SARATOGA SELECT SALE STARTS TODAY

The second major yearling sale of the summer, Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings Sale gets underway tonight at 7:30 p.m. at the Humphrey S. Finney Sales Pavilion. The 2000 sale concluded with a record average of \$305,847 for 137 yearlings sold. Last year's sale was topped by a \$4.2 million son of Seattle Slew--Omi (Wild Again); his half-sister by Gone West will sell as Hip 153 on Wednesday. A total of 237 yearlings have been catalogued for the three-day auction, including offspring of leading sires A.P. Indy, Deputy Minister, Gone West, Kingmambo, Rahy, Saint Ballado, Seattle Slew, Seeking the Gold, Storm Cat and Unbridled. On Thursday, a colt from the final crop of Mr. Prospector will go through the ring. Several young stallions are represented by first-crop yearlings, including Awesome Again (Deputy Minister), Coronado's Quest (Forty Niner), Deputy Commander (Deputy Minister), Favorite Trick (Phone Trick), Formal Gold (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), Gentlemen (Arg) (Robin des Bois), Grand Slam (Gone West), Skip Away (Skip Trial), Tale of the Cat (Storm Cat) and Touch Gold (Deputy Minister). Among the offerings are Hip 88, full brother to MGSW Saudi Poetry (Storm Cat), herself the 1998 sale-topper; and Hip 235, a Tabasco Cat half-sister to GISW A P Valentine (A.P. Indy).

POINTING FOR THE TRAVERS

A day after Point Given's thrilling victory in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Park, trainer Bob Baffert said that the big chestnut came out of the race in good shape and will now aim for Saratoga's Midsummer Derby. "He's flying home to California tomorrow [Tuesday] to prepare for the Travers," Baffert said. The trainer also took the opportunity to praise the horse's courage under fire and to clear up any confusion over remarks made immediately after the race. "What the race showed us is when this horse is in a fight he is a fighting champion," Baffert commented, a sentiment that jockey Gary Stevens shared. "You always wonder how a horse is going to respond when he's in a dog-fight. We got the answer to that question yesterday [Sunday]." The post-race fireworks between trainer and jockey are a thing of the distant past, according to the parties involved. "There was a mixup with Gary, but everything is fine now," Baffert acknowledged. "The focus should have been on the horse. It was a tense day for the whole team. We only had three weeks to get the horse ready to face a very competitive field giving away weight. Everyone had their hearts in their throats. Just before the race I realized I had neglected to give one piece of information to Gary. The track offered to convey that info through their personnel. It was a dumb idea and a bad case of 'whisper down the lane.'" Upon his return to Southern California, Stevens' phone rang. It was Baffert. "Everything is more than fine [with me and Bob]," Stevens said. "After the race, my adrenaline was pumping and so was the horse's. I've got a very good working relationship with Bob and we're very good friends. If he thinks I messed up, he's not afraid to say it and vice versa. Bob and I have been great friends for a long time. I tend to wear my heart on my sleeve. It was a mixup, but we got everything ironed out. It lasted about 10 minutes. As far as any controversy is concerned, there really isn't any. This is the Point Given show, not the Bob and Gary show. We're going to try to win a Horse of the Year championship with him. I am a lot happier right now than I was at 5:45 yesterday. I'm happy because everything is good with Bob, [racing manager] Mr. Mulhall and the Prince."

A two-year-old filly by supersire Danehill (USA) brought a final bid of A\$180,000 to top Sunday's Magic Millions August Mixed Thoroughbred Sale on the Gold Coast. The bay, out of Clowning (Aus) (Rory's Jester {Aus}), was consigned by Magic Millions Sales Pty Limited and was purchased by R A and J E Ferguson. In large part thanks to the far-and-away topper, the sale saw increases across the board. A total of 86 horses sold for \$613,627 and an average of \$7,135. Last year, 62 horses sold for \$226,600 and an average of \$3,597.

Our local postman, who cheerfully delivers the mail on his bicycle, often finds his load considerably lighter after he has visited my house. The other day was no exception, because one of the packages he unloaded was the latest edition of Gainsborough's private stud book. This handsome volume nowadays provides details of a 229-strong broodmare band which Sheikh Maktoum bin Rashid al Maktoum maintains worldwide. It's hard to imagine that 1985's considerably slimmer book was big enough to contain details of the mares owned by all four Maktoum brothers, with Sheikh Maktoum's share at the time being a mere 35 mares.

The Sheikh's broodmare team then underwent some rapid expansion, rising to nearly 100 mares by 1988, with one of the new arrivals being Carduel, a Buckpasser mare whose only win came in a maiden at Belmont. Carduel's acquisition had been prompted by the excellent juvenile form shown by Always Fair, her 1985 son by Danzig. Bought for \$400,000 as a yearling, Always Fair provided Sheikh Maktoum with the thrill of a Group win at Royal Ascot, taking the G3 Coventry S., and went on to become a very good miler.

Carduel repeated the Royal Ascot magic 11 years later when another of her sons, Faithful Son, gamely got the better of Chester House and Daylami in a tight finish to the G2 Prince of Wales's S., and this Zilzal gelding later confirmed his status as one of 1998's best ten-furlong performers.

Carduel was retired earlier this year after producing her 14th live foal, a colt by Sultry Song, but the Gainsborough team have the consolation of having

retained her three eldest daughters, even though none of them managed to win. The first of them, the Mr. Prospector mare Lailati, raced five times at up to 1 3/8 miles. Although she was distinctly moderate, she was better than Carduel's Alydar filly Green Jannat, whose only placing was a second in a two-horse race. Next came Lailati's sister Golden Digger, who failed to reach the first three in any of her four starts.

Considering that competition for places in the Gainsborough broodmare band is fairly intense, with plenty of good homebred fillies coming off the track every year, it is rather surprising that all three of these disappointing daughters of Carduel were retained. However, recent events have underlined the wisdom of the decision to keep them. Lailati's record stands at two stakes winners from her first four foals, the latest being her excellent Unfuwain filly Lailani, who followed up her victory in the Irish Oaks with another G1 success in Saturday's Nassau S. That Nassau win came three days after Golden Digger's second foal, the Marju colt Naheef, had maintained his unbeaten record with a very stylish success in the G3 Champagne Lanson Vintage S.

Perhaps the decision to keep Lailati and Golden Digger owed quite a lot to the fact that, with Mr. Prospector as their sire and a Buckpasser mare as their dam, they are bred to the same powerful pattern as Seeking the Gold, Miswaki, Woodman and Mining.

All three of Carduel's eldest daughters also had the considerable attraction of being free of Northern Dancer blood, and were therefore candidates for mating to the many stallions from the male line which provided Carduel with all three of her stakes winners (the third was Always Fair's brother Asaasy, a Listed winner over a mile in Germany).

In fact Lailati and Golden Digger have been mated exclusively to Northern Dancer-line stallions, with Lailati producing her first stakes winner, Copper Carnival, to Danzig's son Petit Loup and her second, Lailani, to Northern Dancer's son Unfuwain. Marju, the sire of Golden Digger's son Naheef, also qualifies as a Northern Dancer-line horse, even though he's only a great-grandson. Danehill, a Danzig horse inbred to Northern Dancer's dam, has obvious appeal for Carduel's daughters and all three have young stock by him, so this is a family with a bright future.

SIX ENTER HALL OF FAME The Racing Hall of Fame honor roll grew by six yesterday as trainers Richard Mandella and Tom Smith, jockey Earlie Fires and racehorses Holy Bull, Paseana (Arg) and Maskette were inducted at the Finney Pavilion on the grounds of Fasig-Tipton Saratoga. "Silent" Tom Smith trained folk hero Seabiscuit and 1947 Kentucky Derby winner Jet Pilot as well as champions Kayak II, Mioland, Star Pilot and Beaugay. Mandella made his reputation with star sprinter Phone Trick and went on to condition champions Kotashaan (Fr) and Phone Chatter. He then got into a groove with handicap horses as Siphon (Brz), Dare and Go, Gentlemen (Arg) and Malek (Chi) combined to win six straight \$1 million races in California. Earlie Fires, who has ridden the winners of over 6,000 races, was touched at the ceremony. "In this business, you have a lot of people to thank," Fires told *The Blood-Horse*. "Between the trainers and owners, and everybody that is in this business--everybody that is connected with the races, the grooms, everybody--It's a little emotional for me. Because I've been a long time trying to get here." Undefeated at two, **Holy Bull** (Great Above) went on to become Horse of the Year at three in a campaign which saw him win the GI Metropolitan H., GI Woodward S., GI Travers S. and GI Florida Derby. In all, the big grey won 13 of 16 starts and \$2,481,760. Now standing at Jonabell Farm in Kentucky, Holy Bull has sired champion two-year-old Macho Uno as well as GISW Confessional. Multiple champion **Paseana** (Ahmad {Arg}), a Group 1 winner in her native Argentina, replaced Bayakoa as trainer Ron McAnally's resident South American superstar. The bay mare won 10 Grade I events in the U.S., including the 1992 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, and received two straight Eclipse Awards as champion older mare. She earned \$3,115,012 while going 28-14-10-1 in her North American campaign. After well-documented fertility problems, Paseana produced her first live foal last year in Argentina, a filly by Lode. Joining that pair of contemporary runners is **Maskette** (Disguise), a foal of 1906. The brown filly defeated colts in the Futurity S. as a two-year-old and won the Ladies, Gazelle and Alabama Stakes at three. She won 12 of 17 starts for owner/breeder/trainer James R. Keene. From 1954 to 1992, a stakes race was run in her honor at Belmont Park, but that event was renamed the Go for Wand as a memorial to that ill-fated filly.

Baptize made it back-to-back graded stakes victories with this sharp effort. The dark colt travelled to Chicago last time for the GII Arlington Classic June 30 and came away with a 2 1/4-length score. Heavily favored here, he sat in third as Saint Verre, making his turf debut, cut out soft fractions over the firm course. Baptize angled to the outside on the far turn, had a head in front at the stretch call and covered his final furlong in a sprightly 11 4/5 while posting a clear success. It was the sixth victory for jockey Jerry Bailey in this event. Strategic Partner, who nosed out Baptize in the GIII Crown Royal American Turf S. in May, finished well for second. "There were two in front of us and, being the favorite, I guess they were trying to keep us tight in there," said winning trainer Bill Mott. "But Jerry was able to swing him out at the half-mile pole. Then, at the three-sixteenths pole he hit him left-handed, and the rest is history. He likes the firm going, doesn't like the soft going." Baptize could make one more start at the Spa. "We'll have to look at the stake [GIII Saranac, 9-2, 9.5f] at the end of the meet, but we didn't look too much more beyond this.," Mott continued. "This was the first one on the list."

With an enormous effort, the American filly New Real Deal achieved her fifth victory out of six starts Saturday in Palermo's G1 Ignacio Correas. Stage Classic was a distant third to Macho Uno in the GI Grey Breeders' Cup at Woodbine last October, but was shelved following a fourth in that track's Display S. Nov. 10.
