FAVORITE TRICK WORKS FOR LONG BRANCH

Favorite Trick (Phone Trick) will make his next start in the \$100,000 8.5-furlong Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth Park July 19, trainer Bill Mott confirmed yesterday. "That's our plan," said Mott, who decided to skip the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park this Sunday in favor of the Long Branch. "I want to see him run at Monmouth Park. The Long Branch gives us another week, time to give him another long work, and it gives him a race over the track." The colt had that long work yesterday morning at Belmont, going seven furlongs in 1:29 3/5. "He went very well," said Mott. "We had missed a little time with him--he bruised a foot--but that was about a month back. It's well behind him now. He seems to be doing fine. If he runs well (in the Long Branch), we'll consider the Haskell (GI, August 9). His race will tell us which way we should go."

HINE GETS HIS ISELIN WISH Monmouth Park is expected to announce today that it has changed the conditions of its Aug. 30 GI Iselin H. to lure **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) to the race. According to Monmouth's Vice President and General Manager Bob Kulina, "It's pretty much a done deal." Kulina said he had to finalize a few details with trainer Sonny Hine today and hoped to have the loose ends tied up by this afternoon. Kulina confirmed that the distance of the race will be changed from a mile and a sixteenth to a mile and an eighth and that the purse will be increased. The race is currently worth \$250,000. The new value of the race has yet to be determined. Kulina admits that it was a difficult decision and is anticipating that it will stir up some controversy. "What ultimately won me over was that we have great fan support here and should I let tradition stand in the way of giving the public what it wants, the chance to see a major star?" Kulina said. "We went through all the negatives and positives and think this will be a good thing for New Jersey racing." Skip Away, stabled at Monmouth the last three summers, won the GI Haskell at the track as a three-year-old and was second in last year's Iselin.

Champion Sprinter honors and the Breeders' Cup Sprint beckon for Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's homebred Elnadim, who relished the fast ground and wired this high-class field for his first win in three starts this year. Runner-up in his first start this year in the G3 Duke Of York S. May 14, Elnadim then disliked the patchy ground when third in the G2 Temple S. at Sandown May 25. However, knowing his fondness for a fast track, the bettors made him the 3-1 chalk here and watched him take one-tenth of a second off the course mark. Winning trainer John Dunlop said, "He's a serious horse with a beautiful pedigree and a lovely temperament, a pleasure to train. Everyone kept telling me when he won the (G2) Diadem S. at Ascot last September that he would be champion sprinter this year, and he has shown here the horse he really is. He loves this fast ground. Sheikh Hamdan has earmarked the Breeders' Cup Sprint and why not? We might go to the (G1) Nunthorpe S. at York first (Aug. 20). He's got plenty of speed for the five furlongs there and the drop back in distance wouldn't bother me. There is also the (G1) Haydock Park S. (Sept. 5) and the (G1) Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp (Oct. 4)." Roger Charlton, trainer of runner-up Tamarisk (Ire), was pleased with his charge's effort, saying, "I'm delighted. This was a big step up in class from a listed race at Lingfield, where he had everything in his favor, to a Group One."

CHIEF HONCHO DEAD Chief Honcho (Chief's Crown) was found dead in his paddock Tuesday at Wintergreen Farm in Midway, Kentucky. An autopsy will be conducted to determine the cause of death. The 11-year-old stallion raced for five years, earning victories in the 1992 GI Brooklyn H., 1991 GII Excelsior H. and the 1990 GII Jim Dandy S. and was on the board in seven other Grade I races. From 34 starts, Chief Honcho won 10 races and earned \$1,265,719. He was campaigned by Bertram and Matthew Firestone and was trained by Bill Mott. His first foals are three-year-olds of 1998.

TATTERSALLS JULY ENDS Tattersalls July Mixed Sale in Newmarket, England concluded yesterday. High price at the final session was paid for hip number 280 **Salamah (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), a winner of two of eight starts in England. Consigned by Juddmonte Farms, the four-year-old gelding brought a final bid of \$161,457 from Danny Murphy. Over the four sessions of the sale, 219 horses sold for a total of \$3,505,206 and an average of \$16,005. The average sales price decreased 13.6 percent from \$18,519 a year ago.

It was an impressive debut for Robert Sangster's homebred Commander Collins (Ire), who was sent off the 4-5 favorite despite taking on four previous winners. But he did the job in style after running greenly early on, refusing to settle. Once jockey John Reid set him about his task, he quickened well on the outside at the three-sixteenths pole to catch the leader Rhapsodist, a stakes winner at Royal Ascot, and powered home for a clever win, suggesting he has a bright future. "He could be a Guineas horse next year," said winning trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam, "but we'll take our time deciding where to go next with him. He has a choice of several big events over seven furlongs or a mile, but he does need more experience."

Local News, Virginia:

Colonial Downs recently concluded its first harness racing meeting, but the Virginia track is still without a signed contract from its Thoroughbred horsemen. The second Thoroughbred meeting at the track is scheduled to begin August 27. Joe DeFrancis, president of the Maryland Jockey Club which manages Thoroughbred racing at Colonial Downs, told the *Harness Tracks of America Newsletter*, "Every day that passes without our being able to put out a condition book and begin the process of telling horsemen definitely when the meet will be in Virginia and recruiting horses is harmful. And that increases geometrically with the passage of time."

Local News, Maryland:

A record 825 two-year-olds have been nominated for lifetime eligibility in the Maryland Million program. The 13th running of Maryland Million Day is scheduled for Saturday, October 17 at Laurel Park. The latest group of juveniles made eligible for the stallion stakes program represents 65 percent of the entire Maryland-sired foal crop of 1996, another record.

Local News, Florida:

The Second Circuit Court in Tallahassee has ruled in favor of three Thoroughbred owners in Florida who argued that it was unconstitutional to withhold the one-percent money from purses to fund the Florida Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. Owners Donald Rudder, David Margulies and William Meyers sued the Florida Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, and argued through their attorney that the one percent taken from purse money to support the horsemen, "...is gained through an unlawful exercise of the police power and the (statute) contains no provision for how the funds collected must be spent in the furtherance of a legitimate state interest." Margulies said, "Who gave the horsemen permission to fund those concerts (held at Calder and Gulfstream) with our purse money? Very little of the money spent goes to benevolent purposes." Judge Terry Lewis told the division that the withholding of purse money was unlawful and is unconstitutional. Debbie Miller, director of the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, issued a directive to the Florida tracks stating the court's decision and informing the tracks that they "...are no longer required to withhold one percent from the total purse pool, nor required to pay such funds to the horsemen's association." Ken Dunn, president of Calder, said, "We have a contract with the horsemen and we are honoring the contract which calls us to pay the one percent." FHBPA president Scott Savin and executive director Kent Stirling were unavailable for comment.
