NOVERRE DANCES TO SUSSEX VICTORY

Godolphin's **Noverre** (Rahy), defeated by a neck in the G1 St James' Palace S. and disqualified from a victory in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) several weeks after he won it, rallied on the far outside for a two length victory in the Champagne Lanson Sussex S. yesterday at Glorious Goodwood. Defeated at Royal Ascot in the one-mile St. James Palace June 19 by Black Minnaloushe, the blaze-faced bay was rested afterwards with this race in mind. Last week he was disqualified due to a positive drug test from his first place in the French 2000 Guineas May 13. He is quickly establishing himself as an international campaigner in the true Godolphin mold, improving with racing. "He's very brave and very tough," said Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum. "The way he did it was very pleasing and he's a good horse--he was working well. Now I think he's the best miler in Europe. He's tough and he takes his races." *Sussex cont. p2*

BAMBU SHOOTS TO SARATOGA STAKES WIN

Edward Marshall & John Schoonover's **Big Bambu** (Salt Lake) returned to the site of her most impressive performance to score her first graded stakes victory in yesterday's GIII Honorable Miss H. at Saratoga. It was the fourth consecutive victory for the bay filly, trained in Ohio by Alan Sobol, who came into this race off a front-running win in the Regret S. at Monmouth July 4. Last year, she shipped into Saratoga for the GI Test S. where she led to deep stretch at 28-1 before getting caught late by Dream Supreme. On paper, a speed duel seemed imminent in the four-horse race, as both Big Bambu and favorite **Dat You Miz Blue** (Cure the Blues) were front-running types with blinding early foot. A suicidal pace never materialized, however, as Big Bambu asserted herself on the outside and Dat You Miz Blue, along the rail, was taken back and raced behind the leader. Big Bambu was able to set reasonable fractions and, when challenged on the outside by the favorite along the turn, she had plenty left in the stretch to win by a length. "The graded stakes win is very significant," said Sobol. "That was a major goal for us this year. We're going to take her back home to Ohio and go from there. The Breeders' Cup Sprint is a possibility."

GODOLPHIN'S MELBOURNE SEVEN Godolphin accounted for the lion's share of the 28 overseas entries unveiled yesterday for the G1 Tooheys New Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 6. Of their seven possibles for the two-mile A\$3,635,000 contest **Mutafaweq (USA)** (Silver Hawk {USA}), winner of the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 8 and **Marienbard (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}), victor of the G2 Yorkshire Cup at York May 17, are the most notable. **Give The Slip (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}), who has been racing so far this term as pacemaker for stable companion Fantastic Light (USA), also features in the list. Sir Michael Stoute has entered **Cover Up (Ire)** (Machiavellian {USA}) and **Dalampour (Ire)** (Shernazar {Ire}). David Elsworth has nominated **Persian Punch (Ire)** (Persian Heights {Ire}), third to Jezabeel in 1998. Mark Johnston has G1 Ascot Gold Cup winner **Royal Rebel (Ire)** (Robellino {USA}) entered, while Amanda Perrett may send **Solo Mio (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) there. Ireland has three entries, while **Caitano (GB)** (Niniski {USA}) is the sole German entry and **London Bank (GB)** (Bigstone {Ire}) the lone Italian. Greg Nichols, Racing Victoria's manager, said yesterday, "There is more depth in our international entry this year than ever before. Although overall numbers are down, we've attracted the best quality middle-distance horses and stayers from eight countries. And when you add them to the best from Australia and New Zealand, the scene is set for a world-class carnival."

Bruno Grizzetti has transferred some of his string to Chantilly, aiming at the upcoming Deauville meeting. He is preparing the Luigi Riccardi-trained **Slap Shot (Ire)** (Lycius {USA}), third in Sunday's G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte, for the G1 Prix Morny Aug. 26. **London Bank (GB)** (Bigstone {Ire}), the first Italian-trained horse to be entered for the Melbourne Cup, is heading for the G2 Prix Kergorlay Aug. 19. INCREASED FUNDING FOR REHABILITATION

The Horserace Betting Levy Board yesterday announced a 200 percent increase in its funding for the charity Rehabilitation of Racehorses (RoR) from £50,000 in 2000 to £150,000 this year. Established by the British Horseracing Board last year to help in re-schooling and providing new homes for ex-racehorses, the organisation has been supported by all the principal organisations in racing and major bookmaking companies and the Tote. Last year a total of £230,000 was raised. Robert Hughes, the Levy Board Chairman, commented: "In its first year, Rehabilitation of Racehorses has established a strong base. All parts of racing and breeding, and the bookmaking industry, got behind it, making a valuable contribution to this important part of racing's horse welfare effort. For the rehabilitation centres, which do a remarkable and completely dedicated job, it has meant a very welcome and much-needed injection of cash."

Go Racing, the media rights company, yesterday unveiled its new company name and brand identity of "atheraces." Chief Executive Officer Chris Stoddart introduced the new brand with immediate effect. FLYING BABE, TIT FOR TAAT TOPS IN NEW ZEALAND

Flying Babe (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}) has been rated the top two-year-old in New Zealand, while **Tit for Taat (NZ)** (Faltaat {USA}) topped all three-year-olds on the New Zealand Free Handicap. Flying Babe, a granddaughter of Danehill, received a rating of 58kg. "Flying Babe was outstanding, winning the Mercedes Super Bonus Classique and [G2] Matamata Breeders' S. very easily," said Dean Nowell, who prepared the list for the New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders' Association. "She then returned from a virus to run a creditable third in the Ellerslie Sires' Produce S." Tit for Taat was rated at 60kg in the 1200m-1600m division, with **Star Satire (NZ)** (Volksraad {GB}) the top filly at 57.5kg. "There were very promising gallopers among the top dozen or so, but Tit for Taat's two outstanding Group 1 wins, in the 2000 Guineas and the Bayer Classic, earned him the top spot," Nowell commented. "Star Satire was the only three-year-old to defeat the older horses in New Zealand at weight-for-age when she won the [G1] Auto Auctions WFA."

It is important to retain the loyalty of the horsemen who race at Turfway year-round." Live racing resumes at Turfway on Sept. 5 and the Kentucky Cup Day of Champions is scheduled for Sept. 22.

SUSSEX SUCCESS (*cont. from p. 1*) Although **Noverre** is customarily in the firing line throughout his races, he was held up here by Frankie Dettori in eighth on the rail as **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon) was sent on by Johnny Murtagh. Paul Scallan finally got the slow-starting **Darwin (Ire)** (Danehill) to the front to perform his pacemaking task, where he set a strong gallop. In the straight it was Black Minnaloushe and Michael Kinane and **No Excuse Needed (GB)** (Machiavellian) and Kieren Fallon who attempted to wrest the lead from Bach with 1 1/2 furlongs to race after Darwin had faded. However, Dettori had pulled out Noverre and was closing fast on the wide outside. As No Excuse Needed got the better of his battle with 300 yards remaining, Noverre was quickening upsides and, grabbing the lead at the distance, pulled away for a smooth two-length success. The winning time was almost a second and a half outside that set by Aljabr in this event in 1999. For Frankie Dettori, the success completed an afternoon stakes double after the performance of Naheef in the G3 Champagne Lanson Vintage S. "At Ascot I got there perhaps too early, then Black Minnaloushe got me on the line," said Dettori. "Today I left it a bit later and he won like I expected. He has never run a bad race--he doesn't know how to." Future plans are yet to be determined, but Noverre will likely reappear at Ascot in September. "He is in the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp [Sept. 9], the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot [Sept. 29] and the G1 Breeders' Cup Mile [at Belmont Park Oct. 27]," said Godolphin's Simon Crisford. "But the QEII is the big race for him. It was very important to get that Group One back--it was a great shame to lose that, but now he has won the Sussex and he deserved that as he is very tough and durable horse. He's very admirable." Noverre is quoted at 8-1 for the Breeders' Cup Mile with Coral Eurobet. No Excuse Needed will head to Deauville Aug. 19 for the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois where he will meet **Olden Times (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}). **Distant Music** (Distant View) will now head for the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York Aug. 21.

While the punters hammered down the price on Leo's Luckyman, the price drifted up for the colt from the David Loder barn, where long odds are rarely found. "He's a horse that's done everything right, but we came here and we thought we'd be lucky to win," explained David Loder. "The horse is climbing the ladder quickly and Frankie was very impressed with him today. To ask a horse to run first time out at Epsom is difficult and he handled it well, I thought. That's why we were happy to come and run him on this track, as I'm not usually that keen to run too many two-year-olds here because I think it's a bit unfair on them." Settled in seventh on the rail early by Frankie Dettori as Redback (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) cut out the running, he traveled easily to the only turn. Leo's Luckyman got to the front, but was soon challenged by Where Or When (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), while Naheef was switched to the far outside to offer the greatest threat. Hitting the front with 175 yards remaining, Naheef lengthened away from the tiring favourite to win eased down from Bragadino, who tracked the winner's run without ever posing a realistic threat. "He has a great temperament, he does everything right for you all the time, he's well balanced, he's a good size, he's got a good action," Loder added. "He's slowly putting together a nice portfolio of ability that you're looking for in a top horse." Naheef is now quoted at odds of 20-1 for next year's G1 2000 Guin-
