SKIP AWAY BACK ON GOLD CUP TRACK Two-time champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) looks back on track for next Sunday's GI Hollywood Gold Cup after the filling in his front legs went down. The grey five-year-old got loose on the Belmont track Friday morning and the problem arose Saturday. Trainer Sonny Hine reported yesterday that the filling near Skip Away's knees is gone now and the horse will likely work Tuesday morning. "If he looks as good as he did today, we'll take him out and jog him a mile to a mile and a half Monday," Hine said. "At that time, if he has no filling, we'll schedule a breeze for him Tuesday at 8:30 (EDT)." Skip Away is expected to be flown from New York to Los Angeles Thursday. Hine also mapped out Skip Away's goals for the rest of the year, citing the August 15 GI Pacific Classic, September 19 GI Woodward, October 10 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and November 7 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. In other Gold Cup news, defending champion **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) worked six furlongs in company in 1:13 2/5. "He's had enough tough work so we didn't want to overdo it today," explained trainer Richard Mandella. "We lightened up on the work because he's had a pretty tough month of training." The six-year-old has not run since finishing last in the March 7 GI Santa Anita H. Two Gold Cup possibles worked yesterday. **Bagshot** (Smokester) worked six furlongs in 1:13 1/5 and **Mud Route** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) went the same distance in a bullet 1:12 3/5.

STEVENS TO REMAIN IN CALIFORNIA Jockey Gary Stevens, who had announced plans to ride the Saratoga and Belmont Fall meetings in New York, will now remain in his Southern California base at least through the July 22 to Sept. 9 Del Mar meeting, according to his agent, Ron Anderson. "We've been offered a position to ride a lot of good young horses at Del Mar and we're going to stay put and just continue on here," said Anderson yesterday. "We've been approached by Bob Baffert with a whole bunch of young horses which he anticipates developing into good horses. We're not staying for one or two horses." Stevens, the leading rider in the country by money earned, had originally planned to come to New York because of the quality of the summer and fall meets, said Anderson, but, he explained, "We're going real well, we're leading rider in the country, and we're going to stay put."

Archers Bay, with only five races under his belt, ended his juvenile campaign with back-to-back Aqueduct wins last winter and, in two 1998 races, finished third in a May 10 New York allowance and second in the June 3 Plate Trial S. last time out. Second choice behind Plate Trial winner Brite Adam, Archers Bay raced fifth early, stuck his head in front at the top of the stretch and drove clear to the wire. Kent Desormeaux became the first jockey to win the Queen's Plate and Kentucky Derby in the same year since Bill Hartack rode Northern Dancer to victory in the two races in 1964. "He left no doubt in my mind that he was absolutely going to drive all the way to the wire," Desormeaux said after the win. "It was just a matter of how far from there. My true moments of anxiety came at the quarter pole where I had no place to go and I was all dressed up. It was just a matter of finding him some racing room. He got some room and he strutted his stuff." Winning trainer Todd Pletcher added, "He's been flagged by shin problems from early in his two-year-old year. When we made this decision back in December to give him a little time and have him ready for this, it's one of those things that rarely, in this game, come together. But in this case it really did."

Trainer Andre Fabre scored his seventh success in the Grand Prix de Paris as Limpid (GB), on only his fifth lifetime start, enjoyed a comfortable win over the G1 Prix Jean Prat winner Almutawakel (GB), with Wafic Said's G1 Prix Lupin winner and G1 French Derby runner-up Croco Rouge (Ire) an unlucky in third. Runner-up on his only start as a juvenile, Limpid broke his maiden at Saint-Cloud February 27 and followed a second in the Prix Montenica at the same track March 31 with a fourth in G3 Prix de Guiche at Longchamp May 14. He raced in midfield as Almutawakel set a swift pace on

the fast ground from SPECIAL QUEST (FR) (Rainbow Quest). With a half mile to race, Special Quest grabbed the lead as the field quickened, but Almutawakel regained control entering the stretch. He was soon challenged by Limpid, who took command well inside the final eighth and won handily. Croco Rouge, who hit traffic problems after the final turn, finished well, but was too late to threaten the two leaders. Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's racing manager Anthony Stroud said, "We will probably put Limpid away now and prepare him for the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (at Longchamp October 4). He's a late-maturing type and that's why we missed the Classics." Almutawakel's rider Frankie Dettori said of the runner-up, "He has run well again and has certainly improved since the Prix Jean Prat (May 31 at Chantilly). But he got tired inside the final furlong and I knew that Olivier Peslier's horse had the race won." Of Croco Rouge, rider Sylvain Guillot said, "He didn't have a good trip, but he was not the same horse I rode in the (French) Derby. He was not as fresh today and I think he was feeling the effects of that race."

Winning for the third time in five lifetime starts, Another Dancer (Fr) came into the race off a second in the G1 Prix Cleopatre at Saint-Cloud May 12 and a fifth place finish in the G1 French Oaks at Chantilly June 7. Cantilever (GB), winner of the G2 Prix de Royaumont, led from the gate, but Glorosia (Fr) took over after a quarter mile, setting a good pace from Cantilever, while Another Dancer was settled in rear. At the half-mile mark, Cantilever joined Glorosia up front and these two led into the straight, but Cash Asmussen timed his run aboard the winner to perfection, bringing her through on the outside to catch the two leaders and draw away for an impressive score.

He pursued the lead set by the mare **OCCUPANDISTE (IRE)** (Kaldoun {Fr}), who raced very freely in her first start this year, followed by **Alamo Bay** and **AIR EXPRESS (IRE)** (Salse). But **Occupandiste** was hating the ground, switching leads every few strides and she failed to quicken entering the stretch, where **Donkey Engine** soon took command and went clear and was not hard pressed to see off the challenge of the runner-up. Winning trainer **Alain de Royer-Dupre** commented, "Donkey Engine will now go to **Deauville** in August, either for the (G1) **Prix Maurice de Gheest** (over 6 1/2 furlongs August 9) or the (G3) **Prix de Meautry** (6 furlongs August 30), or both."

It was announced yesterday that owner **Wafic Said** has sold a half-interest in his three-year-old colt **Croco Rouge (Ire)** (**Rainbow Quest**), winner of the G1 **Prix Lupin**, runner-up to **Dream Well** in the G1 **French Derby** at **Chantilly** May 31 and third in yesterday's G1 **Grand Prix de Paris**.
