's GII Stephen Foster H. **Silver Charm** (Silver Deputy) seemed more than up to the task after a season which had been pure perfection with wins in the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup and GII Strub S. at Santa Anita and a heart-stopping victory in the March 28 \$4 million Dubai World Cup. Rested since, but with a pair of bullet works over the Churchill strip to prepare him, last year's Derby winner and champion three-year-old was sent off the overwhelming 2-5 choice by the 19,095 on hand but, after taking the lead at the top of the stretch, he was unable to withstand the charge of **Awesome Again** (Deputy Minister) in the final sixteenth of a mile while conceding 14 pounds to his rival. "We have no excuses," said jockey Gary Stevens. "I saw a flash inside the sixteenth pole and I knew we were history. (Trainer) Bob (Baffert) had said all week long that the horse was going to be short. He didn't have him all the way cranked up." Baffert conceded that was true. "I knew he was vulnerable," said the trainer. "He is big and heavy and he was giving a lot of weight." The winner is a Canadian-bred who took a leg of his native country's Triple Crown at three, the G1C Queen's Plate. While trainer Pat Byrne said he hated to disappoint the fans who had come out to see Silver Charm, the time to strike was ripe. "I'm always sorry to see Silver Charm and horses of his caliber lose," said Byrne, "but if we were going to beat him I thought it might be when he was coming off a layoff. Our horse was fresh and he had a good race under his belt over this track." Byrne, who also trains '97 Belmont Stakes winner Touch Gold is looking down the road to their next start at Churchill, the Nov. 7 \$4 million Breeders' Cup Classic. "You can tell them all that Touch Gold's trainer will have two for the Classic," said Byrne. Baffert, for one, will be waiting. "It takes (Silver Charm) a few races to get going," he said. "In November, he'll be sleek and fit."

The winner of last year's Queen's Plate at Woodbine as well as the GII Jim Dandy at Saratoga for trainer David Hofmans, Awesome Again took the winter off after beating just one horse in the GI Super Derby at Louisiana Downs Sept. 28 in his final '97 outing. His four-year-old return was an impressive one, a seven-length allowance score at Churchill May 22 in his first start for trainer Pat Byrne, and the effort proved to be just what he needed to upset last year's three-year-old champion. Both Awesome Again and Silver Charm sat off the early leaders, with Silver Charm's rider, Gary Stevens, making the first move, sending his colt for the lead turning for home. The pair gained the advantage near the eighth pole, while Awesome Again was sent after him up the rail. As Silver Charm began to tire and Awesome Again drifted out a bit, the pair brushed briefly in the final sixteenth, with the winner proving just too much for the runner-up. "In the final sixteenth, it seemed like Silver Charm was going to make a race of it," said winning rider Pat Day, "but my horse really asserted himself." Said Byrne of the winner, "We'll definitely go to Saratoga with this horse. We want to get a Grade I for him now." Said losing rider Gary Stevens, "We have no excuses. The race shaped up a lot like we thought it would. My horse accelerated for me well coming into the stretch. I just got outrun." Semoran bobbled 70 yards from the wire, pulled up lame in his right front just past the finish and was vanned off the track. X-rays revealed a ruptured right front flexor tendon and he was placed in a Elastakan cast. "He is doing fine," said Bob Baffert's veterinarian, Doug Berry. "He is standing on all fours. We'll know a little more soon."

A Grade I winner on the turf, Subordination had a 2-for-5 record on the dirt coming into this race and had run away with the GIII Fort Marcy H. when it came off the grass at Aqueduct May 9, winning by eight lengths. Sent right to the front once again here, the bay was shadowed early by Sir Bear, winner of the GIII Excelsior Breeders' Cup H. over a wet-fast track last out, but shook loose at the top of the stretch and drove home to take his second straight graded stakes. "This horse just absolutely loves the slop and he proved today that he's legitimate," said trainer Gary Sciacca. "I knew that there were other horses in here with a lot of speed, but I felt that we were quicker...and I told (jockey Eibar Coa) to get to the lead and take it from there. This horse has done everything right for us." Sciacca said the GII Suburban H. July 4 could be next. The 3-1 favorite, ACCELERATOR (A.P. Indy), third in the GI Met Mile, trailed the field for six furlongs, but rallied late to get fourth.

Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile cont.

The winner of three graded stakes since shipping to the U.S. last fall, **Hawksley Hill (Ire)** (Rahy) warmed up for the Shoemaker with a win at this distance in the GII San Francisco Mile at Golden Gate May 23 as the 6-5 favorite. He should start the clear choice again here. Stablemate **Labeeb (GB)** (Lear Fan) has made just nine U.S. starts since his arrival in 1995 but, despite suffering from both physical and behavioral problems, has earned a quartet of graded stakes wins in that time, including the 1995 GI Hollywood Derby and the 1996 GII American H., both over this course. He comes off a win in Santa Anita's San Simeon H. April 18.

In response to a lawsuit filed against Gulfstream Park by Alan Quartucci, the managing partner of Gold Spur Stable, whose Devil's Cup broke down in the 1997 Fort Lauderdale H. at the track, Gulfstream has filed a third-party lawsuit against that horse's trainer, John Kimmel, in the 17th Circuit Court in Broward County, Florida. The suit, which would seek damages from Kimmel if the track is found liable in the incident, contends that when Kimmel signed his stall application blank, he relieved the track of any liability concerning Devil's Cup, who was euthanized October 23 due to complications related to the accident. Gold Spur Stable, through Quartucci, filed suit against Gulfstream March 11, claiming the track was negligent with respect to the condition of its turf course the day Devil's Cup was injured. Gulfstream's suit contends that Kimmel "...knew or should have known of the conditions of the track, and as a trainer, made a decision to permit Devil's Cup to race in the 11th race at Gulfstream."
