ISELIN PURSE DOUBLED The purse for the GII Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park has been increased from \$250,000 to \$500,000 and trainer Sonny Hine said yesterday that **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) will be there. "I gave my word that I would come if they changed the distance of the race and if the purse put me in the position to win \$10 million (with Skip Away) before the Breeders' Cup, and my word is my bond," said Hine. "The (\$500,000) purse will enable me to get to \$10 million. If we just won the Woodward and the Jockey Club Gold Cup, it would only give us \$900,000, and we need \$1 million and change to get there." Skip Away has earned \$8,906,360 to date. Cigar, the leading American Thoroughbred racehorse in history, earned \$9,999,813. As expected, the distance of the Iselin has also been increased, from 1 1/16 miles to 1 1/8 miles, its distance from 1979 to 1994. Skip Away used the race as a prep for the Woodward last year, finishing second to Formal Gold in both, and Hine said yesterday he would not run his horse that short again. "I had no intention of running 1 1/16 miles," he said. "It's not fair to the horse. They want him to carry 131 pounds in the Iselin. It wouldn't be fair if he had to do that sprinting. The horse has got to come first." Bob Kulina, vice president of Monmouth and the Meadowlands, said he did discuss Skip Away's weight assignment with Hine, adding, "It's very unfair to talk about that until you know who you are weighting, but in this day and age, a one-pound pick-up is about what we do." Skip Away won the GIII MassCap at Suffolk Downs under 130 pounds, his highest impost ever, before taking the weight-for-age June 28 Hollywood Gold Cup carrying 128. He will make his next start in the Iselin, skipping a possible outing in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga August 8. "I know if I push for the Whitney, I'll be pushing too hard," said Hine. "He's coming back to himself, but he won't breeze for awhile. With the Iselin being August 30, I have a lot of time to work on his feet and his legs and get everything perfect."

Brave Deed (Alydeed) followed three straight allowance wins at Churchill with a strong third in the June 7 GI Acorn S. at Belmont after dueling with MGISW Jersey Girl for the first three-quarters. Breaking from the rail today, she sports bullet works and appears poised for a big effort. **Santaria** (Star de Naskra), winner of the New Jersey Futurity at the Meadowlands last November in her career debut, has run second in three of her last four starts, all graded stakes. Her most recent runner-up finishes came in the April 18 GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland and the Acorn. **Kirby's Song** (Sultry Song) has been beating up on Canadian-bred opponents, winning Woodbine's GII C Fury S. May 9 and GIC Canadian Oaks June 6, but her previous open stakes tries have resulted in out-of-the-money finishes.

TOUCH GOLD SHARP AT CHURCHILL Touch Gold (Deputy Minister), winner of the 1997 Belmont S. and Haskell Invitational, worked five furlongs in a bullet 1:00 at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. The four-year-old, who came back after nearly eight months on the sidelines to take a Churchill allowance test June 28, went his final quarter in :22 3/5 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 2/5. "He went very well," said trainer Pat Byrne. "He picked up another horse in the lane and man, he really finished." Byrne is pointing both Touch Gold and stablemate **Awesome Again** (Deputy Minister), who bested champion Silver Charm in the GII Stephen Foster H. last out, for the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga August 8, but said only one of the two will run there.

HERB MCCAULEY INJURED Jockey Herb McCauley, thrown when his mount, Merri Soul, was carried wide on the first turn during the fourth race at Monmouth Park yesterday, suffered compound fractures of the left tibia and fibula and underwent surgery at Monmouth Medical Center yesterday afternoon. "He's in the operating room right now," said McCauley's agent, Joey DiAngelo, at 7 p.m. last night. "He broke one bone completely in half, and has a couple of cracks as well. He's in really rough shape. The doctor (Dr. Christopher Johnson) wasn't quite sure what he was going to do--if he'd be putting a rod in the bone or if he'd put plates on either side. He told me he would know more once he got in there."

CORRECTION: A local news item in the "East Report" of Tuesday's TDN reported that Monmouth Park led all U.S. tracks in attendance over the Fourth of July weekend, with 40,579 at that track July 3-5. In fact, Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas was tops in attendance over the holiday weekend. After setting a track record when a crowd of 27,105 came through the gates Friday, July 3, Lone Star Park enjoyed a total attendance of 48,403 for the three days.

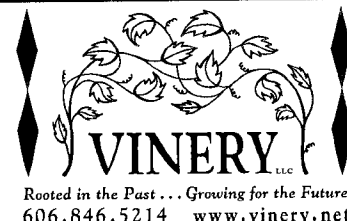
