FAVORITE TRICK RETURNS TODAY Making his first start since an eighth-place finish in the May 2 Kentucky Derby, 1997 Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick) will face six rivals in today's \$100,000 Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth Park. "He's doing very well," said trainer Bill Mott, at Monmouth yesterday to saddle Daylight Savings to a half-length win in the GIII Oceanport H. "He's rested up from his ordeal at the Derby. That set him back a little bit, but he's back on his game now." A big race in the Long Branch could earn Favorite Trick a return trip to the Jersey Shore for the Aug. 9 \$1 million GI Buick Haskell Invitational, but Mott added, "We'll see how he runs (today). If he runs extremely well, the Haskell is a possibility, but we want to get through (the Long Branch), then make a decision."

SKIP AWAY BACK ON WORK TAB Two-time Eclipse champ **Skip Away** (Skip Trial) had his first work since winning the June 28 GI Hollywood Gold Cup yesterday at Belmont Park, going a half in :47 under jockey Jerry Bailey. Confirming that the five-year-old popped a splint in the Gold Cup, trainer Sonny Hine said, "He was so tired after California that we wanted to rest him a little. Then he started to fill up and we knew we had to do something with him. I'm glad I didn't wait an extra week like I was going to or we would have been too far behind with him. Now we'll go to Saratoga and get ready for the Iselin." Skip Away will make his next start in the Aug. 30 \$500,000 GII Philip H. Iselin H. at Monmouth Park, but he also could make a public appearance in upstate New York. The New York Racing Association is hoping to get Hine to give his horse a work between races August 15 or 16. "I think it's a great idea," said Hine. "I'm all for it, because it would be a chance to give something back to his fans."

EARLY TIMES TO SPONSOR HOLLYWOOD

DERBY Early Times Kentucky Whiskey has signed a three-year contract with Hollywood Park to sponsor the track's richest three-year-old turf race, which will now be known as the \$500,000 Early Times Hollywood Derby. The 59th running of the 1 1/8-mile race, which was sponsored by Crown Royal from 1995-97, will be televised nationally on Sunday, November 29. The Early Times Hollywood Derby is one of five Grade I events at the Hollywood Park fall meet, which runs November 11 through December 21.

Coming off an impressive win in the GIII Finger Lakes Breeders' Cup H. June 20, Kelly Kip got his fifth win of the year at his fifth different track, pressing the pace outside and drawing off in the stretch to an impressive score that was just two ticks off the track record. This was the first time that the winner of the GIII Bold Ruler at Aqueduct April 11 and the Suffolk Downs Breeders' Cup H. May 30 was able to put together back-to-back victories this year. Affirmed Success came on well to be second after breaking awkwardly and racing wide.

Auntie Mame capped off her three-year-old season, where she had won five stakes including the GII Rare Perfume at Belmont September 13, with a courageous second to eventual female turf champion Ryafan in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. Laid off for the winter, she returned to be third by a neck in the GII Black Helen H. at Hialeah April 11. In her last race, against colts in the GII Dixie at Pimlico May 16, she had what trainer Angel Penna Jr. called "an unsettling experience," checking twice and losing two shoes before finishing fifth. Sent off as the second choice this time, Auntie Mame tracked the leaders on the outside in third, moved three-wide on the far turn, gained the lead in midstretch and dug in to hold off the favored runner-up Tresoriere. Of future plans, Penna said, "There are two races at Saratoga that I'm thinking about running her in. The Glens Falls H. (1 3/8 miles on turf August 14) or the Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup H. (1 1/16 miles on turf August 16)."

Old Trieste (A.P. Indy) quickly erased the memories of his 24-length defeat in the Kentucky Derby by coming back June 21 to wire the GIII Affirmed H. at Hollywood by 4½ lengths. His chances in this race will depend on whether another speedster, **Shot Of Gold** (Jolie's Halo), forces a rapid early pace. That one, the winner of Turfway's Rushaway S. March 29, has won five of his last six starts and could get his first graded win here. Waiting in the garden spot behind them will be GI Champagne S. winner **Grand Slam** (Gone West). After taking the GII Peter Pan at Belmont May 24, he contested the pace in the Belmont S. before fading to finish seventh.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Either the heat got to her, or I don't know, but she was a little fatigued today. I think she's a little better than her performance."
