NO PACIFIC CLASSIC FOR SKIP AWAY Champion **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) will not start in Del Mar's August 15 GI Pacific Classic, according to trainer Sonny Hine. Hine said the five-year-old champion is still recovering from his recent trip to California where he captured the June 28 GI Hollywood Gold Cup. "If I take him all the way back out to California again, I may blow my chance to make the Woodward, Jockey Club Gold Cup and maybe even the Breeders' Cup," the trainer explained. A likely target for Skip Away is Monmouth Park's GII Iselin H. on August 30, but Hine insists the track change the distance of the 1 1/16-mile race before entering his charge. "If they don't change the distance, I'm not in," said Hine, who wants the race to be extended to 1 1/8 miles. "They came to me, I didn't go to them. I think they should do what they need to do to bring people in." Hine listed the nine-furlong Aug. 8 GI Whitney H. at Saratoga as another option. Skip Away, a two-time Eclipse champion and winner of his last seven races, has not returned to the track since his Gold Cup victory.

Mudlark Robertico (GB) reveled in the very heavy going at Hamburg--the wettest conditions for the German Derby since 1978--to give his 30-year-old trainer Andreas Schutz, in only his first season as a trainer after taking over from his father Bruno at the end of last year, his third German Classic success of the season. Schutz also scored with the filly Elle Danzig (Ger) in the G2 Henkel-Rennen (German 1000 Guineas) and G2 Preis der Diana (German Oaks). Unraced as a juvenile, Robertico broke his maiden at Hanover May 3, then won the Rivo-Rennen over a mile and a quarter at Baden-Baden May 24; he came into the Derby off a third-place finish behind Derby favorite LANCIANO (GER) (Surumu {Ger}) on a very soft track at Cologne in the G2 Oppenheim-Colonia Union-Rennen over a mile and three-eighths June 14. This win takes his record to three wins from five lifetime starts. The German Derby field, following a moderate pace, was strewn across the track as some jockeys looked for better ground. Robertico moved up on the inside rail before they turned into the stretch, quickened to challenge Nadour El Bahr (Ire), who had taken over at the top of the lane, and these two raced neck and neck to the line, with Robertico proving the stronger. Favorite Lanciano could finish only 17th after appearing to go lame.

Racing in Grade I company his last two starts, Banker's Gold had been second in the seven-furlong Carter H. May 3 and second in the Met Mile May 25. Dropping a bit in search of his first win since taking a 1 1/16-mile Gulfstream allowance race in February, the colt pressed the pace from the inside, swung out for the stretch drive, took over late and held on over the fast-closing Boundless Moment. "I let them battle on the lead and I just waited to make my move," said winning jockey Jorge Chavez. "I thought I was home free at the sixteenth pole until I saw (Boundless Moment) coming. We had just enough to hold him off." Winner of the GI Peter Pan S. at a mile and an eighth last year, trainer Allen Jerkens said the colt may stretch out once again and go for the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga August 8 next. "I think he can go a lot further if you can rate him," he said. The 4-5 favorite RICTER SCALE (*Habitony), looking for his third consecutive graded win, dueled on the front end early, taking a short lead after a half, but tired and finished fifth. "He just didn't finish like he did in his last two wins, for whatever reason," said his jockey, Jerry Bailey.

Hookedonthefeelin had made only one previous start, a 1 1/2-length victorious debut June 8. The chestnut filly jumped out to the early lead and drew off easily in the stretch under a hand ride. "I haven't had a two-year-old win like that since Serena's Song," said winning rider Gary Stevens who won the Landaluce S. aboard that filly in 1994. "She basically just galloped all the way around with not much effort to it at all. She acts like she'll go on. I didn't expect to be on the lead; she just kind of dragged me there with a high-powered gallop." Stevens swept the three weekend stakes at Hollywood over the weekend; the American H. with Magellan, Beverly Hills H. with Squeak and the Landaluce. Jockey Chris McCarron was second in all three events.

Local News, South Africa:

The three-year-old colt **Classic Flag (SAf)** (Allied Flag, by Danzig) established two new records when winning South Africa's premier race, the \$178,396 Rothmans July H. over a mile and three-eighths at Greyville in Durban on Saturday. In addition to breaking the track and race record, setting a new mark of 2:12.09, Classic Flag became the first horse to win the event from his outside post position of 18 in the field of 18. Ridden by Anthony Delpech, Classic Flag won convincingly by a length and a half from the five-year-old mare **Faralmond (Arg)** (Farnesio {Arg}), to give champion trainer David Ferraris his second straight win in the race. Four-year-old gelding **Golden Hoard (SAf)** (All Fired Up, by Timeless Moment), winner of the recent G1 Nissan Challenge and runner-up in the Rothmans a year ago, finished a head away third. Classic Flag's win was his seventh in 10 starts this season.

On the same Greyville program, two-year-old colt **Gold Tax (SAf)** (Goldkeeper, by Mr. Prospector) won the G1 Premier's Championship over a mile. Trained by James Goodman and ridden by Stuart Randolph, Gold Tax beat the previously unbeaten **Lucy's Lad (SAf)** (Jallad, by Blushing Groom {Fr}) by a length. Gold Tax, whose sire Goldkeeper stands in Zimbabwe, has now won three of his seven starts.

Cinemine won the Grapevine S. over this track in April and returned to finish third in the Park City S. May 9 before a sixth-place effort in the June 7 Mesquite Mile last time out. The longest shot in the field of eight dueled for the lead from the start, enjoyed a clear advantage at the half-mile pole and confidently drew off again when challenged at the top of the stretch. "She's a pretty nice filly," said winning trainer Larry Robideaux. "She's probably an under-rated filly. I felt that if she didn't run a good race, she had a heck of an excuse and it was up to me to fix the excuse. She has the ability, but I'm supposed to find out what is going to help her run." The victory gave jockey Alex Jiminez the first stakes win of his career.

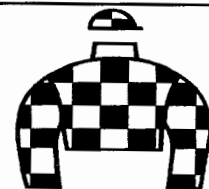
