**FILLY AND MARE TURF RACE ADDED TO BREEDERS' CUP A** \$1 million turf race for fillies and mares will be added to Breeders' Cup Championship Day beginning in 1999 at Gulfstream Park, Breeders' Cup Ltd. announced yesterday. The new race, approved by the board of directors yesterday, will be called the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. It is open to fillies and mares, three-years-old and up, and will be run at 1 1/4-miles on the turf when the Breeders' Cup site permits. Due to the configuration of Gulfstream's seven-furlong turf course, the race will be run at 1 3/8 miles next year. The new race will bring the total value of the eight-race championship card to \$13 million. "We are very pleased to add the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf to our program of championship races," said Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief, Jr. "In creating this new race, we have responded to the interests of owners and breeders in North America and overseas who have long desired increased earnings opportunities for female turf horses. At the same time, the Filly and Mare Turf also completes our goal of impacting all of the flat racing Eclipse Award categories for championship day."

**EXOTIC WOOD RETIRED** Multiple Grade I stakes winner **Exotic Wood** (Rahy) has been retired from racing after suffering a slight bow in her left fore tendon. The six-year-old mare, owned by Martin and Pam Wygod and trained by Ron Ellis and David Hofmans, captured the 1996 GI Go for Wand H. and the 1998 editions of the GI Santa Maria H. and GI Santa Monica H. She was runner-up in the final two starts of her career, the March 8 GI Santa Margarita and June 28 GII A Gleam H. Hofmans said the bow was discovered after the mare worked four furlongs in :53 3/5 at Hollywood Park on July 9. "She's done enough, it would make no sense to keep racing her," said Hofmans. Exotic Wood won 11 of 17 races for earnings of \$890,695. No 1999 breeding plans have been made.

**DONALD BROWN WINS DOMINION AWARD**

Donald J. "Peanut Butter" Brown has been named winner of the 1998 Dogwood Dominion Award, presented annually to an "unsung hero" in the Thoroughbred industry, Dogwood Stable President Cot Campbell announced yesterday. Brown--selected from 61 nominations by judges Anne Campbell, Pat Day and Mack Miller--will receive a cash award of \$5,000 and a bronze of Dominion, Dogwood's popular stakes campaigner of the mid-seventies, at a luncheon at the Saratoga Reading Room on August 5. "Peanut Butter Brown is a self-appointed guardian angel to the down and out on backstretches from New Jersey to Florida," Campbell said. "He has worked tirelessly since 1971, creating softball leagues, organizing major fund-raising activities for such charities as the Donald MacBeth Fund and the Horse Retirement Foundation, and many a race tracker has had a roof over his head or a job to report to in the morning because of the kindness and concern of Peanut Butter. From the time he came on the race track as a hot-walker (with a jar of peanut butter and \$2 to his name), he has been a credit to the sport because of his deep concern for downtrodden race trackers."
