### SKIP AWAY STARS IN HOLLYWOOD

**GOLD CUP** Maybe they should give him a star on the "Walk of Fame." Back at Hollywood Park, site of his explosive GI Breeders' Cup Classic victory last November, **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) rode a six-race winning streak into yesterday's \$1 million GI Hollywood Gold Cup. The 2-5 favorite in the race, he broke sharply, set the pace with 8-5 **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) hard on his heels, then met the challenge when last year's Gold Cup winner joined him on the far turn. The two raced as a team for a quarter, but at the top of the lane Skip Away put Gentlemen away and staved off the late bid of **Puerto Madero (Chi)** (Gallantsky) to win by 1 3/4 lengths. While he has a long way to go before he can match the 16 straight victories of Cigar, yesterday's performance prompted jockey Jerry Bailey to make a more than favorable comparison to the horse he rode to two Horse of the Year titles. "When they both ran together, Skip Away beat him, and maybe that will tell you something," said Bailey. "I will always have a special place in my heart for Cigar, but maybe Skip Away is a better horse. I think my heart is big enough to have a place for both of them. This is a special animal."

**TOUCH GOLD GLITTERS IN RETURN** Making his first start since finishing ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last November, GI Belmont S. and GI Haskell Invitational winner **Touch Gold** (Deputy Minister) came within a tick of the track record winning a mile allowance race at Churchill Downs yesterday. The four-year-old, bet down to 1-5, put a head in front after a half, lost the lead on the far turn, but came back again under new jockey Pat Day to win by 2 3/4 lengths, stopping the timer in 1:34. Said trainer Pat Byrne. "He ran very fast, and he got a lot out of it. He cooled out really well, and we're happy with that." As for the future, Byrne said, "The Whitney H. (August 8) will be his next likely start. If he has an unbeaten campaign, he has a great shot at Horse of the Year. We'd have to knock off Skip Away, he's the top horse this year and has done nothing wrong. But what you do in the fall is what counts. We have a fresh horse and he's ready to fire."

Dropping six pounds off his victory in the GIII MassCap last out May 30, Skip Away was carrying his lightest impost of his current winning stretch, which grew to seven with another impressive effort here. The overwhelming favorite in this eight-horse field, the grey went right to the lead under jockey Jerry Bailey as '97 Gold Cup winner **Gentlemen (Arg)**, making his first start since running last in the GI Santa Anita H. March 7, kept him in his sights. But when **Gentlemen** made his bid on the final bend, Skip Away answered, running stride for stride with that rival to the top of the stretch before powering away and holding **Puerto Madero (Chi)** safe for the win. While extending his own streak, the two-time champ denied trainer Richard Mandella his seventh consecutive million-dollar race in California (excluding Breeders' Cup races). "It was game race, he really had to run," said trainer Sonny Hine, then added with a laugh, "I guess they'll say we didn't beat anybody again today, but I don't know what's left. Maybe **Touch Gold**--he beat non-winners in a year today. Maybe he'll be an up-and-comer." As for what's next, Hine said, "This has been a trying week for us with this horse. His feet were broken up so badly, the nails wouldn't stay in the shoes. He's going to have to stop for a week to 10 days and grow a little foot. If I can make (the Pacific Classic at Del Mar August 15) anyway, I will come. But he ran so hard today, maybe we ought to wait a little bit." As for **Gentlemen**, Mandella said, "He might have gotten a little tired the last eighth of a mile. Maybe he didn't--maybe he just got outrun. We hope to improve at Del Mar."

Dream Well (Fr), winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly May 31, established himself as the best three-year-old colt in Europe with this stunning victory over City Honours, a head runner-up to High-Rise (Ire) in the G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom June 6. Dream Well becomes only the third colt to win both the French and Irish Derbys, following Assert (Ire) in 1982 and Old Vic (GB) in 1989, and the sixth French-trained winner of the Irish Classic. Unraced at two, he broke his maiden in the G3 Prix La Force at Longchamp May 14 and followed with a neck defeat of stable companion Croco Rouge (Ire) in the French Derby. This win takes his lifetime record to three wins and two seconds from five starts and his earnings to \$1,091,080. Slowly away from the gate after a slight stumble, Dream Well raced well in rear as RISK MATERIAL (IRE) (Danahill) and SUNSHINE STREET (Sunshine Forever) set the pace on the heavy ground. But winning jockey Cash Asmussen propelled his mount to the front rank with three-eighths of a mile to run and the pair drew clear to win with ease, while City Honours ran past beaten horses to claim second spot without in any way threatening the winner. "I was very confident Dream Well would run well and he has run a great race," said winning trainer Pascal Bary. "We put blinkers on him earlier this season to help him concentrate and they seem to have worked. The plan now is to give him a break and bring him back for the (G2) Prix Niel in September (September 13) and then the (G1) Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (October 4)." Cash Asmussen added, "I almost got to the front a little too quickly. He can run lazily with the blinkers on and I had to keep him up to his work."

A walk and then a sprint for this Group 1 event, tactics which ruined the chance of the odds-on favorite SILVER PATRIARCH (IRE) (Saddlers' Hall), who is no sprinter. Reluctantly, Romanov (Ire) led the field, followed by Silver Patriarch and Fragrant Mix (Ire) along the rail. The pace was only quickened at the top of the stretch, with the battle was then joined between Fragrant Mix, Romanov and Gazelle Royale (Fr); Fragrant Mix proving the stronger in the closing stages, winning his second Group race of the season following the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly June 7. Owner/breeder Jean-Luc Lagardere's racing manager Roland De Longevialle said: "We always thought Fragrant Mix was capable of winning a Group 1 race. He had a long layoff after last year's French Derby, but we knew he had great quality and that it was worth persevering with him. Olivier (Peslier) rode a great race on him today. The (G1) Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (October 4) is a possible target for him." Romanov's trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam said: "We would have preferred not to have made the running and a faster pace would have helped. But he's run a great race, especially as this was only his second start this year (he won the G2 Jockey Club S. May 2). The (G1) King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot (July 25) is next." The King George is also the definite target for Silver Patriarch, whose trainer John Dunlop said: "Silver Patriarch is not a sprinter and likes to come off a fast pace. The pace was much too slow, as we feared it might be. He definitely goes for the King George now."

A.P. Assay, who picked up her third win in an optional claiming allowance at Hollywood after a two-month freshening May 21, was off at 10-1 in her stakes debut. The dark bay was fastest away from the gate and led all the way to the wire, opening it up down the stretch to easily best 1-2 Exotic Wood in track-record equalling time. "I was very surprised she was on the lead, that wasn't where we wanted her to be," said winning trainer Paco Gonzalez. "But she was running easy and when she got to the three-eighths pole, I thought, 'There's nobody moving to her--I can't believe it!' She ran faster than the colts (in the Triple Bend)." The favorite was returning after finishing second in the GI Santa Margarita H. March 8 last out. "I might have had her a little too relaxed down the backside," said her jockey, Chris McCarron. "I didn't want to be head-and-head for the lead because she hadn't run in a while. I'm disappointed, but I'm not discouraged."

Laid off 8 ½ months after winning two allowance sprints last July, Stormin Fever ran second going seven furlongs in an Aqueduct allowance April 19 on his return and won going a mile at Belmont May 8. Ambitiously placed in the GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont May 25, he finished seventh, 10 lengths behind the winner. Going a route for the first time, all he needed here was a hand ride to grab the lead after three-quarters and extend his margin under restraint through the stretch.

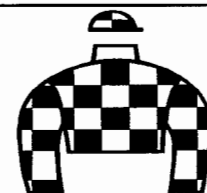
