### SILVER CHARM OUT OF HOLLYWOOD

**GOLD CUP** For the second time this year, 1997 Kentucky Derby winner **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) had to be declared from a Grade I California showdown yesterday. Scheduled to make his next start against **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) and **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) in Sunday's G1 Hollywood Gold Cup, the four-year-old colt spiked a 102-degree fever yesterday and will be forced to miss the race. Silver Charm had been expected to tackle Gentlemen in the March 7 G1 Santa Anita H., but had to be withdrawn on the eve of the race with a bruised foot. The foot healed quickly and the grey was able to travel to Dubai for a gutsy win in the March 28 G1 World Cup. After a brief vacation, Silver Charm returned to the races with a second-place finish in the June 13 G1 Stephen Foster H. and was unexpectedly added to the Gold Cup roster last Friday. "The first thing we do every morning is take the temperature of all our horses," Baffert explained yesterday. "His temperature was 100.1 and he walked fine. So we put his grain in, we put him in his stall and he usually dives right in the bucket. His groom said he didn't even go for the grain. He said he went to the corner and just put his head down. We took his temperature again, and he had a fever of 102. We brought every thermometer in the barn to take his temperature and they all had the same thing." Baffert added that blood tests were taken Wednesday. "He's got something there so we can't afford to take a chance."

**ALYDAR TRIAL BEGINS** The trial of former Calumet groom Alton Stone was scheduled to begin yesterday in Houston, Texas. Stone is charged with giving false statements to a grand jury last August. In dispute is how the groom came to be a last-minute replacement for Calumet's regular night watchman on the night that 1978 Triple Crown runner-up Alydar broke a leg at the Lexington, Kentucky farm. If convicted, Stone faces a maximum of five years in prison and fines of \$500,000. The trial is the culmination of years of investigations to determine if the heavily insured horse was killed to pay off loans on the indebted farm. Alydar was used as collateral on a loan provided by the now-defunct First City Bancorporation. The bank had threatened to foreclose on the loan just weeks before Alydar's death. Stone contends that discrepancies in his testimony were the result of lapses in memory years after the events in question occurred.

### NTRA RACING TO THE BREEDERS' CUP

**DEBUTS SUNDAY** The National Thoroughbred Racing Association's Racing to the Breeders' Cup television series will make its 1998 debut Sunday with a live special edition telecast of the \$1 million Hollywood Gold Cup from Hollywood Park. The program will air from 7-7:30 p.m. ET. The NTRA Racing to the Breeders' Cup telecast of the Hollywood Gold Cup will be hosted by Bob Neumeier and Tom Durkin will call the race. Sandra Neil will join Neumeier as co-host when the series resumes on August 8 with the Whitney H. from Saratoga.

### LOUP SAUVAGE TO VINERY

**Loup Sauvage** (Riverman--Louveterie, by Nureyev) will stand at Vinery in Midway, Kentucky at the conclusion of his racing career. The four-year-old, third in this year's G1 Dubai World Cup, was highweight three-year-old in France at 9 1/2 to 11 furlongs and, in his most recent outing, won the May 21 G1 Prix d'Isphahan. He is being pointed towards the 1998 G1 Breeders' Cup Classic. In a transaction that affects only the horse's stud career, Vinery purchased 90 percent of Loup Sauvage. The chestnut's owner and breeder Daniel Wildenstein retains a 10-percent interest.

Prior to his fourth spot at Epsom, Sunshine Street had finished runner-up in all of his five lifetime starts, with Hughes in the saddle on two occasions.

## WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

### PEDIGREE SHORTS

The G3 Coventry S. last week at Royal Ascot resulted in a win for **Red Sea (GB) (c, 2, Barathea {Ire}--Up Anchor {Ire}, by Slip Anchor {GB})**. Red Sea is a two-year-old from the first crop by his sire, a son of Sadler's Wells. Red Sea's dam is a descendent of Never Bend, which means that Red Sea has a double of Lalun, dam of both Never Bend and of Sadler's Wells' broodmare sire, Bold Reason. This has been a tremendous pattern for both Sadler's Wells and his brother Fairy King, and it appears to be carrying on to the next generation, as Barathea is the fifth son of Sadler's Wells to sire a stakes winner with this duplication.

**Sugino Cutie (f, 3, Majestic Light--Summer Mood by Raja Baba)**, who captured the listed Crocus S. in Tokyo Feb. 1, combines a rarely seen pair of brothers. Her sire Majestic Light is by Majestic Prince, who in turn is out of a mare by Royal Charger. The unusual element comes in the female line, where we find that Sugino Cutie's third dam, Fair III, is by Madara, a moderately performing brother to Royal Charger who stood in South America. In addition to having Royal Charger/Madara 4x4, Sugino Cutie also has their three-parts brother Nasrullah in the fourth generation. To complete the story, her fourth generation also features the genetic relatives Ambiorix (by Tourbillon out of Lavendula) and My Babu (by a son of Tourbillon out of a daughter of Lavendula).

A quality field for the GIII Sabin H. at Gulfstream Feb. 1 was upset by the unfashionably bred **Radiant Megan (m, 5, Commadore C.--Radiant Flower, by Sir Jinsky)**. Radiant Megan's pedigree line is not a particularly familiar one, but her sire is a graded stakes winner by Champion Turf Horse Mongo (by Royal Charger), and her dam is by a brother to the good mare Javamine out of a sister to Champion Vaguely Noble. At first glance, this pedigree looks to be an outcross, but, in fact, both sire and dam have concentrations of similar strains. To begin with, the dam of Commadore C. has Sir Gallahad III 4x4x3, with one cross coming through the mare La France. Then Sir Jinsky has Sir Gallahad III's brother, Bull Dog, 5x5x5, with a more distant cross of Sir Gallahad III via Omaha, a close relative to La France. There are also similarities in the "wings" of the pedigree. Both Royal Charger, the great-grandsire, and Noble Lassie, the third dam, are by Nearco out of mares with Gainsborough, Blandford and The Tetrarch close up their pedigrees.

We have mentioned before the affinity between Nearctic and Alibhai, a close relative to Nearctic's dam, Lady Angela. This combination is taken to new extremes by **Cool Dixie (f, 3, Dixieland Band--Be Cool, by Tank's Prospect)**, winner of the \$100,000 Tiffany Lass S. at Fair Grounds Feb. 1. Cool Dixie's sire Dixieland Band is by Northern Dancer, a son of Nearctic, out of a mare inbred to Alibhai. Cool Dixie's granddam is the stakes winning Icy Time. She is by Icecapade (by Nearctic) and is out of a daughter of a Nearctic mare, so she has that horse 2x3. On top of that, Icecapade is a three-quarters genetic relative to Northern Dancer (both by Nearctic out of Native Dancer mares), which means Cool Dixie has Northern Dancer/Icecapade 2x3 and Nearctic 3x4x5.

Is something going on between Carson City and Secretariat? When **Western City (c, 3, Carson City--Fire Alarm, by Secretariat)** won the Lecomte H. at Fair Grounds Jan. 31, he followed Boone's Mill as the second stakes winner by Carson City out of a Secretariat mare. What's more, there are two stakes winners by Carson City out of mares by Secreto, who is himself out of a Secretariat mare. In fact, if one wants to extend the connection, Carson City's highest earner, Lord Carson, is out of a mare by a son of Secretariat's half-brother, Sir Gaylord.

The Tom Fool/Flaming Page combination credited a young sire with his first stakes winner recently. This was **Prospector's Song (f, 3, Prospector's Music--Music Bell, by Stop the Music)**, a three-year-old filly who captured the Dixie Belle S. at Oaklawn Jan. 30. Prospector's Song comes from the first crop by Prospector's Music, a three-parts brother to Silver Ghost. Prospector's Music is out of a mare by The Minstrel (granddam Flaming Page) and Prospector's Song's broodmare sire, Stop the Music, is by out of mare by Tom Fool.
