SHORE TO PLEASE

The Thoroughbred Corporation's **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) looks to add new meaning to "Fast Times at the Jersey Shore" when he goes postward as the odds-on choice in this afternoon's GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park. Fifth as the favorite in the Kentucky Derby when kept too close to the hot pace, the strapping chestnut rebounded to score a 2 1/4-length success in the GI Preakness May 18 and was an amazing 12 1/4-length winner of the 12-furlong GI Belmont S. in his last racetrack appearance June 9. Given some time off following that effort, the Bob Baffert pupil has trained well for his return, including a July 31 blowout at Del Mar in :58 4/5 for five furlongs. Trainer John Ward Jr. and owner John Oxley, who teamed with Monarchos to slay the dragon in the Kentucky Derby, are represented by **Hero's Tribute** (Sea Hero). After having his Triple Crown aspirations dashed by a last-of-seven finish in the GI Blue Grass S., the bay was fitted with blinkers and responded in kind with a 3 3/4-length win in the GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont May 26. Most recently third in the GII Dwyer S. July 8, his running style fits this oval and he will try to take advantage of his inside draw. **Jamaican Rum** (Exemplary Leader) ships in from California for trainer Jim Cassidy. The runner up in the GII Arkansas Derby earlier this year, the gray was defeated in restricted stakes company in his next two starts, but closed impressively into a slow pace to finish third behind Congaree in the GI Swaps S. at Hollywood Park July 15. **Burning Roma** (Rubiano) ventures into graded-stakes company for the first time in 2001. The bay colt is the winner of five of six this season and three straight, including a 9 3/4-length dusting of the Leonard Richards S. field at Delaware June 17 and a 1 1/4-length score in this track's Long Branch Breeders' Cup S. July 15. In second that afternoon was Stonerside Stables' **This Fleet Is Due** (Devil His Due), who was gaining ground on the winner at the wire. He will appreciate the added sixteenth of a mile of this event. The least experienced member of the sextet is **Touch Tone** (Pick Up the Phone). Trained by the affable Ronny Werner, the bay is three for four in his brief career, punctuated by a front-running, 7 1/4-length victory in the Iowa Derby July 6. (*Field p4*)

FAVORITES STUNG AT SARATOGA

Scorpion (Seattle Slew) entered yesterday's GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga with the odds squarely against him, having never having won a stakes or a route race. His trainer, D. Wayne Lukas, had just lost one of his biggest client just days ago and he was facing top three-year-olds **Congaree** (Arazi) and **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy), but Lukas has been the architect of big race upsets in the not too distant past. One need only think back to the 1999 Kentucky Derby or the Belmont S. of 2000 to be reminded of the fact that Lukas can have a horse ready for the big ones. Mix in a dash of Saratoga's reputation as "the graveyard of favorites" and in the end, Scorpion registered the stunner from a game **Free of Love** (Meadow Flight). "We'll definitely point for the [GI] Travers S. [Aug. 25]," the winning conditioner commented. "He's earned his shot at it. He obviously likes the track here; he's run some very good races here as a two-year-old." (*Jim Dandy cont. p2*)

IRON MASK (USA) (c, 3, Danzig {USA}--Raise a Beauty {USA}, by Alydar {USA}) has shown consistent sprinting form in France, finishing out of the money only twice in nine lifetime outings. His biggest win was recorded last August in the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Chantilly. The globe-trotting bay scored last time in the Singapore International S. Reigning first season sire Strategic (Aus) supplied the first two across the line in Saturday's Gr2 San Domenico S. (1000m) at Sydney's Warwick Farm in a shock result as the Gai Waterhouse trained Excellerator (Aus) (Marsday {Aus}) languished in fifth place. Acting on advice from jockey Chris Munce that Excellerator didn't handle the track and raced on one rein from the start, Waterhouse will consider sending the Magic Millions winner to Melbourne (which races anti-clockwise, the opposite of Sydney) to contest the Ascot Vale S.

"He was never comfortable. He was on the wrong leg and he struggled all the way through the race," Munce told Thoroughbred Racing Board stewards. Waterhouse's other option is to keep Excellerator in Sydney for the Gr2 Up and Coming S. (1200m) at Warwick Farm on August 18. Waterhouse suggested that track bias was to blame saying leaders were winning. Mistegic (Aus), who took the lead and held off a challenge from Fair Embrace (Aus), won the L. Breeders' Plate on debut but plans went awry after he was galloped on when third in the L. Canonbury S. and suffered an illness during a spell that trainer Lee Curtis believes accounted for the gelding's ordinary efforts in four subsequent outings. Curtis may miss the Up and Coming S. in favour of having a fresh horse for later races while Fair Embrace will target the Gr2 Silver Shadow S. (1200m) on August 18, the first leg of the four race Princess Series. Gr1 winning sire Strategic (Aus) (Zeditave {Aus}) finished the 2000-2001 season with 10 winners and two SW from 35 starters; he is standing at Woodlands this season at a fee of \$18,700; his second crop of yearlings averaged \$38,964 for 31 sold at the major sales, off a fee of \$7,000.

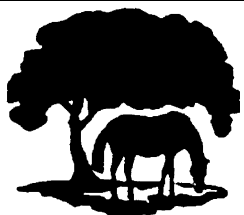

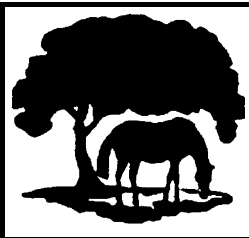

SCORPION PULLS THE UPSET Scorpion, scratched from Friday's GII Amsterdam S. in favor of this spot, won his Gulfstream return to the races Mar. 3, but was off the board in the GIII Gotham and the GI Santa Anita Derby before running a distant sixth in the Northern Dancer H. at Churchill June 16. The bay returned to the winner's circle with a 1/2-length allowance tally at Belmont July 4, but was being asked a big question over a course he displayed affinity for last year. Scorpion broke alertly but was eased back off the pace set along the inside by **Free of Love** and odds-on **Congaree**. The latter was given his head leaving the half-mile pole in an effort to put the race away early, but Richard Migliore aboard Free of Love never vacated the rail and fought back to secure a narrow advantage at the top of the stretch. He disposed of the challenge of Congaree in upper stretch, but Jerry Bailey had Scorpion in gear late and he hit the front in the shadow of the wire for the win. "I couldn't believe how they quickened at the 4 1/2 furlong marker," Bailey commented. "My horse worked hard and inside the sixteenth pole, I had a pretty good feeling we would get up. Free of Love hung in tough." **Windsor Castle** (Lord Carson) was an early scratch due to a pulled muscle.

Graveyard of Favorites Claims Another

A confident Gary Stevens turned favored Congaree loose with a little more than four furlongs to run, but could not dispose of Free of Love and tired down the lane to be third. Or did he? "It looked like he was cruising fine, but then all of a sudden he ran out of horse," trainer Bob Baffert said. "(Jockey) Gary (Stevens) thinks he might have bled. Maybe the humidity got him. We'll take him back to the barn and scope him." The conditioner refused to blame the surface for his horse's performance. "This track is a weird track. A lot of good horses lose here. I think he handled the track fine. We'll take him back to California. I doubt we'll run him in the Travers."

Monnavanna could not have been more impressive when winning the Listed Prix Amandine here July 13 by five lengths from **Stunning**. That performance saw her build on her smart previous form, the highlight of which was a seventh-placing behind Banks Hill (GB) in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22. **Tempting Fate** was third in that event, beaten two lengths, and she is a most consistent filly at the highest level. Previously she was a game fourth behind Rose Gypsy (GB), beaten less than a length, in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 13. She is the one to beat. **Amonita** was a further 1 1/2 lengths back in fifth that day and connections were convinced she would have been closer with a less trouble-free run. She was an impressive winner of the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp last October and the feeling is that she has not had a chance to show that form since.
