BALLYDOYLE BONANZA

Johannesburg (Hennessy) produced a performance of the highest order at Leopardstown yesterday afternoon to destroy his rivals and provide Ballydoyle master Aidan O'Brien with his fourth consecutive success in the G1 Independent Waterford Wedgwood Phoenix S. Off at 2-5, he won with such ease that William Hill were driven to cut his odds for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket to 6-1. He was barely off the bridle until asked to win his race by jockey Michael Kinane with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, where he quickened away brilliantly to win by five lengths over 25-1 **Miss Beabea (Ire)** (Catrail). In doing so he confirmed the suggestion from O'Brien that he had improved since his last run, when beating stable companion **Wiseman's Ferry** (Hennessy) by four lengths in the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14. In fact, he has not been tested in his four starts, including a Fairyhouse maiden May 30 and the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21 at a furlong shorter. Here he was settled in fourth early by Kinane as **Line Rider** (Danzig) tried to establish a fair pace on his behalf. His stable companion was never going fast enough, however, and as Kinane swept by in the closing stages, he made his rivals look like poor platers. Speeding clear in a matter of strides under economic riding, he established himself in another league. "Michael [Kinane] was very confident," O'Brien said. "Johannesburg has superb acceleration and has never been extended. He'll have no problem with seven furlongs." The trainer was collecting his 10th Group 1 win of the 2001 season, having witnessed King Charlemagne take the ninth an hour and a half earlier at Deauville. Johannesburg may now head to the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 26 before a tilt at the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket Oct. 4.

SHOW ME THE MONEY

Cashier's Dream (Service Stripe) is the morning-line favorite for today's GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga, but she is unfamiliar with the role. The Michigan-bred paid \$88.20 when she broke her maiden for a \$50,000 tag at Churchill Downs May 18 and \$37.80 when she made it two straight in a Churchill allowance race June 20. But owner/breeder/trainer James Jackson really scored when he sold the filly after that race. Exactly how much Team Valor and Heiligbrodt Racing Stable paid has not been disclosed, but it had to be significantly more than it cost to breed the two-year-old, whose sire stands for a fee of \$2,500. Cashier's Dream wasted little time earning back some of her purchase price, leading every step to take the GIII Debutante S. July 7. "After we bought her, she continued to train very well," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "There was the normal adjustment of going from one trainer to another, but she kept moving forward. At first, we had no intention of running in the Debutante, but she kept training the right way." The chestnut put on an formidable performance in her graded-stakes debut, winning by 3 1/2 lengths and setting a track record in the process as she covered the 5 1/2 furlongs in 1:02 2/5. "None of us expected that kind of effort," Asmussen said. "When she won it, the thought was, 'Yeah, let's go to Saratoga and see what she can do.'" Only one of her competitors has shown what she can do at the Spa. **Magic Storm** (Storm Cat) made her second career start at Saratoga July 29 and finished well to win by a widening 4 1/4 lengths for trainer D. Wayne Lukas. Lukas has won the Adirondack five times, taking four consecutive runnings of the race from 1985-88, and adding another victory with Salty Perfume in 1997.

FALLON DOUBLE MATCHED BY DARLEY

Kieren Fallon yesterday rode a double at Ascot in the first two races before seeing his advantage at the head of the jockeys' championship diminished by a double Kevin Darley in the next two races. Fallon remains six ahead of last year's champion on 108, with Richard Quinn on 89 in third. Fallon, who is bidding for his fourth title, last won in 1999, took the opening two handicaps on the card on **Soft Breeze (GB)** (Zafonic {USA}) and **Scheming (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}). Darley then took the Listed Amtico EBF Valiant S. on **Riberac (GB)** (Efisio {GB}) before winning the fourth race on **Salviati (USA)** (Lahib {USA}) Fallon warned: "I think it's going to be quite close. Kevin Darley is there, but I think Richard Quinn isn't out of it. It is a pity he got a suspension at Brighton the other day because that really would have made it interesting. Three of us going into the last couple of months with nothing between us. It's all to play for if you avoid the suspensions and injury. It's going to be interesting for the public. It would be great to win the championship back. It's going to be tough. One of the previous years, I was way in front and I won by 50 or 60 winners and it wasn't that exciting but this year it's going to be." Earlier he had told the *News of the World*: "This season's jockeys' title means a lot to me--perhaps even more than the three I have got in the bag. When I came back from my arm injury there were plenty of knockers out there. They were whispering that I wasn't as strong as before and that I wouldn't be able to make it back to the top. I knew then, right back in March, that the only way to properly shut them up would be to win the title back from Kevin." Fallon is currently quoted as the 1-20 favourite to emerge triumphant with Cashmans, who quote Kevin Darley at odds of 9-2 and Richard Quinn at 1-33.

SHUTTLERS SET TO ARRIVE

Five-time Australian champion sire **Danehill (USA)**, who ended the 2000-2001 season at the top of the sires' table with 188 runners for 93 winners including 13 stakes winners and earnings of A\$7,734,448, heads Monday's influx of Northern Hemisphere stallions arriving for the southern season. Danehill is making his 12th consecutive trip to Australia and his 23rd successive hemisphere change to head the roster at Coolmore Australia at a fee listed as private but believed to be around A\$200,000. He'll arrive in Sydney on a flight via Dubai and Singapore. Three other flights, which will be carrying horses from the United Kingdom, Ireland and France, are scheduled to arrive in the coming week, including a private 747 freighter owned by the Dubai Royal Family coming from Shannon; a 747 from Amsterdam and a 747 coming from Dublin. **Octagonal (NZ)** and **Anabaa (USA)** will be aboard the plane from Amsterdam arriving Tuesday, along with Victorian property the Independent Stallion Station's **Dolphin Street (Fr)** and **Brief Truce (USA)** and Eureka's **Piccolo (GB)**. "It is a considerable relief to everyone in the Australian and New Zealand bloodstock industry that, despite foot and mouth in Europe, this year's stallion shuttle has taken place," said International Racehorse Transport's managing director Quentin Wallace. "Although we started making plans as early as February this year for the shuttle flights, nothing could have prepared us or the studs for the convoluted process required by quarantine to complete this year's shuttle. It will be a relief to everyone when the job is finally completed." Accompanying Danehill on his flight will be **Orpen (USA)**, **Fasliyev (USA)** and **Desert King (Ire)**, who are also bound for Coolmore; Collingrove's **Perugino (USA)** and **Danehill Dancer (Ire)**; WA stud Heytesbury's **Second Empire (Ire)**; Yarraman Park's **Spectrum (Ire)**; **Monashee Mountain (USA)** and **Victory Note (USA)**, who are headed for Willowbend in Queensland; as well as **Desert Prince (Ire)**, **Grand Lodge (USA)** and **Dracula (Aus)**, who are going to Woodlands Stud in NSW. Also on that plane will be **King's Theatre (Ire)** and **Shinko Forest (Ire)**, who are going to Glenlogan Park in Queensland; Arrowfield's **Ashkalani (Ire)** and **Danzero (Aus)**; Victorian stud Eliza Park's **Desert Sun (GB)**; South Australian stud Lindsay Park's **General Monash (USA)**; Widden's **Dr. Fong (USA)**; **Mind Games (GB)**,

who is going to Roseneath near Sydney; and Vinery Australia's **Loup Sauvage (USA)**. Darley's **King's Best (USA)**, **Singspiel (Ire)**, **Lujain (USA)** and **Xaar (GB)** will be on the Dubai Air Wing flight along with seven other of the Royal Family's stallions: **Saratoga Springs (Can)**, who is headed for Milluna Stud in Queensland; Collingrove's **Marju (Ire)**; and freshman **Mujahid (USA)**, going to Widden Stud as well as **Cape Cross (Ire)**, **Fly To The Stars (GB)**, **Bahhare (USA)** and **Almutawakel (GB)**, who are bound for New Zealand. **Montjeu (Ire)**, **Woodborough (USA)**, **Daggers Drawn (USA)** and **Lake Coniston (Ire)** will be on the Singapore Airlines flight straight from Dublin to Auckland. A total of 37 stallions including 13 bound for Argentina and Chile will depart North America.

As for what's next, Voss said, "I don't know what to do. It seems strange to put a 10-year-old horse on Lasix. A horse couldn't have bled more than he did. We'll work him a couple of times and hope for cooler weather."

King Charlemagne and Jamie Spencer came from last to first to beat Three Points (GB) and Pat Eddery by a neck in an exciting finish. In doing so, the colt added to the remarkable Group 1 tally of Aidan O'Brien, who notched up his ninth win at the highest level so far in 2001. Dropping back in distance after two fine victories in the G3 Ballycorus S. at Leopardstown June 13 and the G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh July 15, both at seven furlongs, King Charlemagne acquitted himself well on this easy ground. Last year, he showed a willing attitude when winning the G3 Somerville Tattersall S. at Newmarket by a neck from Grandera (Ire) at the end of September. In fact, he has only tasted defeat once, on his debut in York's Convivial Maiden S. last August, and he has proved a tough cookie ever since. Held up in last place here as Eddery took Three Points into his customary front-running position, he travelled easily as his rivals struggled to close on the leader. His jockey was looking for room with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining, finding it between the fading Tertullian (Miswaki) and Watching (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}). Quickening from there as he pursued Three Points, the colt drifted left under pressure, but found something in reserve to pass the game front-runner in the final 100 yards before going away to a comfortable success. Winning owner Michael Tabor was delighted. "This is a fast-improving horse and this Group 1 race fit perfectly on his agenda," Tabor said. "He might now return in the G1 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup [at Haydock Sept. 8], but we will discuss the situation with his trainer." Spencer, winning his fourth Group 1 race, explained, "I was instructed to go handy, but the horse missed the break and I had no other choice than to wait. When I asked him, he quickened nicely and won very comfortably. He is a real nice horse and can still improve off that run." King Charlemagne is the first three-year-old to win this event since College Chapel (GB) in 1993. O'Brien, at Leopardstown to saddle Johannesburg in the G1 Phoenix S., told *PA Sport*, "We have always rated this horse highly and the drop back in distance today was not a problem. He has plenty of pace."

For a short period approaching the final turn it looked as though Frankie Dettori and Mutafaweq (Silver Hawk) would be the main danger, but that horse started to tread water soon after and it was left to the two at the head of affairs to fight it out. Grabbing the lead with a furlong remaining, Sabiango showed his toughness to overcome the determined effort of Belenus. Boreal came with a bold late run, but, in a thrilling finish, it was Sabiango who held on for the win.

Only one horse has finished in front of El Corredor since a fourth-place effort in his 1999 debut, and that was none other than last year's Kentucky Derby winner, Fusaichi Pegasus. The judiciously campaigned colt broke his maiden in his second start at two, added a Santa Anita allowance win in January of last year, then went to the sidelines for nearly seven months before making it three straight in a Del Mar allowance just over a year ago. The dark bay tried stakes company for the first time in the GII Del Mar Breeders' Cup H. last Sept. 3 and ran his streak to four with a 2 1/2-length victory, then missed beating "Fu Peg" by three-quarters of a length in the GII Jerome H. at Belmont Park Sept. 23. Sent off the favorite in his next appearance, the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 25, he ended the season with yet another victory and he was looking to pick up where he left off here. The crowd's 3-2 favorite had been working sharply and proved ready for his return, contesting fast early fractions before asserting himself in the drive to the wire. "I wasn't sure he was ready, but he was doing well and I thought he would run well," winning trainer Bob Baffert said. "He's a classy horse, a great sprinter. He's had some problems, a little this and that, but he's really a good horse. Sometimes, when they are away that long, you forget how good they are." Added jockey Victor Espinoza, "You ride a horse like this with a lot of confidence. I let him run away from there on his own. I didn't really ask him to
