REAL QUIET BACK ON TRACK Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Real Quiet** (Quiet American) had his first work since narrowly losing the GI Belmont S. June 6 yesterday at Churchill Downs. The three-year-old colt breezed three furlongs in :36. "He was just begging me to move on him," commented jockey Shane Sellers, aboard for the work. "He galloped out really good." Trainer Bob Baffert said Real Quiet will start next in Monmouth Park's GI Haskell Invitational August 9. "I had to work him," Baffert said yesterday. "He was getting pretty wild. He came out of the Belmont great."

ALBARADO INJURED IN CHURCHILL SPILL Jockey Robby Albarado sustained a fractured skull during Wednesday's third race at Churchill when his mount Presho suddenly fell and Apprehend, ridden by Willie Martinez, collided and fell over the downed horse and rider. The 24-year-old Albarado was examined by track physician Dr. Barbara Sowers and sent via ambulance to Caritas Medical Center where a CAT Scan revealed a depressed skull fracture to his right temporal area and secondary linear fracture leading to the left frontal area. "There is no bleeding and the brain is intact," said Sowers. "With any type of injury like this, the first 24 hours are the most important. It takes a very severe impact to sustain a fractured skull through a helmet." Presho, a four-year-old maiden making his third start this year, was euthanized on the track and a necropsy has been scheduled. Going into yesterday's card, Albarado was the third-leading rider at Churchill with a record of 37 wins from 256 starts.

While Godolphin's LA NUIT ROSE (FR) (Rainbow Quest) set the pace, the Aga Khan's French 1000 Guineas winner Zalaiyka (Fr), the hot 5-4 favorite, and Exclusive (GB) settled well in fourth and fifth, respectively. At the quarter-mile pole La Nuit Rose still led with Zalaiyka making her challenge on the outside, but with three-sixteenths to run, Swinburn found the perfect split for Exclusive and the bright-colored chestnut quickened brilliantly and went away from the opposition to score her second win in five lifetime starts for earnings of \$278,778. Zalaiyka was hard-ridden to keep the second spot from fast-finishing Winona (Ire) and LADY IN WAITING (GB) (Kylian). "This is a great way to celebrate," said the recently knighted Sir Michael Stoute. "Exclusive has thrived since the 1000 Guineas, where she was only beaten a short head for second, and she was specially trained for this. I'm absolutely thrilled. I would think a mile and a quarter would suit her well, so we will think about (stretching her out)." Added jockey Walter Swinburn, "Exclusive was a big, raw filly in the 1000 Guineas, but I knew (Stoute) had her in great shape for this race. She was going so well a furlong and a half out that I knew she would win. This is the place to have winners and it's great to be back." A probable target for Exclusive is the 1 1/4-mile G2 Nassau S. at Goodwood August 1. Alain de Royer-Dupre, trainer of the runner-up, said, "No real excuses, but the ground didn't suit her. Every time she runs on this type of ground, she hasn't liked it and her jockey (Gerald Mosse) said she was continuously changing her leads."

Group 1 races are on the agenda for the lightly raced **Diktat (GB)** after this impressive display, his first stakes success and his third straight from as many starts this season. Settled in midfield while **LA-FAAH (IRE)** (**Lahib**) and **BIANCONI (Danzig)** set the pace, **Diktat** made his move at the quarter-mile mark, quickening well to grab the lead and, despite wandering across the track, was always in command and ran out an easy winner. "He's a very progressive horse," said winning trainer **David Loder**. "I toyed with the idea of running him in yesterday's **St James's Palace S.**, but he'd had only three previous starts and I felt he was too immature and green for that test. So we went for this instead and although he still ran rather green when he hit the front, he still showed that he is potentially a very good horse. I hope he can run in Group 1 races for the rest of the season, with the **Sussex S.** at **Goodwood (July 29)** and the **Prix Jacques Le Marois** at **Deauville (August 16)** two possible targets. He would not want the ground too firm, so I would lean towards going to **Deauville**."

STAR CRYSTAL (IRE) (**Brief Truce**) set the early pace, but was overtaken on the final turn, where the crowd's choice **Capri (GB)** grabbed the lead and looked the probable winner. The favorite was soon challenged by stable companion **Laurentide**, but it was **Maridpour (Ire)**, who only broke his maiden at lowly **Hamilton Park** in **Scotland May 15** on his last start, who outfinished them both, plugging on gamely and gaining the front close to home, winning for the second time in four lifetime starts, all this season.

Living up to the great promise she had shown when winning the **National S.** at **Sandown May 26**, **Bint Allayl (GB)** was simply sensational here. Having followed **DAMALIS (IRE)** (**Mukaddamah**) down the center of the track while **LITTLE MOVIE STAR (Risk Me {Fr})** and **Coralita (Ire)** set a hot pace, she quickened brilliantly at the quarter-mile pole, struck the front at the eighth pole and was soon clear, being eased down at the finish to take ample revenge on the runner-up **Pipalong (Ire)**, who had beaten her in her debut at **York May 12**. Winning trainer **Mick Channon**, a former English national team soccer star, said, "It's everyone's dream to have a winner at **Royal Ascot** and this is a very special winner. We've always thought she was very good and she's proved it again today, just as she did at **Sandown**. I will talk to **Sheikh Ahmed** now and I would think we'll keep her to six furlongs and go for the (G2) **Lowther S.** at **York (Aug. 20)** and then the (G1) **Cheveley Park S.** at **Newmarket** at the end of **September**." Winning rider **Frankie Dettori**, also impressed with his mount, said, "It was a great display and she's very much one for the future."

Local News, Hong Kong:

The Hong Kong Jockey Club has reported its first-ever drop in annual betting handle, according to yesterday's Harness Tracks of America newsletter. Hong Kong Jockey Club Chief Executive Lawrence Wong told a press conference, "economic problems faced by most Asian countries have damaged, at least in the short term, business and consumer confidence in Hong Kong." Handle dropped .87 percent to \$11.82 billion over the racing season which ended Sunday.

Australian trainer David Hayes, five-time champion trainer in Melbourne and the man who saddled Jeune to win the Melbourne Cup in 1994, this week clinched the trainers' title in Hong Kong, saddling a treble at Sha-Tin Sunday to take his season's total of winners to 62, three ahead of his great rival Ivan Allan, who beat him by one winner last season. Hayes, who went to Hong Kong after the 1994-95 Australian season, joins former Australian champion jockey George Moore and his son John Moore as the only Australian trainers to win the Hong Kong title. The senior Moore won the title 10 times, while his son has won it on four occasions.
