HISTORY'S CALLING

Ten-year-old **John's Call** (Lord At War {Arg}) will go postward in his title defense of the GI Sword Dancer H. today at Saratoga seeking to become the oldest Thoroughbred to ever win a Grade I race in the U.S. He earned his first such victory in last year's edition, romping by 9 1/4 lengths over a soft course, before ending 2000 as a finalist in the Eclipse Award voting for champion turf horse. Having gotten a lengthy vacation, the Tom Voss trainee opened this campaign with a victory in the Cape Henlopen S. at Delaware going 12 furlongs July 22, the identical prep to last year's triumph. "Why would I want to change anything?" Voss asked. "It was his first time out in eight months going a mile and a half. It was strictly a prep to see where he was and he won it fairly easily." **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) has reached a new level since switching to the turf, romping by six lengths in the Louisville H. June 2 at Churchill before crossing the line in front by a head in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth July 1. Though DQ'd to second in that 11-furlong contest, the six-year-old grey poses a front-running threat here. "I don't think the distance will be a problem for him," Sheppard said. "I'm quite sure he'll get the trip. It's nice to have a horse like this because he has the speed to be close and the stamina to run all day."

SUPERSTAR LEO RETIRED

Lael Stable announced the retirement yesterday of **Superstar Leo (Ire)** (College Chapel {GB}--Council Rock {GB}, by General Assembly), who was awarded the Cartier Award as Europe's top two-year-old filly last year. Purchased by Lael Stables after her victory in the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot, the Lester Piggott-bred bay went on to win the G2 Polypipe Flying Childers S. at Doncaster before running a gallant second versus older horses in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp in her final start at two. She came back as a three-year-old to run five times, but her best finish was a second in a listed stakes in England. Trained by Newmarket-based William Haggas, Superstar Leo finished her career with five wins from 13 starts and earnings of \$279,695. Breeding plans have not yet been announced.

BAY ON THE WAY BACK

Trainer Roger Charlton reported yesterday that **Frenchmans Bay (Fr)** (Polar Falcon {USA}) is back in training. The three-year-old, third to Golan (Ire) in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6, has returned to cantering after surgery to his near-fore knee. Charlton told the *Racing Post*, "We're delighted with his progress and he returned to slow cantering three weeks ago. The idea is to bring him back to the racecourse for a maiden at the end of next month or, more likely, sometime in October. Ideally, we'll fit in another race before the end of the season and then we'll be able to put together a proper programme for next year."

Michael Tabor's European auction record purchase **Diaghilev (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) makes his long-awaited debut on Sunday in the opening Waterford Crystal EBF Maiden at Leopardstown. The May colt, out of the top class mare Darara (Ire) (Top Ville {Ire}), a half sister to champion Darshaan (GB), reached a staggering 3.4 million guineas at last year's Tattersalls Houghton Sales in Newmarket. The half-brother to Kilimanjaro (GB) and full sibling to Rhagaas (GB) and Darazari (Ire) faces 10 opponents in the mile maiden. Trainer Aidan O'Brien commented earlier in the spring that the colt "looks top class." WATERHOUSE'S BAN LIFTED

The 17-year exile of the high-profile former bookmaker Rob Waterhouse will end today when he returns to the rails for the Premiere Stakes meeting at Rosehill in Australia. The New South Wales Thoroughbred Racing Board effectively overruled the New South Wales Bookmakers' Co-Operative, giving Waterhouse the green light. The TRB cleared the way for Waterhouse's return in June and it seemed his application to the Co-Op was little more than a formality, but the 300-member organization sought a full vote from its members, refused the idea of bringing its meeting forward to expedite Waterhouse's return and ultimately declined his application for membership. However, the TRB put an end to a protracted and much-publicised saga by reversing their decision. "Mr. Waterhouse has now fulfilled the conditions set when his licence was granted in June," TRB Chief Executive Merv Hill said in a statement. Waterhouse, married to top trainer Gai, was one of several people, including his father, leviathan bookmaker Bill, warned off by the Australian Jockey Club after being found guilty of prior knowledge of the Fine Cotton ring-in scandal at Eagle Farm in August, 1984.
