CHIEF BEARHART BEATEN IN BOWLING

GREEN Last year's champion turf horse **Chief Bearhart** (Chief's Crown), who closed from last to win the GI Manhattan H. at Belmont June 6, was victimized by a pedestrian pace in yesterday's GII Bowling Green H. and finished third, 4 1/4 lengths behind 9-1 winner **Cetewayo** (His Majesty). **Officious** (Magesterial) was second. Last through six furlongs in 1:14.93 and a mile in 1:38.46, the GI Breeders' Cup Turf champion was still trailing the field as they swung into the stretch, making some headway late to save the show bettors as the 3-10 favorite. "It was just one of those things," said his trainer, Mark Frostad. "There was too slow of an early pace and he just didn't get moving soon enough. The weight (124 pounds, 12 more than the winner and runner-up) he carried may have also been a factor. He gave somewhat of a mediocre performance. He fired, it was just that he did it a little too late." The winner, **Cetewayo**, ran for a \$13,000 tag on the dirt at Philly Park last September, one start after losing his rider in his turf debut at Keeneland in April, 1997, but is now three-for-five since returning to the grass. "This horse has been really improving as of late and he's gaining much more confidence with each race," said winning trainer Michael Dickinson. (*Bowling Green chart, p2*)

MCCAULEY SURGERY A SUCCESS Jockey Herb McCauley, injured in a spill at Monmouth Park Friday afternoon, underwent successful surgery to repair his broken left leg at Monmouth Medical Center Friday evening. "They put a rod in his leg, and the doctors said the surgery went better than they had thought," said McCauley's agent, Joey DiAngelo. "But his back is black and blue, and it's possible he might have done something to his hip. They took him for X-rays (yesterday) and we're waiting for the doctor to read them." DiAngelo added that if there is no major problem with McCauley's hip, and no infection from the compound fracture, the jockey could be out of the hospital as soon as Tuesday. He will be out of action for about three to four months.

Kirby's Song, tired of her reputation as a homebody, came through with her first win south of the Canadian border to post a rallying win here. The Canadian-bred was not only winless away from Toronto's Woodbine racetrack, she had never even finished in the money out of that country. The filly was fifth in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Hollywood Park; she ran fifth in the GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream and seventh in the GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park this year. "In Florida, she was running eight-wide the whole trip," said trainer Tino Attard. "At Oaklawn, it was a bad racetrack for her and she hurt her foot a little bit. It was just bruised, but she has had some foot problems in the past. So we took her back home and got her into top shape. We glue her shoes on now, we don't use nails. She's is really good right now." Attard also changed equipment after the Fantasy, and the three-year-old is now undefeated since the addition of a tongue tie. She bounced back to pick up her fourth Woodbine win in the Fury S. in May and added the Canadian Oaks in her last start June 6. She shipped down to Monmouth two weeks ago, showed a liking for the track with a sparkling workout July 4 and ran back to the breeze to run down Santaria in the stretch and draw clear. "We knew there was a lot of speed in the race and I didn't want to get too far back," said winning jockey Todd Kabel. "We had good position and when I asked her around the far turn, she really took off. I was urging her on, but she's that type of filly. This race proves that she can win outside of Canada." The 6-5 favorite Brave Deed, trying a two-turn race for the first time, pressed the pace, but tired late to be third.

Overlooked at 9-1, Cetewayo was taking on no less than champion Chief Bearhart in his graded-stakes debut, but came through, closing from fifth to catch Officious in the stretch and pulling away to his fourth win in his last five starts. A claiming horse while racing on the dirt who dropped his jockey in his turf debut at Keeneland in April, 1997, the bay picked up his first turf win in an allowance race at the Meadowlands last October, took the winter off, and returned to win a Pimlico allowance in April. He was second stretching out to a mile and a half at Pimlico in May, but came back to win the Sir Ivor S. at that distance at Laurel June 24. "His owner (Dr. John Chandler) wanted to go in this spot in the worst way and he had a lot of confidence that this horse would run very well," said trainer Michael Dickinson. "Chief Bearhart didn't have it today and luckily for us, we did. My horse ran his race...he was relaxed and he made that one strong move at the end." The winner goes next in the GIC Hong Kong Jockey Club S. at Woodbine July 26. Champion Chief Bearhart, coming off a win in the GI Manhattan H. June 6, rallied from last to get third. Trainer Mark Frostad said he would take a look at the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga August 15 next. "There are a lot of big races ahead of him," he said.

On the board in all three Triple Crown races and winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby and GII Swaps S. last year, Free House had not been seen since running sixth as the 7-10 chalk in the GI Super Derby last September 28. Back after the 10-month absence, the grey was bet down to 4-5 and ran to those odds, sitting off the pace set by Wild Wonder through rapid fractions, sweeping to the lead on the final bend and galloping away to a convincing score. "I was worried about bleeding, because he bled in the Super Derby," said trainer Paco Gonzalez, "but he looks pretty good. He looks like he's not stressed. I think he is more mature now--he's stronger, he's more relaxed. We hope he stays this way." Added co-owner John Toffan, "I think we'll find out in the Pacific Classic (Aug. 15 at Del Mar) where we're at."

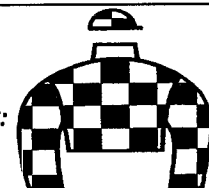
