OXX TAKES OAKS FOR SECOND

STRAIGHT YEAR Giving trainer John Oxx his second straight win in this Irish Classic, **Winona (Ire)** (Alzao) answered all questions about her stamina with a total rout of the field in yesterday's G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks at The Curragh. Always traveling smoothly, the three-year-old quickened her stride at the quarter-mile pole as the 4-5 favorite **Bahr (GB)** (Generous {Ire}) grabbed the lead; she put the crowd's choice away in just a few jumps and went clear for an impressive seven-length strike at 12-1. **Kitza (Ire)** (Danehill) got up for second. Although she had gone without a win since breaking her maiden on her debut at Leopardstown in July, 1997, Winona had run well earlier this year, finishing fourth in G1 Airlie-Coolmore Irish 1000 Guineas here May 24 and then running a strong-finishing third in the G1 Coronation S. at Ascot June 17. The Oaks was her second win from seven lifetime starts, and takes her career earnings to \$207,475. She will now stay in Group 1 class, aiming for the G1 Yorkshire Oaks at York August 19 and the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp September 13. "We weren't sure how she would copy with a mile and a half," said Oxx, who took the 1997 Irish Oaks with the Aga Khan's Ebadiyla (Ire), "but it helped when the pace slowed at the top of the hill. We thought beforehand that a mile and a quarter might be her best trip, but we're delighted that a mile and a half looks to be her best distance." Winona's rider Johnny Murtagh added: "Once the pace steadied, I was confident. I tracked Bahr early in the straight and then Winona picked up brilliantly." Bahr, runner-up in the Vodafone Oaks at Epsom June 5 and winner of the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Ascot June 18, was reported to be "blowing hard" after the race; blood samples were taken from her to rule out any physical problems.

A longshot in this field, Winona (Ire) was stretching out beyond a mile for the first time after finishing third in the G1 Coronation S. at that distance at Royal Ascot June 17. Looking for her first win since breaking her maiden 51 weeks ago, the bay filly was rated mid-pack as GLOROSIA (IRE) (Bering {GB}) set the pace. The 4-5 favorite Bahr (Ire) took over two furlongs from the wire, but Winona motored right past and drew well away to win easily.

The easiest kind of maiden winner in her first start May 10, Manistique also trounced allowance foes in her two-turn bow, winning by 10 lengths in her second appearance June 4. Handling graded-stakes company with equal disdain, the dark bay allowed **VISIBLE SLEW** (Seattle Slew) to set the pace for a half, cruised into the lead on the far turn and put her four rivals away under mild encouragement from jockey Gary Stevens. "She was awesome, just like she was in her first two outs," said Stevens, who picked up the mount from Corey Nakatani, who was playing in the \$500,000 Isuzu Celebrity Gold Championship. "She's just a big, fluid-moving filly and she's going to win a whole bunch of these because she's really special. She was very nervous in the post parade and really got more excited than I would have liked. I thought...I was going to have my hands full, but midway around the first turn she came back to me nicely." Trainer John Shirreffs said there was "a 90-percent chance" Nakatani, who finished 22nd in the golf tournament behind the winner, ice hockey star Mario Lemieux, would be back aboard Manistique next time out.

Seemingly cured of his pre-race behavior problems, Coronado's Quest registered his third businesslike win in a row with an easy victory over four others. In his second race since being sidelined with a bruised foot, Coronado's Quest showed good early speed to gain control of the race on the backstretch, moved to the rail on the turn and drew off easily under a hand ride. "This colt is the bomb," said regular jockey Mike Smith. "He ran great and gave a real professional performance. He loaded well, broke well and behaved perfectly." Trainer Shug McGaughey was pleased as well, saying, "I have to consider this one of his best races so far." Things are right on schedule for the winner of the Gil Wood Memorial S. and Gil Riva Ridge S. He will go next in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth August 9 where opponents could include Real Quiet and Victory Gallop. "It will be an interesting race for him and we'll probably go up to Monmouth a few days before just to school him in the paddock," said McGaughey. Third-place finisher Scatmandu banged his head on the gate and was bleeding from his left nostril, which may have compromised his late run.

Running before a crowd of 90,757, two sons of Sunday Silence came home one-two in the final Grade 1 race of Japan's spring season--runners for the event were voted in by the racing fans. Post time was delayed five minutes when MEJIRO BRIGHT (JPN) (Mejiro Ryan {Jpn}) reared in the starting gate and had to be moved to the outside post position before the race could start. Once underway, favored Silence Suzuka (Jpn) set all the pace, leading by three lengths as they came into the stretch and holding on to the wire from the late-closing Stay Gold (Jpn). The winner has now won eight of his 13 career starts and earned more than \$2.2 million. Top vote-getter Air Groove (Jpn) came on for third. Jockey Katsumi Minai, aboard the winner for the first time as a substitute for regular rider Yutaka Take, said, "The colt ran well. The pace was ideal so in the final stretch he still had more speed left. I'm relieved that I was able to fulfill everyone's expectations as a pinch-hitter."

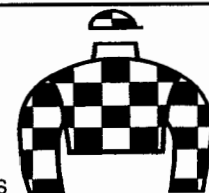
