WHAT'S THE WORD? JOHANNESBURG

If Aidan O'Brien dominates any one particular race, then it is G1 Independent Waterford Wedgwood Phoenix S. Successful in the last three renewals with Lavery (Ire), Fasliyev and Minardi, he looks almost certain to add to that in this year's running with **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) at Leopardstown this afternoon. Effortlessly impressive when winning on his debut in a Fairyhouse maiden May 30, he went on to greater things quickly, taking everything in his stride when blowing away the opposition in the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21. Stepped up almost another furlong and a half on his next start in the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14, he barely drew sweat there to dispose of stable companion **Wiseman's Ferry** (Hennessy) by four lengths. He hardly has to do much more to win this. His style is reminiscent of the brilliant Fasliyev, as he seems capable of killing off his rivals with relentless speed and he can quicken off a true pace like stable companion Minardi. He will be extremely hard to stop here, providing he handles the softer conditions. Wiseman's Ferry is yet to run a bad race and he is the most likely runner-up again here. Previous to his fine effort at The Curragh last time, he had tried to give four pounds to the smart Irony (Ire) in the Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot June 22, finishing just 2 1/2 lengths back in sixth.

THE WAIT IS OVER

He made his connections wait for it. Six-year-old **With Anticipation** (Relaunch) picked up the first Grade I victory of his career at Saratoga Race Course yesterday afternoon, holding off **King Cugat** (Kingmambo) to win the \$500,000 Sword Dancer Invitational H. by three-quarters of a length. The eye-catching gray nearly pulled off a Grade I score in his last race, but after crossing the finish line first in the July 1 United Nations H. at Monmouth Park, he was disqualified and placed second for interfering with Senure during the stretch drive. "This makes up for getting disqualified in the United Nations, particularly for the horse," said Hall of Fame trainer Jonathan Sheppard, who was himself winning his first Grade I flat race at Saratoga. With Anticipation raced almost exclusively on dirt prior to this season, winning a pair of stakes. He had tried turf once before, running third, but blossomed when returned to the lawn for a Keeneland allowance race in April. After winning that race by 8 3/4 lengths, he added a six-length tally in the Louisville H. June 2, then made it three in a row in the U.N. before losing that win via the stewards' stand. Stretching out another furlong for the Sword Dancer, the Augustin Stable homebred dueled **Slew Valley** (Valley Crossing) through steady fractions, shook free of that rival at the top of the lane and held on gamely to beat the favorite to the wire. "I had some question about the distance, with him being a front-running horse," Sheppard admitted. "He obviously handled everything fine, and the course was in extremely good shape--much firmer than I thought it would be after all the rain we got. It was a great performance." King Cugat was impressive in defeat. Checked on the second turn and again on the third, he angled to the outside for the final drive and just missed. "He had to check three different times during the race," trainer Bill Mott said. "That was enough to make the difference in the margin of victory." **John's Call** (Lord at War {Arg}), looking to repeat his 9 3/4-length Sword Dance romp of last year, pressed the pace, but tired to finish last. Still, the crowd greeted him with a cheer when he returned to be unsaddled. (*Sword Dancer chart, p3*)

FLORES DRINKS FROM VICTORY CUP

American jockey David Flores took Ascot by storm yesterday by winning the Shergar Cup for the team representing the "Rest of the World." His winning double was initiated by the easy 2 1/2-length success of **Steenberg (Ire)** (Flying Spur {Aus}) in the Ritz Club Shergar Cup Juvenile. Flores, enjoying success in his first ride at Ascot said, "It's an honour for me to be here and be competitive at this great track. I have enjoyed it from the beginning and it has been great. I'd love to get more opportunities to be at this track." He came back in the Dubai Duty Free Shergar Cup Sprint to win aboard **Orienteur (GB)** (Inchior {GB}) and secure the victory for his teammates. "First of all, thanks to Sheikh Mohammed for inviting me here and to Simon [Crisford] and all the group that work for Godolphin. It really is a pleasure for me and I'd love to come back again. This is a great day--what an experience," said a jubilant Flores after his sprint win. His grand finale proved instrumental in gaining the overall victory for his team, who finished up with 125 points. Team "Britain & Ireland" ended their day with 115 points. Flores also led the individual point standings with 45 points, 15 clear of his nearest pursuers, Pat Eddery and Mirco Demuro, both with 30 points to their credit.

Team "Britain and Ireland" get off to a quick start...

Jockey Mick Kinane scored aboard **Persiano (GB)** (Efisio {GB}) in the first race, the **ILPH Shergar Cup Mile H.**, which helped his team gain a 23-17 advantage over their rivals. The seven-year-old held off the late challenge of Mirco Demuro on **Smart Ridge (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}). Kinane commented, "It's a nice, different atmosphere for us and on Group 1 days it can be pretty intense and you probably don't enjoy it as much as you should." Despite Flores' win in race two, **Ritz Club Shergar Cup Juvenile**, "Britain and Ireland" filled the next three places and maintained a 10-point advantage.

Team "Rest of the World" Bounces Back...

Britain and Ireland's dominance ended in the **Ritz Club Shergar Cup Distaff**, race three in the series, when jockey Gerald Mosse brought **Flying Millie (Ire)** (Flying Spur {Aus}) up late, defeating Mirco Demuro and **Ghazal (USA)** (Gone West {USA}). This time, team "Rest of the World" filled three of the first five positions, making them the leaders by 10 points on a total of 65. Mosse said, "I was sure that my filly was very well and in perfect condition so I had to kick early and make sure that I made some points for my team."

Team "Britain and Ireland" will not be denied...

The **Millennium and Copthorne Shergar Cup Stayers H.** went to the late running **Moon Emperor (GB)** (Emperor Jones {USA}) with jockey Pat Eddery aboard. That leveled the two teams at 80 points each. Eddery commented, "It's a lot of fun to ride in it and it's great to have all the top jockeys from around the world." The "Britain and Ireland" team finally took command in the fifth race as jockey Richard Hughes and **Thundering Surf (GB)** (Lugana Beach {Ire}) denied David Flores and **Mana d'Argent (Ire)** (Ela-Mana-Mou {Ire}) by a short head in the **Carvill Shergar Cup Challenge H.** The home team held an almost unassailable lead with 107 to 93 after filling three of the first five positions...almost.

"Rest of the World" back on top...

It was David Flores and Orienteur who led home a 1-2-3 finish for team "Rest of the World" in **Ritz Club Shergar Cup Juvenile**, final race of the challenge. He said after that performance, "Thanks to the trainers--these horses are great! I was just very grateful to be on these kind of horses today and it's an honour for me to be in this place. It's so beautiful. What a day!"

FABRE AND PESLIER RULE AT DEAUVILLE

Trainer Andre Fabre and jockey Olivier Peslier wrote another remarkable chapter in their story yesterday after having won with all five contenders at Deauville. Winning the opening two conditions events with **Shaanmer (Ire) (Darshaan {GB})** and **Restless Rixa (Fr) (Linamix {Fr})**, Peslier quickly followed up on Fabre's **Sangreal (NZ) (Celtic Swing {GB})** in the Listed Prix Ridgway. Fabre was without a representative in the fourth race, a handicap, where Peslier was fourth on **Quel Fontaneilles (Fr) (Tel Quel {Fr})**. They quickly resumed normal service with **Slew The Red (USA) (Red Ransom {USA})** in the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron and Peslier came back to score on **Visorhill (Fr) (Danehill {USA})** in a conditions event, marking his 100th winner of the year. Unplaced on **Royal Leon (Fr) (Garde Royale {Ire})** in the closing handicap, Peslier just failed to remain unbeaten while Fabre celebrated his perfect score. Peslier paid tribute to his retainer, "I am thrilled, for myself, but also for the stable of Mr. Fabre. He is a great professional and had some hard times earlier this season when losing the horses of Mr. Wildenstein. He reaps the dividends of his work and proves once again what a great trainer he is."

Yet it was Sangreal, the winner of a Saint-Cloud conditions event June 25, who put his seal on this race from the start. Never troubled in front, he stayed true in the straight as jockey Thierry Jarnet and Sensible wandered under pressure on his outside. The New Zealand bred was barely asked and went on to score comfortably over the beaten favourite.

This event was dominated by French horses for three years after becoming a Group 1 contest in 1995, but locals have since had to sit and suffer as Japanese and British raiders have stolen the glory. This year, the lack of top-class domestic sprinters is starkly illustrated by the fact that the sole defender, **Danger Over (GB)**, is himself without a stakes success so far this term. Last year, he was beaten a length by **Three Points (GB)** in the G3 Prix de Meautry here in August. That was the first try at sprinting for the then John Dunlop-trained colt and it showed he had the necessary speed to cope at stakes level in the division. He has raced consistently since, finishing a creditable runner-up to Harmonic Way (GB) in the G2 Cork & Orrery S. at Royal Ascot June 21 before running fourth to Mozart (Ire) in the highly competitive G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 12. Godolphin are keen to send the four-year-old over a more testing trip, stating yesterday that, "Three Points should appreciate the extra distance at Deauville." Of greater concern may be how he handles the much softer terrain. That may also account for the chances of **Minardi**, who is much better on a sound surface. Eighth last time in the G1 St. James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot after running fourth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5 and third to stable companion Black Minnaloushe in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 26, he is dropped back in trip here. If he handles the conditions and shows the form of his wins in the G1 Independent Heinz 57 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown last August and G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket last October, he has a major chance. Stable companion **King Charlemagne**, dropping back in distance for the first time since his two-year-old days, has wins in the G3 Ballycorus S. at Leopardstown June 13 and G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh July 15 this season.

When **Mutafaweq** beat Wellbeing (GB) by a short head in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 8, he was recording Group 1 success number four. That is made all the more remarkable by the fact that he almost died after the first of those, the G1 St. Leger at Doncaster in 1999, after suffering a severe bout of heat exhaustion. Lesser horses would have been soured by the experience, but Mutafaweq came back wanting more. Last year he took the G1 WGZ-Bank-Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf in July and the G1 Canadian International at Woodbine in October in the same dogged fashion. His rivals are headed by **Anzillero (Ger)**, winner of the G1 WGZ-Bank-Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf July 22. That performance was a career-best effort, but he may not get the better of runner-up **Sabiango (Ger)** again here. That colt was a late withdrawal from the G1 Deutsches Derby due to deteriorating conditions at Hamburg July 1. The German Derby was won by **Boreal (Ger)**, who resumes his successful partnership with jockey John Reid and must be respected. **Subiaco (Ger)**, fourth at Dusseldorf last time, bids to provide Andreas Starke with his first win in this contest. Third to Catella (Ger) last year when this race was run at Gelsenkirchen, he was an impressive winner of the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne Apr. 29.

El Corredor, a.k.a. "the runner," runs into a competitive field in his first start since taking the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 25. Five-for-seven lifetime, he captured the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. over this surface last September and came back to be second, beaten 3/4 of a length by Fusaichi Pegasus, in the GII Jerome H. The accomplished miler tries seven furlongs for the first time. **Swept Overboard**, first and third in two starts over this tricky surface, won the Robert Kerlan Memorial H. sprinting on the Hollywood turf two back. He comes off a third-place finish behind Kona Gold and Caller One in the GII Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. July 22. The off-the-pace runner posted a career-high 116 Beyer figure that day, better than any of today's competition have run. **Blade Prospector**, always near the pace, has tried to carry his speed over a distance in his last two starts. "Last time, she won pretty handily and she acted like she would go the seven-eighths," jockey David Cark said. "That was our biggest concern, but she just did it wonderfully. She's got a very bright future." Added trainer Robert Tiller, "This filly is just a powerhouse and she proved today what she can do. I was really concerned hooking these kinds of horses at seven-eighths, but she handled it. I think this filly is something special."

Nayef showed his class here with an authoritative display to outclass his rivals. He was the big story of the winter as the unbeaten ante-post favourite for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, but the bubble was burst before he turned up for that Classic. A one-paced third in the G3 Craven S. Apr. 19, he was sent to the Guineas in the hope that his return performance was not his true form, but finished eighth. He was given a rest by Marcus Tregoning after that effort, coming back to be third to Alexius (Ire) in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood July 31, and was heavily favored to get back to winning ways this time. Taken to the front early by Richard Hills, he settled well to take the field along. His lead looked momentarily threatened at the top of the straight as Richard Quinn moved Inglenook (Ire) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) menacingly onto his tail. That was the impetus the giant colt needed, however, and with maximum encouragement from Hills, he changed stride and lengthened away, powering clear for an emphatic success. Connections may now supplement him for the G1 Rothmans Royals St. Leger at Doncaster Sept. 15. "He's learning more all the time and he needs racing," Tregoning said. "We gave him that run at Goodwood which has done him good and I'm very pleased today. We might well consider the St. Leger, but it's entirely up to Sheikh Hamdan."
