**NARROW WIN FOR FAVORITE TRICK** Reigning Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick), returning to the races for the first time since an eighth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby, eked out a narrow head win in yesterday's Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth Park. Sent off the prohibitive 1-5 favorite in the field of six, the dark bay colt dueled with allowance winner **Tomorrows Cat** (Storm Cat) throughout and just prevailed over that rival at the wire, stopping the clock in 1:43 for the 1 1/16 miles. "It was a workmanlike win," commented trainer Bill Mott, who inherited Favorite Trick from Pat Byrne after the colt's unbeaten two-year-old campaign. "He didn't kick away at the end, but the horse knew he had them at all times. He did what he had to do, that's his temperament." Mott said Favorite Trick could see action next in Monmouth's Aug. 9 GI Buick Haskell, Saratoga's Aug. 9 GII Jim Dandy or the Aug. 29 GII King's Bishop.

**KEENELAND JULY OPENS TODAY** A total of 229 horses have been catalogued for Keeneland's 52nd annual selected yearling sale which opens today in Lexington, Kentucky. The yearlings--138 colts and 91 fillies--will be sold during three sessions, Monday at 7:30 p.m. and Tuesday at 1:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. There are seven yearlings by Mr. Prospector, 12 by Storm Cat, seven by A.P. Indy, 14 by Danzig, nine by Nureyev, 1 by Sadler's Wells, 12 by Seattle Slew and 11 by Seeking the Gold. Among the yearlings in the sale are hip number 34, a full brother to Champion Older Horse **Pleasant Tap** (Pleasant Colony) and half to Kentucky Derby winner **Go for Gin** (Cormorant), hip number 54, a half brother by Deputy Minister to Champion Two-Year-Old **Chief's Crown** (Danzig), hip number 68, a half sister by Mr. Prospector to **West by West** (Gone West) and hip number 81, a half sister to Breeders' Cup Sprint champion **Desert Stormer** (Storm Cat) by Tabasco Cat. Also in the catalog, hip number 98, a half sister by Carson City to champion **Gilded Time** (Timeless Moment), hip number 145, a half brother by Seeking the Gold to champion **Prairie Bayou** (Little Missouri) and hip number 167, a half brother by Storm Cat to champion **Eliza** (Mt. Livermore).

Old Trieste set the pace before fading to 10th in the Kentucky Derby and returned to win the GIII Affirmed H. in his last start June 21. The chestnut speedster jumped out to the early lead, setting fractions of :23.1, :46, 1:09.2 and 1:34.1. He took a seven-length advantage into the stretch and stormed home by 12 lengths. "I took exception to people saying that we had a loose, lonely lead in the Affirmed," said winning trainer Mike Puype. "How do you chase a horse that runs 1:09 2/5 routing? This horse has incredible speed and you're going to get tired chasing that kind of speed. This was a quantum leap for him today--to run a mile and an eighth and run away from them." Winning rider Chris McCarron added, "This colt really has a ton of ability. I really liked him last summer when I got on him as a two-year-old, and he's just gotten better and better." Jerry Bailey, on the runner-up Grand Slam commented, "I guess I've got to tip my hat to the winner. I would have liked to see SHOT OF GOLD (Jolie's Halo) get away better and maybe press him, but I don't know if even that would have done it because Old Trieste really sparkled today. I mean, how much faster could Shot of Gold make him go?"

River Bay, twice a group stakes winner in France, captured the GI Hollywood Turf Cup last December in his second U.S. start and returned to finish second in his only 1998 effort, the May 25 GI Hollywood Turf H. Heavily favored, the chestnut broke slowly and was forced to steady when in tight quarters around the second turn, but made a three-wide bid at the top of the lane to take over at midstretch and drew clear late. "Last time, everything went wrong," said winning jockey Alex Solis, referring to his six-wide trip in the Turf H. "Fortunately, this time I saved ground and when I got to the four-and-a-half (furlong marker), I just tried to get him out in the clear, and that's where I won the race, right there. I got him out in the clear where he was able to run."

Classic Cat, winner of the GI Lexington in April, ran third in the GI Preakness and eighth in the GI Belmont in his last start June 6. Favored here, the chestnut colt settled off the pace early, reached contention turning for home and just prevailed in a long stretch drive for the second graded stakes win of his career. "My colt has had a plethora of foot problems, but obviously he didn't have them today," said winning trainer David Cross, Jr. "I don't think he's a Victory Gallop or Real Quiet, but he is a nice horse capable of winning a lot of money." Cross said the August 30 Remington Park Derby would be next for Classic Cat.

Lightly raced Public Purse, winner of June 18 G3 La Coupe at Longchamp in his only previous start this season, received a brilliant ride from jockey Olivier Peslier to register his fourth win from five starts. Racing in second spot, Public Purse was switched to the rail early in the stretch and after grabbing the lead had just enough left to resist the customary strong late drive of G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay winner Limnos (Jpn). "Olivier gave Public Purse a great ride," said Prince Khaled Abdullah's racing manager Grant Pritchard-Gordon. "Public Purse is an improving horse, but we have no definite plans for him until we talk to (trainer) Andre Fabre when he gets back from vacation."

After a long stewards' inquiry and a photo-finish, The Thoroughbred Corporation's Dr Fong, last out winner of the G1 St James' Palace S. over a mile at Ascot June 16, got his fifth win from seven starts, but only a nose separated him from defeat here and plans to run him in the 1 1/4-mile G1 Juddmonte International at York August 18 are now on hold. After tracking a good pace, Dr Fong went for the lead at the quarter-mile pole, only

to wander off a straight course towards Quel Senor (Fr), but jockey Kieren Fallon quickly straightened him and he looked like an easy winner--until Aware (GB) came from several lengths back to finish like a train and just miss at the wire. The stewards looked into Dr Fong's wandering off a straight line, but allowed the result to stand. Winning trainer Henry Cecil said, "I'm just not sure about the mile and a quarter being his trip and we'll have to think again about the Juddmonte International." Kieren Fallon adamantly stated that this was not the true Dr Fong. "He is much better than that. The pace was slow and I had to go much earlier than I wanted."

**RECORD PICK 6 AT HOLLYWOOD** A record \$3,869,771 was wagered on Hollywood Park's guaranteed \$1.5 million Pick 6 Saturday, shattering the mark of \$3,342,371 set June 14 when the track guaranteed a minimum Pick 6 pool of \$1 million. The record Pick 6 helped generate total handle of \$18,994,274, highest in track history with the exception of Breeders' Cup and Triple Crown events. The day's handle was up 74 percent from 1997. Twenty eight winners collected \$77,221.20 a piece. There were 2,755 tickets with five winners, worth \$336.20 each.

**HANGING ROAD TO DEVONIA STUD** Brian and Valeria Mills's Devonia Stud in Reddick, Florida has purchased three-quarters of **Hanging Road** (Gulch--Lambros, by In Reality) from Ocala-based bloodstock agent Billy Murphy. The six-year-old, a winner of seven of 44 races for earnings of \$130,235, will retire to stud at Devonia in 1999.

The bay colt, making his turf debut as the favorite, pressed the pace, took over easily when asked nearing the stretch and drew off confidently for his first graded stakes win. "He just ran a dynamite race and he definitely took a liking to the turf," said winning rider Mike Smith. "Neil (Howard) told me that he's usually far back, but today I should just ride him however the race comes up. That was good because I found myself on the lead right away. He broke well, he was in hand and after the mile and a quarter, he was still full of run." Trainer Neil Howard said the August 10 GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame H. at Saratoga could be next for **Parade Ground**.

## WRITERS UP

### THE YEARLING EXCHANGE *By Steve DeCaspers*

Nobu Araki, Osamu Yosuda and Taylor Made Sales Agency will make history tonight when the bidding starts on hip number 38 at the Keeneland July Sale. The chestnut filly by Brian's Time out of the Blushing Groom (Fr) mare Pink Turtle will be the first Japanese-bred sold at the country's premier select yearling sale. The second, a Sunday Silence filly out of Maplejinsky, will go as hip number 185 Tuesday night.

Tatersalls' sold a Japanese-bred yearling by Sunday Silence out of the Shirley Heights mare Lingerie (GB) for \$470,400 last year, but the Keeneland offerings are believed to be the first available in the U.S.

Although he would have characterized the comment as "half-joking," Taylor Made Sales Agency consultant Nobu Araki has pursued what prominent Japanese horse owner Osamu Yasuda said to him at last year's Keeneland November sale. What Yosuda said to grab Araki's attention was that he may be interested in selling a few of his yearling at the Keeneland July sale, particularly a filly by American classic winner and leading Japanese sire Sunday Silence out of multiple Grade-I winner and producer Maplejinsky.

It has been an interesting journey for both horses and horsemen. Araki first mentioned the idea to the Taylor brothers, and Taylor Made encouraged him to pursue it with Yosuda's racing manager Yoshiomi Onizuka.

The decision was pretty easy according to Duncan Taylor, who said, "In Sunday Silence, you've got the hottest sire over there, and coverage of Japanese racing has really improved and increased over the last five years. Being proactive, we decided to jump on it."

Taylor Made also has a lot of ties with Maplejinsky's family, having sold the mare and her half-brother Dayjur as well as Miraloma and Storm Beauty, who are both out of Maplejinsky's granddam Stick to Beauty. They will also consign a Danzig colt out of Maplejinsky's first daughter Sky Beauty at this year's July Sale.

Although the pioneering spirit of both Taylor Made and Osamu Yasuda contributed to the historic offering, completion of the deal came down to old-fashioned luck.

"The decision became contingent on Maplejinsky foaling another filly by Sunday Silence (this year)," said Araki. On March 12, after Maplejinsky foaled a full sister to hip number 185, "They told us to go ahead and enter the sale."

Taylor heavily praised the work of Araki, who had gone through his farm's 18-month internship program, saying, "I don't think we'd have been able to do this without Nobu."

After both horses were entered, they had to undergo inspection by Keeneland officials in Japan, then spend 30 days in quarantine there. Following a 17-hour flight, they were placed in U.S. quarantine for two days, finally arriving at the farm April 19. First impressions at Taylor Made were good, considering the journey both had undergone.

"The Sunday Silence is a more classic looking filly, while the Brian's Time is a quick and well-balanced type," he said.

While the yearlings are from very familiar American families, Araki expressed some concern over how the sires would be received. "Both Sunday Silence and Brian's Time aren't really known outside of Japan as stallions, but they have sired many outstanding runners."

In addition, their American racing records are still fresh in the minds of many breeders who regretted seeing them exported as stallion prospects to Japan in the first place. Sunday Silence was named 1989 Horse of the Year after never finishing worse than second in nine starts and winning the Kentucky Derby, Preakness, and Breeders' Cup Classic. Brian's Time won the GI Florida Derby and GI Pegasus H. during his three-year old season and earned over \$1 million.

Sunday Silence, having sired 10-percent stakes winners from starters, is the more celebrated sire of the two. His progeny include Dance Partner (Jpn), Japan's champion three-year-old filly of 1995 and older mare of 1996, as well as Fuji Kiseki (Jpn), the 1994 Champion two-year-old colt in Japan who retired undefeated in four starts. Another one moving toward the list of his top progeny is the recent winner of the Japanese Derby, Special Week (Jpn).

While Brian's Time gets only 6-percent stakes winners from starters, he has produced two Japanese Horses of the Year. Narita Brian (Jpn) won that honor in 1994 after taking all three legs of the Japanese Triple Crown.

Although there is no long term strategy in place for future selling of Japanese-bred horses in America, Duncan Taylor sees this offering as a significant step in the international aspect of commercial breeding. "Our culture has always seen the Japanese as only coming in and buying horses, but at some point that will change. We want to position ourselves to be a player when things start to go the other way."

### Maiden winners cont.
