ALYDAR GROOM CONVICTED According to published reports, Alton Stone, the groom who replaced Calumet Farm's regular night watchman on the night Alydar was fatally injured, was convicted yesterday of two counts of lying to a grand jury. The grand jury was investigating charges that Alydar's death, the result of a broken leg suffered the night of November 13, 1990, was not an accident, but that the horse was killed to collect on the multi-million dollar insurance policy. Calumet was heavily in debt at the time of Alydar's death, and, despite using the insurance money to pay off many creditors, subsequently went bankrupt and was sold. Stone was charged with lying about how he came to be the night watchman's last-minute replacement; he could face up to five years in prison and fines totaling \$500,000. Sentencing is set for September 8.

THREE CHIMNEYS BUYS KING RANCH PROPERTY Three Chimneys and King Ranch has entered into an agreement to purchase the Kentucky Division of King Ranch. The sale of the approximately 670-acre property, located on Old Frankfort Pike, is expected to close on November 30. The farm's name will be changed to Old Bradley Place and will be operated as a division of Three Chimneys. Three Chimneys owner Robert Clay commented, "This is a very exciting development for us. This historical property has raised so many outstanding horses over the years. It is a premier piece of land, strategically located to allow us to consolidate some of our operations. Raising horses on the same land as E.R. Bradley and Robert Kleberg and his children and grandchildren is an awesome responsibility."

Correction: Due to an error in a Breeders' Cup press release, the date and the purse for this year's Turfway Breeders' Cup in yesterday's *TDN* was incorrect. The race, carrying a \$250,000 purse for fillies and mares going a mile and a sixteenth, will be held on the Kentucky Cup Day of Champions, Saturday, September 26 at Turfway Park.
