## DANDY CHANCE FOR CONGAREE

**Congaree** (Arazi), who will go favored in today's GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga, finished third in both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness in only his fifth and sixth career starts. Those two efforts had taken plenty out of him, so the decision was made to skip the Belmont and prepare for the second half of the season. "Congaree looks awesome," said Baffert, who praised Stonerside for deciding to give Congaree time off. "Stonerside and the McNairs are all for good management of the horse," said Baffert. "That makes a huge difference." Congaree came back from his vacation to score a front-running victory in the GI Swaps S. going today's distance at Hollywood Park July 15. "The Swaps was a good race for him," said Baffert. "It wasn't too hard on him." His biggest challenge should come from Preakness and Belmont second-place finisher **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy). The OI Memorial Stable colorbearer won the GI Champagne S. in his third career start, but fell behind in his training this spring with sore shins. Following disappointing efforts in the GI Blue Grass and Kentucky Derby, he finished second in the last two-thirds of the Triple Crown. Stabled at Saratoga since early July, the chestnut put in a sharp five-furlong work in :59 4/5 over the main track last Saturday. While he comes into the race in excellent shape, the same can not be said of trainer Nick Zito, who has been saddled with symptoms of a slight cold and fatigue. A victory in the Jim Dandy would probably be the best medicine. **Windsor Castle** (Lord Carson) took the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct over nine furlongs last fall to finish his two-year-old season. He was detoured from the Derby trail by sickness, but has steadily progressed in three starts leading up to this. Most recently, he ran second behind E Dubai in the GII Dwyer S.

## FEET DON'T FAIL HIM NOW

The Thoroughbred Corporation's **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) broke from the far outside in each of the Triple Crown races. A consistent horse in all respects, he drew the far outside post for Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park. With only a field of six going in the race, which had its purse raised from \$1 million to \$1.5 million because of the Preakness and Belmont winner's presence, the outside post is not much of a disadvantage for Point Given. "With only six in, I couldn't have picked a better spot," said jockey Gary Stevens. "I'll allow him to go out there and get comfortable and ride him with a lot of confidence." Point Given, who galloped two miles yesterday over the Monmouth strip, was wearing a bar shoe behind, which he will also sport for the race. "He popped an abcess on his quarter," explained trainer Bob Baffert. "We had to clean it up a bit. We put the bar shoe on for protection. It's a very thin bar shoe and it should not affect him in the race at all." Baffert said he also lost a week of training with the big colt to heal his cracked heels. Baffert said Point Given had been unusually quiet and reserved over the past few weeks. "I was sort of worried about his quietness, but after I schooled him in the paddock at Del Mar he turned into a lunatic back at the barn," said Baffert. "He can turn it on when he wants to." Baffert is seeking his first Haskell win from four starts. He was previously second with Anet in 1997, third with Forestry in 1999 and second with Captain Steve last year. John Ward, who beat Point Given with Monarchos in the Kentucky Derby, will try to slay the giant again with a different horse. The speedy **Hero's Tribute** (Sea Hero) will break from the rail and dispute the early pace. If nobody goes with him, he could be dangerous. He won the GII Peter Pan S. two back and finished a troubled third in the GII Dwyer at Belmont July 8. He threw down sub-:45 half-mile splits in both races. "Monmouth is known for its speed bias. This is a good spot to see what he is made of," said Ward. "I want him to go out there and be aggressive. If you're going to kill a giant, the best time to do it is in the first step out of the cage." *Haskell field p.4*

Compton Bolter is accustomed to more esteemed company than this, having been ambitiously campaigned throughout his career. It has not been an unwarranted ambition, however, as he has acquitted himself admirably at a higher level than this. Last year, he was fifth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket in May before ending a memorable season by taking the Listed Churchill S. on the all-weather at Lingfield in November. This year, he was second by two lengths to Border Arrow (GB) in the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. at Sandown May 29 before getting busy again. For this event, he defied top weight under a masterful ride by Kevin Darley, making up ground swiftly from the rear before the straight with long-time leader Maniatis the primary target. Short of room on the rail with three furlongs remaining, Darley lost ground by switching, but once in the clear, he picked up in style to wear down the tough front-runner in the final 50 yards. The winning time was over four seconds slower than the course record. Trainer Gerald Butler told *PA Sport*, "It's the Arlington Million next, he loves travelling and about the only place he hasn't been is Hong Kong, but we'll get him there one day."

Speightstown, with a three-race skein in hand, broke running from the five hole and City Zip was hustled up to secure the rail. Three-year-olds simply dominate this race, having taken the last eight runnings. This time **Lailani** is the one to beat here, coming off a fine neck beating of Mot Juste in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 15. She is a fast-improving filly, having been thrown in at the deep end there after a string of successes in handicap company. Frankie Dettori, who partners her again this afternoon, spoke at the time of her "very very big heart". She holds the fourth-placed **Sequoyah** and **Time Away**, who was fifth, on that running and should not be inconvenienced by the drop back in trip, having won over the 10 furlongs in three of her handicaps. Sequoyah is the chosen representative of Aidan O'Brien here, but it is hard to make a case for her on form as she was found wanting in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22 and in both the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas (at The Curragh May 27) and Irish Oaks. Time Away is the more attractive proposition, having won the G3 Musidora S. at York May 15 over this distance before running a game third in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly July 10. The doubts surrounding her centre around her ability to handle undulating tracks--the reason behind her absence in the Epsom Oaks. Geoff Wragg's **Danceabout** is the best older filly in the line-up and she would have a shout on the form of her win in last year's G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket in September. Returning to be a fine fourth in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury 19, she filled the same position last time behind Proudswings in the G2 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 11. That was a muddling affair and she was given a lot to do which flatters **Dear Daughter**, only a neck away in fifth. However, Sir Michael Stoute does not over-face his three-year-olds and she must be respected here.
