A KNOCKOUT PUNCH

Through a shroud of gloom and afternoon rain, the incredible **Persian Punch (Ire)** (Persian Heights {GB}) won his first G2 Goodwood Cup yesterday in his fourth try in dramatic fashion. Beaten a head by **Royal Rebel (GB)** (Robellino) in the June 21 G1 Ascot Gold Cup at Royal Ascot last time out, the eight-year-old bounced back here ready for another fight. His dominance, which was as usual established from the outset, was briefly challenged in the straight by the three-year-old **Double Honour (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), who had tracked him in second from the start. Headed with 3 1/2 furlongs remaining, jockey Richard Quinn asked Persian Punch to go to war. Grabbing the lead again with two furlongs remaining, the gelding stayed on to the line to hold off a spirited Double Honour. Trainer David Elsworth described his veteran runner, "He seems as good as ever and he keeps going. He's been such a flag-bearer for our yard for years and it's great that he's maintaining his high standard. We're all very proud of them. I'm always worried when a horse goes by you, but in hindsight the horse does relish a bit of an argument and he does keep going so we hadn't thrown our tickets away." Owner Jeff Smith added, "It was absolutely wonderful, especially after Ascot--I think that's what most people came to see, whether we would get our own back. If there's half a mile to run and there's duel, I'd back mine every time." Persian Punch may return to the Tooheys New Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 6, where he ran third in 1998.

POINT GIVEN ARRIVES AT JERSEY SHORE

After a 12-hour odyssey that started on the Pacific Coast and ended in New Jersey, **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch), the favorite for Sunday's G1 Haskell Invitational H., arrived at Monmouth Park at 5:30 p.m. yesterday. The 3-year-old, accompanied by a stable pony named Maximus, left Del Mar on a van bound for LAX, took a Federal Express flight to Newark Airport, touched down at 3:15 p.m., then boarded another van for the final leg of the journey. "We had a very good trip, no problems," assistant trainer Jim Barnes, who traveled with the colt, said. "We had a smooth flight, and he handled the trip very well." Point Given's presence makes the Haskell worth \$1.5 million.

That the filly had no form to suggest she could win this adds further lustre to her trainer's skill with these types. Second to Heavenly Whisper (Ire) in the Listed Masaka S. at Kempton Apr. 14 on her seasonal return, Mauri Moon's best effort since came when fourth last time in the Listed Ballymacoll Stud S. won by Nafisah (Ire) at Newbury June 14. Here she was taken to the front early by Darryll Holland where she dictated the pace until asked to race with quarter of a mile remaining. Far from raising the white flag, she galloped on in game fashion and gave more as Sheppard's Watch and Martin Dwyer closed in. The winning time was nearly a second and a half outside of the standard, suggesting that the rain falling on the Sussex track had not yet taken hold.

MAGNA WINS BID FOR OTB New York City Mayor Rudy Giuliani yesterday announced that Frank Stronach's Magna Entertainment Group and its partners Greenwood Racing, Robert Baker and William Mack are the winning bidders for the New York City Off Track Betting Corporation. The deal, in negotiations for over two years, is valued as high as \$389 million, depending on handle and state racing laws. According to Giuliani, that figure is \$113 million more than the maximum possible payment bid by the New York Racing Association, in partnership with Churchill Downs and TVG Network. If the state legislature approves the sale, Magna would pay the city between \$150 million and \$260 million in down payments, then pay yearly fees according to handle. "It was a no brainer in terms of which of the two should get it," said Giuliani. Despite Giuliani's assertion, the deal still faces several hurdles including the state legislature and union issues for OTB workers. NYRA Chairman Barry K. Schwartz was not pleased at all with the decision. "I'll bet anybody any amount of money at any odds that Magna never pays \$260 million in cash for OTB," said Schwartz.

PADUA ENDS PARTNERSHIP WITH LUKAS Satish Sanan's Padua Stables removed most of its horses from the care of D. Wayne Lukas yesterday, ending Lukas' reign as Padua's general manager and exclusive trainer. "The final decision was made a couple of days ago," said Sanan. "We haven't had the production we would like to have had and thought we deserved. We just thought we needed a little change in strategy." The partnership began when Sanan, with Lukas as an advisor, began buying yearlings at Keeneland July in 1997. Along with buying dozens of high-priced yearlings at auctions all over the world, Sanan purchased Silverleaf Farm in Ocala, Florida in April of 1998 and began its conversion into a \$15 million state-of-the-art training center. Lukas was named general manager and minority partner in Padua shortly thereafter. The stable had success with 1999 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner Cash Run and Grade I winner Yes It's True, but there were many high-priced failures. Most recently, Born Perfect, a \$3.6 million KEEJUL yearling by Mr. Prospector out of the Seattle Slew mare Molly Girl, was retired unraced after suffering an injury in training. "This is not a kneejerk reaction," added Sanan. "Wayne is a great trainer and has trained many champions. The split was very amicable and he will continue to train some of our horses." Sanan said that Padua will continue to be active at major sales and will redistribute its horses to several trainers.

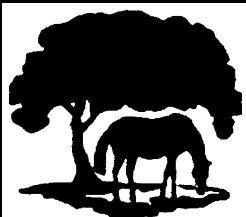
