GENTLEMEN SIZZLES WHERE SURF MEETS

TURF Getting ready for the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar August 15, **Gentlemen (Arg)** (Robin des Bois) worked six furlongs in a sizzling 1:10 4/5 Friday morning at the oceanside oval. The six-year-old, third in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 28, won last year's edition of the Pacific Classic. "He went real nice," said trainer Richard Mandella. "He galloped out seven furlongs in 1:23 and change and he looks like he's in very good shape." Jockey Corey Nakatani was aboard for the breeze and will be back in the saddle for the Pacific Classic, replacing Gary Stevens, who rides Silver Charm. Mandella is bidding for his third straight in the \$1 million event; he ended the great Cigar's 16-race winning streak with Dare And Go in the 1996 running of the race.

REAL QUIET TOPS HASKELL WEIGHTS Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **Real Quiet** (Quiet American) has been assigned high weight of 126 pounds for the \$1 million GI Buick Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park August 9. **Victory Gallop** (Cryptoclearance), who topped the top weight by a nose in the GI Belmont S. June 6, gets in the 1 1/8-mile race at 125 pounds, and **Coronado's Quest** (Forty Niner), who picked up his third straight graded-stakes score in the GII Dwyer H. July 12, was assigned 124. Horse of the Year **Favorite Trick** (Phone Trick), winner of the Long Branch Breeders' Cup H. at Monmouth in his latest, but still on the fence about the Haskell, is fourth on the list of weights at 123 pounds. According to the *Daily Racing Form*, Real Quiet worked six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 at Del Mar yesterday morning, galloping out the seven-eighths in 1:25 3/5. Explaining why he missed last weekend's GII Swaps S. with the colt, trainer Bob Baffert told the *Form*, "He was a little funky in his hind end, but he's over it. We're starting to lean on him now."

Royal Anthem won his career debut May 16 and followed that up with an allowance win at Newmarket June 6 and his first stakes victory in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Ascot June 19. Six-year-old **Swain (Ire)**, second in both the G1 Duabi World Cup March 28 and G1 Coronation Cup June 5, looks to rebound off a third-place finish in the G1 Hardwicke S. June 19.

With Jersey Girl passing because of the marathon distance, **Keeper Hill** (Deputy Minister) has inherited the favorite's role. The winner of the GI Las Virgenes at Santa Anita February 15 and the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1 was a fast-closing second in the GI Mother Goose at Belmont June 27 and seems best suited to the added distance. **Banshee Breeze** (Unbridled), winner of the GII Bonnie Miss at Gulfstream March 16 and second by a neck in the Kentucky Oaks, raced an even third in the Mother Goose last time and has the best chance to knock off the favorite.

Laid off after winning the March 28 G1 Dubai World Cup in dramatic fashion, **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) returned to the racetrack with a second-place finish to Awesome Again in the GII Stephen Foster H. at Churchill June 13. Although he was entered in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup June 28, he spiked a fever and had to be scratched. This race will serve as a prep for the GI Pacific Classic August 15. Late-running **Benchmark** (Alydar) closed his 1997 campaign with wins in the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. and the GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. and was second in last year's edition of this race. His June 28 return after nine months off in Hollywood's GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup, where he was third against crack sprinters going seven furlongs, should have him well prepped for this spot. **Mud Route** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) finished second to Silver Charm twice at Santa Anita earlier this year, and enters this off a fourth-place finish to Skip Away in the Hollywood Gold Cup.


