ANYTHING BUT A SHORE THING

Preakness and Belmont winner **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) took his act to the Jersey shore yesterday for the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park, but it was not quite a day at the beach for the giant chestnut. The record crowd of 47,127 made Point Given, seeking his third straight Grade I victory in his first start since the June 9 Belmont S., its 3-10 favorite. The colt was allowed to settle near the back of the six-horse field. When he moved up nearing the half-mile pole, it looked as though Point Given would inhale his rivals for an easy win. But pacesetter **Touch Tone** (Pick Up the Phone) and the diminutive **Burning Roma** (Rubiano) weren't ready to give in. With Touch Tone hanging tough on the rail, Burning Roma and Point Given on the outside exchanged bumps within the final furlong. Jockey Gary Stevens straightened Point Given out and the powerful colt finished resolutely for a half-length victory. Touch Tone held off Burning Roma by a nose for second. In a spirited exchange after the race, Point Given's trainer Bob Baffert and Stevens heatedly discussed Stevens's race tactics. Later, Stevens explained, "I was given some instructions from an outrider about three minutes to post. I was told they were from Bob, but I couldn't be sure. I'm just trying to get on my game face for a million and a half dollar race and this guy is trying to give me instructions. Apparently, the instructions went from Bob to the stewards to the outrider and then me. When I got back to the winner's circle, Bob is all joking and laughing and I wanted nothing to do with it. There's a time for kidding and there's a time not to kid and three minutes to a million and a half dollar race is not time to joke." Of the mysterious pre-race instructions, Baffert said, "I wanted somebody at the gate to tell [Stevens] to have the stick in his left hand turning for home because this horse likes to lean on other horses. But after watching the replay, I felt a lot better about the way Gary rode. He did the right thing." Of the actual race, Stevens added, "At the eighth pole, I wasn't sure we had it. Those other colts were running strong. It was a real tough hard-fought race and you never know what's going to happen, regardless of what the tote board says."

INJURY SIDELINES CONGAREE

Congaree (Arazi), third in this year's Kentucky Derby and Preakness, injured his right knee during a third-place effort in Saturday's GI Jim Dandy at Saratoga. "When we got him back to the barn, we noticed he was a little off in his right knee," trainer Bob Baffert explained yesterday. "We had it X-rayed and it came back negative. He just wrenched it. That was the same knee he had problems with last year." The injury will not require surgery. Baffert added that the three-year-old would get the remainder of the year off to recuperate. "We don't want to take any chances with him, something really bad could happen," he explained. "We want to have a nice horse for next year. It's disappointing to end the year like this, but we have to do what's best for the horse."

DARLEY AGREES TO PURCHASE JONABELL

Sheikh Mohammed's Darley has reached an agreement to purchase Jonabell Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. The four stallions currently standing at Jonabell--Cherokee Run, Gold Legend, Holy Bull and Old Trieste--will still stand at the farm and will still be managed by Jim Bell. "It's business as usual," said Bell. "This is a win-win situation. I've been fortunate enough to be in the management of Jonabell for 25 years and I look forward to continuing success with the help and support of Darley." The Bell family will continue an independent breeding operation.

LAILANI BREEDERS' CUP BOUND?

Lailani (GB) (Unfuwain), winner of Saturday's G1 Vodafone Nassau S., has earned a break, trainer Ed Dunlop said yesterday. The filly, who also counts the G1 Irish Oaks among her string of six straight wins, will be rested for a fall campaign that could include the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 16 and the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf at Belmont Park Oct. 27. Dunlop told *PA Sport* yesterday, "We have no set plans at present. There are obviously other fillies of Sheikh Maktoum's to take into consideration, but France remains an option and one's also thought about the Breeder's Cup Filly and Mare Turf."

Two yearlings by the *second leading freshman sire*, two or more sold, at Keeneland July, with an *average of \$273,333*, hip #29 and #164, selling at Saratoga in the Walmac consignment, August 7 & 9.

Love Everlasting showed smart form at two, but it appeared she had lost her way early this season. She started to pick up the tempo with a York handicap success July 13, but found Ranin (GB) 1 3/4 lengths too strong when second in the Listed Aphrodite S. at Newmarket July 21 last time. Here, she ran in second early behind Nafisah and took over with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining as the front-runner started to feel the pressure. From there, she held on to her advantage despite the renewed efforts of the runner-up, who was racing under a three-pound penalty. Relish The Thought (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}), third in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 8 before disappointing when well beaten in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 15, disappointed once again. She was held up in last place early and despite making up the ground, did not find the expected improvement in the straight.

Johnny V. Sets the Spa on Fire:

Jockey John Velazquez booted home five winners yesterday at Saratoga, equaling the record held jointly by Julie Krone, Jerry Bailey, Mike Smith, Ron Turcotte and Angel Cordero Jr. Velazquez piloted Czardas Dancer (\$10.60) to victory in the opener, before guiding Star Attraction (\$8.10) to victory in the third and Boodles (\$11.20) in the fourth. He scored again in the sixth with Atomizer (\$37.40) and finished third in the seventh race aboard Excitabull Trick, but capped the afternoon with a win aboard Starine (Fr) (\$6.80) for trainer Bobby Frankel in the eighth race. With 19 wins, Velazquez holds a one-race lead over Jerry Bailey in the jockey's standings through the first 11 days of racing.

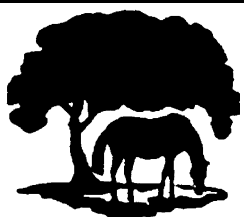

Slightly disappointing thereafter, he showed on his European return this year that he retained ability by chasing home Paolini by 1 1/2 lengths in Rome. Here he raced in fourth early under Frankie Dettori as Pryor (Ger) (Kornado {GB}) cut out the running. Dettori rushed him to the lead around the turn into the final straight and by the furlong pole, Kutub was clear. Keeping him up to his work from there, he strode away before being eased near the line for an easy success.

Five Star Day is lightning fast out of the gate and does his best running on the front end. Therefore, the winner of last October's GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup H. lost chance in his 2000 debut in the Saratoga H. at Bay Meadows May 26, when he broke in a tangle and found himself sitting off the pace for the first time. Nevertheless, he did well to finish second that day. Shipped in from Arlington, where he has been stabled most of the summer, the 8-1 shot broke well from the rail and established a clear lead when some of the other speedy types in the race decided not to challenge him. He blazed through quick splits of :21 4/5 and :44 3/5 while riding the rail, took a 2 1/2-length lead into the stretch and was never threatened by the late run of Delaware Township. "He runs well fresh," said trainer Beau Greely. "I just planned on three or four races this year with the Breeders' Cup Sprint as the ultimate goal. He might make a start before the Breeders' Cup or I might just train him up to the race." Bonapaw, the 7-5 favorite, did well to make up ground late after finding himself in the rare position of being well off the pace. "He was piddling round in the gate," said jockey Gerard Melancon. "Once he didn't break well, I tried to get him to relax in the back."
