**NEW WORLD RECORD FOR A MILE** **Elusive Quality** (Gone West) ran what is believed to be the fastest one-mile race in history in yesterday's Poker H. at Belmont, stopping the teletimer in 1:31 3/5 over a firm turf course. The previous record of 1:31 4/5 was set last year at Santa Anita by Atticus, who won the Arcadia H., also on the turf. The Poker was just the second start on the grass in Elusive Quality's 18-race career. "He looked like Lure out there," said winning trainer Bill Mott of his five-year-old who made his grass debut May 31, taking the Jaipur Handicap by a head. "We always knew he had a lot of talent," Mott said. "It only took us till he was five to figure out what to do with him. It looks like the grass has gotten him to turn the corner a little bit." With Jerry Bailey aboard, Elusive Quality shot right to the front and set fractions of :22 3/5 and :44 2/5. Fast early and fast late, he drew away to win by six lengths. "He's put two races together now and seems more consistent," Bailey said. "A rider really can't force anything out of him. I'm a passenger."

**CAPOTE BELLE MAY BE RETIRED** After suffering a series of setbacks in recent weeks, **Capote Belle** (Capote) will likely be retired, according to trainer Dan Peitz. Capote Belle bled badly when finishing eighth, beaten 57 lengths in her last start, a June 6 allowance at Belmont, and soon thereafter came down with a case of colic. She was sent to the New Bolton Center for treatment and would not be ready to race until the fall, said Peitz. "By that point, it's probably not worth trying to run her again," he said. Capote Belle won seven stakes races in her career, including the 1996 GI Test S. at Saratoga. She would retire with nine wins from 22 starts and earnings of \$603,314.

### **MOTT UNDECIDED ON FAVORITE TRICK**

Trainer Bill Mott said yesterday he was still weighing his options on whether 1997 Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick) would make his next start in the July 12 GII Dwyer at Belmont or the July 19 Long Branch Breeders' Cup at Monmouth. Favorite Trick finished eighth in the May 2 Kentucky Derby in his last outing. "I prefer to run my horses in New York," said Mott. "This is where I'm based and I don't like to ship too often, but Favorite Trick was slow coming back from the Kentucky Derby and then he bruised his foot and we lost training with him. The Dwyer was his goal, but I'm going to have to see if he needs an extra week."

A remarkable first for the Godolphin-Saeed Bin Suroor team, with this the first time the same owner and trainer have completed a trifecta in a Group 1 race in Britain. Benefitting from a five-pound swing in the weights from the G2 Prince Of Wales' S. at Ascot June 16, when beaten two necks by Faithful Son, Daylami reversed the form on this occasion. Central Park set a good pace from the gate, and still had the call with a half-mile to go with Daylami closing. At the quarter pole, Daylami hit the front, with Faithful Son coming to challenge the favourite, who showed great determination to fend off his rival and gain the day. "I always wanted to win this race with Daylami and I felt he would win," said Saeed Bin Suroor. "I think he will stay a mile and a half, so, if Sheikh Mohammed and Sheikh Maktoum agree, he will go for the (G1) King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot (July 25)."

Since arriving from England last summer, Magellan had won two allowances, one sprinting and one going a distance of ground, but came into this race looking for his first stakes win. Unraced since finishing fourth in the GII Citation H. last November, he was sent off the second choice off the layoff, stalked the early pace while pulling his rider hard down the backstretch, turned for home just a head behind longshot Sharekann (Ire), and held off the late charge of Bonapartiste (Fr) in the stretch. The even-money choice, MUFATTISH (Hansel), came into this event off two straight wins, but tired to finish last. "He is the strongest horse, bar none, than I have ever ridden," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "Ben (Cecil) had a lot of confidence in him just off his works. He told me that he pulls hard and to try to get him covered up, and I did. He's obviously talented, but man, is he ever strong!" Cecil said he would be pointed to the Aug. 2 GI Eddie Read H. at nine furlongs over Del Mar's turf course next.

Made the favorite off that performance, he shot out of the gate, posted all of the fractions and set what is believed to be a world record for the distance with a runaway score. This smashing performance caused the usually reserved trainer Bill Mott to invoke the holy name of Lure in his description of the performance and say of his horse's future plans, "I kind of thought of the Breeders' Cup Mile after his last start. After today, you really have to think that, especially if the grass is what is helping him get the mile."
