BAFFERT "BAFFLED" BY SILVER CHARM

Trainer Bob Baffert couldn't find anything wrong with **Silver Charm** (Silver Buck) after his first-ever off-the-board finish in Saturday's GIII San Diego H. at Del Mar. The Eclipse champ was last, 27 lengths behind **Mud Route** (Strawberry Road {Aus}) in the race. "He bled very slightly, but not enough to stop him," said Baffert yesterday. "I'm sort of baffled. His legs are fine--I've told 1,000 people this morning, we just don't know what happened." Asked if he thought the demanding trip to the Dubai World Cup was having a long-term effect on his colt, Baffert said, "I don't want to blame Dubai. At this time last year, the horse did kind of the same thing. He just wasn't doing well, that's why we stopped on him. We'll just see how he is in the next few days. We're going to take him back to the track this week, do some tests. We'll know better in a week what we're going to do with him."

PINCAY INJURED AT DEL MAR Hall of Fame jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. suffered a broken left collarbone and several cracked ribs in a two-horse spill in Del Mar's 10th race Saturday. Pincay's mount, Sid the Author, fell when caught in tight quarters at the three-quarter pole in the one-mile claiming race; Totana, ridden by Brice Blanc, jumped the fallen horse, unseating his jockey as well. Blanc was not seriously hurt and is expected to be back in the saddle today. Both horses appeared to be okay after the accident. Pincay, 51, had picked up his 888th win at Del Mar Friday, bringing him to within one of Bill Shoemaker's all-time record at the track. He will be out of action for four to seven weeks.

SKIP AWAY SHARP AT BELMONT MGISW Skip Away (Skip Trial), who picked up his seventh straight stakes win in the June 28 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, but came out of the race a little the worse for the wear, looked sharp at Belmont Park Saturday morning, working five furlongs in a bullet :59 1/5 with jockey Jerry Bailey aboard. "He went very easy," said trainer Sonny Hine. "That was about as slow as Jerry could hold him." As for the foot problems and the splint that popped up after the Gold Cup, Hine said, "The big thing was fatigue, I think, but he's pretty much over all that." The Hine stable heads to Saratoga today. Skip Away is scheduled to make his next start in the \$500,000 GII Iselin H. at Monmouth Park August 30.

Under a fine tactical ride from jockey Terence Hellier, Ungaro (Ger) went wire-to-wire for his second win from four starts this season; he picked up his second straight Group 1 success following his victory in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano in Italy June 21. SAUGERTIES (Trempolino) was expected to cut out the early fractions, but Ungaro went straight to the front from the gate, setting a moderate pace for a mile. He then quickened well early in the stretch and hung on bravely to withstand the strong challenge of the only three-year-old in the field, Tiger Hill (Ire), who could never get his head in front of the winner.

Most bettors would have been better off dropping a few quarters in the slot machines and pulling the arm rather than trying to pick the top three finishers of Delaware's marquee event. While odds-on favorite RELAXING RHYTHM (Easy Goer) and second choice AJINA (Strawberry Road {Aus}) contested the pace, 41-1 Amarillo sat seventh, made a four-wide move on the turn and survived a stretch duel with 25-1 Tuxedo Junction to get her first graded-stakes win. Timely Broad, off at 108-1, came from last to get third. "At the quarter pole I knew this was the right distance for her," said winning jockey Julie Krone. "She was so strong. At the eighth pole I still had a lot of horse." Amarillo had posted an allowance win at Belmont and a victory in the June 14 Monmouth Beach S. at Monmouth in four starts this year, and was most recently fourth in the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. at Monmouth July 4. As for the favorites, Relaxing Rhythm, undefeated in her first eight career starts and winner of the Molly Pitcher in her latest, stumbled slightly at the break, rushed up, then faded to seventh. "She was really laboring," said her jockey, Pat Day. "She just wasn't comfortable and when I asked her, she didn't respond. It just wasn't her day." Last year's champion three-year-old filly Ajina ended up sixth, but trainer Bill Mott had no excuse. "I don't know," he said. "She does this once in a while."

CAPE VERDI INJURED The Godolphin team has revealed that its three-year-old filly **Cape Verdi (Ire)** (Caerleon), winner of the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas May 3, but unplaced in the G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom June 6, has sustained a small, hairline fracture of a hind pastern and will be out of action indefinitely. Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford said, "With an injury like this, a full recovery takes time. We may be running out of time for her this season, but we hope she will recover fully and come back next year." Cape Verdi has won three of her six career starts, including the 1000 Guineas and the G2 Stakis Casinos Lowther S. at two, for earnings of \$312,100.

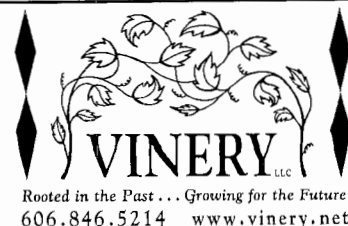
