\$3 MILLION POT FOR HOLLYWOOD

PICK SIX The pool for yesterday's \$1 million guaranteed Hollywood Park Pick 6 grew to \$3,342,371 by the time the bet closed, a record Pick 6 pool for the track. It not only broke the single-day mark, but also surpassed the multiple-day record of \$3,209,796, set with a three-day carryover June 2, 1996. Available in 37 states (with New York the notable exception), the bet combined the fifth through 10th races at Hollywood. The winners of the first five legs were from 2-1 to 4-1; there were 35 winners after the final race, a maiden special weight event, was won by first-time starter **Bimbo's Kiss** (Aksar), off at 26-1 despite Gary Stevens' presence in the saddle. Each winning ticket paid \$53,357.60. "We were very pleased with the promotion," said Hollywood General Manager Euall Wyatt. "It created excitement nation-wide. Hopefully it drew people to the track who otherwise wouldn't have been here. We're looking to do it again." On-track handle on the bet was \$565,288, with \$2,126,715 wagered at California satellite sites and \$650,368 handled out of state. Outside of Hollywood and its satellites, Nevada handled the most on the Pick 6, \$384,201. Golden Gate Fields and its outlets were next at \$280,685. With New Yorkers shut out of the bet, there was a total of \$207,128, third highest out-of-state, wagered on the Pick 6 at the Meadowlands in New Jersey. The lowest contribution to the pool was Dover Downs' \$646.

SEMORAN RETIRED Multiple graded-stakes winner **Semoran** (Phone Trick), third in Saturday's Gill Stephen Foster S. at Churchill Downs, suffered a bowed tendon in his right front leg during the race and has been retired. "He'll be all right," said trainer Bob Baffert. "There was no bone damage, but he will be retired. He'd need a year off to be able to come back." Winner of the Gill Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H. and the Gill Kentucky Cup Classic last season, the five-year-old captured eight of his 22 starts for earnings of \$860,035. As for **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck), who weakened in the final yards and finished second in the Stephen Foster, Baffert said, "I didn't do enough with him (before the race). If I had known I was going to have to give away 14 pounds to a good horse, I would've done more." Pointing for the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar August 15, the four-year-old will likely make one more start before that \$1 million race. "I've got to find something for him," said Baffert. "I'm looking everywhere."

Back on track after a career hampered by both health and attitude problems, Labeeb (GB) bounced back after ending '97 with four consecutive off-the-board finishes to take the Gill San Simeon H. after an eight-month layoff April 18. The winner of four straight from November, 1995 to April, 1997, including the GI Hollywood Derby in his U.S. bow, the bay started another streak, rallying to catch Fantastic Fellow deep in the lane. "I think he's over his antics," said trainer Neil Drysdale of the horse who ducked out and dropped his rider in the GI Manhattan H. in June, 1997. "This is very satisfying, because there was talk about retiring him (last fall). We decided to keep him in training and I think it paid off." Favored Hawksley Hill (Ire) made a bid on the far turn, was steadied at the quarter-pole, came between horses at the head of the lane and got up for third. "He wasn't comfortable at all," said his jockey, Gary Stevens. "(The turf) was stinging him a little bit all the way around. He just wasn't striding out like he normally does."

With her last victory coming in an Oaklawn allowance race February 1, Sweet and Ready was overlooked in this four-horse field, but may have had an excuse in her latest, finishing fourth after breaking awkwardly in the restricted Jewel Princess S. May 22. Breaking sharply this time, the longshot sat back in third as the two favorites battled through a half in :45 3/5 and six furlongs in 1:09 1/5, then rallied down the lane to post the upset victory. "On paper, it looked like a match race," said jockey Chris McCarron. "Actually, I'm kidding, because I rode a nice filly. She just doesn't want to be rushed, she just wants to make one run. She's a filly who takes some riding, too. I had to get after her...but she responded well." Trainer Jeffrey Morris was winning his first graded stakes in his first Hollywood tally. "We brought her over here (for the Jewel Princess) on a Friday night," he said. "I'd only had her a week, and as soon as we got her under the lights I knew we were in trouble. She starting getting the jitters and when I saddled her she froze up...when we tried to move her, she just threw herself on the ground. When a filly does something like that, your chance is gone. This time we did a lot of things differently. We got a chance to school her and get to know her a little better and it paid off." The runner-up, Brulay, was coming off a win in the Gill Railbird S., but tired late after her early duel and just missed in her two-turn debut.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Making his owner the first centenarian to win a stakes race in New York, Recommended List didn't look like a horse who had never won on the main track as he dueled from the inside with RISKY BUY (Well Decorated) through a solid pace then dug in to draw off by a comfortable margin. The odds-on winner of his last two turf starts, the Citation S. at Hialeah April 12 and Anderson Fowler S. at Monmouth May 23, he had finished a distant third in the off-the-turf Garden State S. May 9. But the track was no concern to Jimmy Picou, who said, "We had mud caulks on him today and that helped us, but the big factor was the reduction of the field."

A winner of two-of-four starts at two with two seconds, Buff didn't get off to a good start at three, finishing last in his three-year-old debut, a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 31. Sent right back into stakes company in his next outing, however, he came home a winner in the Jiffy Lube S. Feb. 28 in his first effort on the turf. Raced strictly on the grass since then, but without a win to his credit in that period, he was sent away the third-longest shot here, took command at the top of the stretch and drew away for the impressive win. Bet On Sunshine (Bet Big), third in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, breezed for the first time since straining his left front suspensory ligament in January yesterday at Churchill. The gelding went three furlongs in :37 1/5. "I could tell he really enjoyed it this morning, finally getting to roll," said trainer Paul McGee. "He has been asking for it now for a while. He had those ears pricked and went really good." The six-year-old is still about two months from a race.

Lu Ravi (A.P. Indy), unraced since winning the Gill Fair Grounds Oaks in March, worked six furlongs in 1:13 3/5 at Churchill yesterday morning.

A winner of the GIIC Seagram Cup H. at Woodbine last July, Crown Attorney's most impressive performance last year came when he ran a close third, 1 3/4 lengths behind Geri and Helmsman, in the GIC Woodbine Mile. After finishing up the track in his next two starts, he was laid off until an April 26 allowance on the dirt which resulted in a 22-length drubbing. After finding the winner's circle on the Woodbine grass in a May 16 allowance, he ran second to Kiradashi in the GIIC Connaught Cup two weeks later. With that speedy foe worn down by chasing the insane pace set by RANDY REGENT (Vice Regent), Crown Attorney was able to turn the tables by racing last for six furlongs, advancing on the turn and holding the lead through the stretch run. "He was setting up for this race," said jockey Mickey Walls, "He needed that last race a little more than we thought he did."

After a brief two-year-old season in which he flashed promise, winning a Saratoga maiden race and finishing third in the GII Cowdin in his final juvenile start Oct. 26, Scatmandu had tested the waters early in his three-year-old season in allowance company. After winning his '98 bow April 25 at Aqueduct by a head, he went on to an 11 1/2-length score in his latest, a May 17 Belmont allowance, and traveled down I-95 in search of his first stakes win here. The second choice sat off the early lead, took command on the turn and drew off for the win. Hot Wells, fourth in the Preakness but scratched from last Saturday's Belmont S. over a licensing problem, closed to be second. The 3-2 favorite, BLACK CASH (Deposit Ticket) never seriously threatened while finishing fifth. The time was 4/5ths of a second off Spectacular Bid's track record.
