SKIP AWAY QUESTIONABLE FOR GOLD CUP

After getting loose at Belmont Park Friday morning, **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) has developed filling in both front legs and is no longer a definite starter for next Sunday's GI Hollywood Gold Cup, according to trainer Sonny Hine. "It's minor, but it's there," said the trainer. "The horse is not lame and the horse is not sore, but we're concerned." Hine said he remained optimistic that he could still make the race, but said he would not make a final decision until after Skip Away works Tuesday. He had originally planned to breeze the five-year-old tomorrow, but has put the work off a day due to the problem. "I just looked at him and he was 75 percent better than he was this morning," Hine said yesterday afternoon. "There's a better chance that I'll go than not go, but it all depends. We've got to make sure all the filling is out. I don't want to run him on Bute because he's never been on medication like that before and I don't want to start." Skip Away jogged a mile and a half yesterday morning, but may not go to the track today, Hine said. "We're anxious to come (to the Gold Cup), and now that Silver Charm is in there, we're doubly anxious. But the horse has to go to the Gold Cup first-class. I don't want to make any excuses for him. If I come, you can bet he's 100 percent."

ALBARADO SURGERY A SUCCESS Jockey Robby Albarado was released from Louisville's Caritas Medical Center Saturday morning, less than 24 hours after undergoing surgery for a fractured skull suffered in a spill Wednesday at Churchill Downs. Neurosurgeon Dr. Lansing Cowles performed a cranioplasty on Albarado Friday afternoon, placing titanium mesh over the indentation fracture and then covering it with a polymer, which hardened and will protect the area from future injury. "He said he feels great," said Albarado's agent, Lenny Pike, yesterday. "There's no headache or anything. I think he'll be ready to ride just as soon as it's comfortable to put his helmet back on." If all goes well, Albarado expects to be back over the July 4 weekend.

All the questions surrounding Mossflower's class and ability against proven competition were forcefully answered by the 12 lengths separating her and a Hempstead field comprised of all multiple graded stakes winners. With runaway scores in her only three starts at three, Mossflower returned as a four-year-old to post allowance victories at Aqueduct May 6 and Belmont June 3 before trying this tough crowd. Glitter Woman and DIXIE FLAG (Dixieland Band) set a suicidal pace of :44 4/5 and 1:08 3/5 as 8-5 AJINA (Strawberry Road {Aus}) sat stalking in third and Mossflower lingered in last place. The favorite was unable to muster any response in the stretch, but Mossflower ate up ground on the turn, angled out three-wide, then drew off powerfully to score in stakes-record time. "I'm flabbergasted that she won as easily as she did because the talent she was up against today called for a lot more effort from her than her prior allowance races," said trainer Richard Schosberg. "From here, the Go For Wand S. (nine furlongs, GI, August 2) and Personal Ensign H. (10 furlongs, GI, August 28) at Saratoga could be next, but our ultimate goal is the Breeders' Cup Distaff."

SELLERS STARS IN NTRA JOCKEY

CHAMPIONSHIP Jockey Shane Sellers captured three of four races to earn 36 points and score a commanding victory in the \$100,000 NTRA All-Star Jockey Championship Friday night at Lone Star Park in Texas. Tenth in the inaugural edition of the event last year, Sellers beat out a field which included seven Hall of Famers to take the top prize of \$25,000. He guided 6-1 shot Shareff Prospect to victory in the first leg of the event, upset the second race in the series with 4-3-1 Miami Flyer, was off the board in the third leg, then came back aboard 6-5 Mocha Express to win the final race by three lengths. "I was lucky...the horses ran for me," said Sellers. "When you go against this caliber of riders, it comes down to the horses. It was my night tonight." Julie Krone was the only other All-Star to win a race, getting Illusive Ghost up in the final strides to take the third event; she finished second overall with 18 points. Jerry Bailey was third, Kent Desormeaux finished fourth and Mike Smith was fifth. The rest of the field, in order of the finish, was Chris McCarron, Pat Day, Sandy Hawley, Laffit Pincay Jr., Marlon St. Julien, last year's winner Gary Stevens and Eddie Delahoussaye. Sellers, whose mounts were coupled in the "All-Star Wager" as #9 on the program, paid \$14.80 to win, \$10.20 to place and \$5.80 to show; Krone, #6, paid \$8.20 to place and \$4.00 to show; and Bailey, #1, paid \$5.00 to show. The Sellers/Krone exacta paid \$150.80, and the Sellers/Krone/Bailey trifecta paid \$670.60. The Championship raised more than \$143,000 for the Disabled Jockeys Fund and the Jockeys' Guild.

Brite Adam (High Brite), whose 10 career starts have all come at Woodbine, placed second in his sophomore bow, the April 4 GIIIC Achievement H. at six furlongs, and was then third in the seven furlong GIIIC Queenston H. Winner of the GIC Plate Trial S. by 8 3/4 lengths June 3, he could make trainer Rita Schnitzler the first woman to ever win Canada's classic. **Nite Dreamer** (El Prado {Ire}) ran second in the GIII Louisiana Derby March 15, but was a troubled sixth in his last--he reportedly bled in that race, the March 29 GII Jim Beam S. at Turfway Park.
