**TOUCH GOLD RETURNS SUNDAY** *Touch Gold* (Deputy Minister), winner last year of the GI Belmont S. and GI Buick Haskell Invitational, makes his four-year-old bow in Sunday's seventh race at Churchill Downs, a mile allowance test. Fourth and last in the GI Buick Pegasus H. last September and ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic to end his three-year-old season, the colt has recovered from the quarter crack which sidelined him for seven months and has been training without a bar shoe in recent weeks. "I'm looking forward to seeing him run, just like everybody else," said trainer Pat Byrne, who will be saddling the Classic winner for the first time. "I think we've got him tight enough to go a flat mile and he's trained awfully well." Jockey Pat Day will ride *Touch Gold* for the first time Sunday.

### DARLEY STUD TO SELL AT TATTERSALLS

**JULY** Sheikh Mohammed's Darley Stud Management will offer the largest consignment, a total of 45 lots, at the upcoming Tattersalls July Sale. Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's Shadwell Estates will sell 19 lots, Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum's Gainsborough Stud Management will offer 11 and Juddmonte Farms will have 14 in the sale. A catalogue of 320 lots will include more than 110 broodmares by top stallions such as *Caerleon*, *Fairy King*, *In The Wings* (GB), *Machiavellian*, *Nureyev* and *Shirley Heights* (GB), as well as more than 70 winning horses in training. Among the top quality fillies in training in the sale are an unraced three-year-old by *Rainbow Quest* out of champion *Sonic Lady* (Nureyev); and an unraced three-year-old by *Caerleon* out of G1 *Yorkshire Oaks* winner *Untold* (GB) (Final Straw {GB}). The July Sale will be held July 7-9 in Newmarket, England.

### NTRA "RACING TO THE BREEDERS' CUP"

**SCHEDULE UNVEILED** Fifteen Grade I races, beginning with tomorrow's showdown between *Skip Away* (Skip Trial) and *Gentlemen* (Arg) (Robin des Bois) in the \$1 million *Hollywood Gold Cup* at 7 p.m. EDT, will highlight this year's NTRA "Racing to the Breeders' Cup" series on ESPN. The series has been expanded to 15 shows this season, five more than last year. A total of 19 races, with purses worth more than \$8 million, will be featured. Banshee Breeze (Unbridled) began 1998 with three consecutive wins at Gulfstream, including the GI Bonnie Miss S. March 16., but faltered to third in the GI Ashland S. April 4 at Keeneland. In her last start, the May 2 GI Kentucky Oaks, she made a six-wide move around the far turn and showed courage in the stretch, just missing by a neck to **Keeper Hill** (Deputy Minister). That filly, an off-the-pace runner, came onto the scene with a 5½-length score in the GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita February 15. She also hasn't run since her ground-saving Kentucky Oaks score. **Who Did It and Run** (Polish Numbers) defeated the boys in her last three, winning an April 24 allowance and the May 22 GI Jersey Derby over the Garden State turf and scoring by 12 on the main track in the May 9 Garden State S. An indisputable front runner, she'll be pressured early by **Jersey Girl** (Belong to Me), winner of her last five, including the GI Acorn S. at Belmont June 7, but suspect at the longer distance.
