### SARATOGA SALES CATALOGUES AVAILABLE

**SHAAMIT TO SOUTH AFRICA** Khalifa Dasmal's 1996 Epsom Derby winner **Shaamit (Ire)** (Mtoto {GB}) will become not only the first Epsom Derby winner to shuttle to South Africa for the Southern Hemisphere breeding season, but also the first British-based stallion to stand in that country later this month. Based at The National Stud in Newmarket, England during the Northern Hemisphere season, Shaamit, whose first crop of foals arrived this year, will be based in a specially created 'free zone' at Kenilworth racecourse in Cape Town so that he can return directly to Europe after the season without having to endure months of quarantine in another country.

**VICTORY GALLOP BREEZES AT CHURCHILL** GI Belmont S. winner **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance) worked five furlongs in 1:03 1/5 at Churchill yesterday morning. It was his second breeze since his nose victory in the final leg of the Triple Crown June 6. "He went good," said trainer Elliott Walden. "We're going to come back and work him three-quarters next week in company and we'll go from there." The three-year-old will make his next start August 9, either in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park or the GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga.

He makes his first stakes start. Last year's G1 Italian Derby hero **Single Empire (Ire)** makes his first appearance since finishing 11th in the '97 Epsom Derby 13 months ago.

She makes her second start. **Pipalong (Ire)** won her first two outings before running second in the G3 Queen Mary S. to the highly regarded Bint Allayl in her latest June 17. **Spirit Willing (Ire)**, a seven-length winner in her last effort June 20, is a half-sister to 1987 Irish champion three-year-old filly Unite (Ire) (Kris {GB}), winner of both the English and Irish Oaks.

Now five, the gelding has been undergoing an experimental enzyme treatment at owners Robert and Barbara Walter's Vine Hill Ranch in Sebastapol, California in an attempt to rehabilitate his injured tendon. Winner of the G1 Santa Anita Derby at three, Cavonnier has a record of six wins, three seconds and two thirds in 16 starts for earnings of \$1,139,397.
