ONLY YOU

Who was going to be able to beat the 3-5 favorite in yesterday's GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga? Only **You** (You and I). Making her debut for trainer Bobby Frankel, You dogged odds-on choice **Cashier's Dream** (Service Stripe) around the far turn, got to her throatlatch in deep stretch and just managed to battle her way to the lead in the final strides to win it by a neck. It was 15 1/4 lengths back to **Magic Storm** (Storm Cat) in third; the time of 1:15 for the 6 1/2 furlongs was a stakes record. "The weight made the difference," Frankel admitted. "We got seven pounds from [Cashier's Dream]." But trainer Steve Asmussen was gracious in defeat. "I don't want to make excuses for her," he said. "I'm disappointed that we didn't win, but I'm still proud of the effort she put in." Previously trained by Hal Wiggins, You broke her maiden for a \$50,000 tag at Churchill Downs June 1, then finished second to Cashier's Dream in an allowance test over a muddy strip June 20. Both fillies changed hands after that race, but while Cashier's Dream went on to win the GIII Debutante S. July 7, You was sent straight to New York and given a short break. "She was obviously fit when we bought her, because I didn't have to do much with her," Frankel said. The GI Spinaway S. Aug. 31 could be next for the winner.

GALILEO HEADS QEII ENTRIES Dual Derby winner **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) heads the 45 entries for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. to be contested over a mile at Ascot Sept. 29. The colt, trained by Aidan O'Brien, has already proven himself at a mile and a half so far this season, when winning the G1 Epsom Derby June 9, G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh July 1 and the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in his most recent start July 28. He could face the best of the European milers there, including **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danahill {USA}), winner of the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22, and **Noverre (USA)** (Rahy {USA}), who avenged his G1 St James' Palace S. defeat by **Black Minnaloushe (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) last time in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 1. The latter is one of 18 Ballydoyle representatives left in, as is **Mozart (Ire)** (Danahill {USA}), winner of the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 12. "Once again the Queen Elizabeth II S. looks like the race that will decide the title of Europe's top miler," Ascot Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne said yesterday. "The question on everyone's lips is sure to be whether Galileo will come here and attempt to stamp himself as one of the truly great champions by adding the mile championship to his undisputed dominance in the middle-distance sphere. If he showed the speed to win over a mile here and, given the proven stamina and courage he displayed to win the King George, there might be a few worried faces in America when he goes over to take on Point Given in the Breeders' Cup Classic." The new sponsors for the mile event, the highlight of the three day festival Sept. 28-30, were announced yesterday as BETDAQ, an Irish-based bet brokerage service, who are also sponsoring the G2 Diadem S. on the same afternoon.

AMBITIOUS PLAN FOR JOHANNESBURG Aidan O'Brien will not let **Johannesburg (USA)** (Hennessy {USA}) rest on his laurels after his five-length success in Sunday's G1 Independent Waterford Wedgwood Phoenix S. at Leopardstown. The unbeaten colt heads to Deauville now for the G1 Prix Morny Aug. 26 and he could attempt the difficult double of the G1 Middle Park S. and G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Oct. 4 and Oct. 20. O'Brien saddled **Fasliyev (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}) to win the Prix Morny after taking the Phoenix S. in 1999, while last year **Minardi (USA)** (Boundary {USA}) followed up success in the Leopardstown race with victory in the Middle Park S. Johannesburg was quoted as low as 6-1 for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket after his sensational victory on Sunday, but O'Brien was taking a sensible view about that Classic: "The Guineas is a long way away, but I don't think he will have a problem getting seven furlongs this year and the way he relaxes, you can't say he won't get a mile. There is no doubt he is a very brilliant two year old. I never compare horses, but this horse is a brilliant two year old whose acceleration is electric. He just has two extra gears. You'd be looking at the Middle Park and the Dewhurst later on, but we'll try and get the Morny out of the way first."

FORTUNE FAVOURED AFTER FALL

Jimmy Fortune is recovering from a fall at Folkestone yesterday after landing a double. Having crossed the line on **Welenska (GB)** (Danzig Connection {USA}) in the second division of the Eastwell Manor Median Auction Maiden S., he was thrown from the colt and kicked in the face and groin. Fortune was taken to the William Harvey Hospital at Ashford for X-rays which revealed no serious damage. Racecourse medical officer, Joe Baker, explained: "As he fell, he got a kick to the head. He has been taken to hospital with a suspected head injury. He is stable and he is conscious." Fortune had taken the first division of the maiden on the Cole-trained **Corton (Ire)** (Definite Article {GB}).

He was consigned by Gerald Nielsen (Sunnyfield Farm), Summerfield, agent. The two colts were the lone representatives of their sire at the sale.

Travers Hopefuls Breeze:

The unlucky **Dollar Bill** (Peaks and Valleys), who suffered through terrible trips in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, worked six furlongs in 1:14 over the Saratoga main track yesterday morning with new jockey Jorge Chavez in the saddle. The colt, a distant fourth in the June 9 GI Belmont S. last time out, makes his next start in the \$1 million GI Travers S. Aug. 25. "We thought about pointing to races like the Jim Dandy and Haskell, but thought it best to give him a long break," trainer Dallas Stewart said. "The whole barn needed one after the Triple Crown. It was very frustrating. Maybe he'll need a race to get back into top form, but he belongs with these horses. It's going to be a wide-open race and we've got as good a shot as anyone else in there."

Also getting ready for the 1 1/4-mile Travers, Preakness and Belmont S. runner-up **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy) went five-eighths in 1:02 on the main track. Jockey John Velazquez was in the irons. "It was nothing special, just an easy work," trainer Nick Zito said. The three-year-old comes off a lackluster fourth-place finish in the GI Jim Dandy S. Aug. 4. "He'd had two months off and maybe his head wasn't in it," Zito said.

GI Jim Dandy winner **Scorpion** (Seattle Slew) breezed five furlongs in 1:02 on the Oklahoma training track yesterday, galloping out a sharp six furlongs in 1:14... **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance), who makes his stakes debut in the Travers, went six furlongs in 1:14 yesterday. The colt comes off a 13-length allowance victory July 30. "His last performance was good, but he'll need to improve in the Travers," trainer Phil Johnson said. Because the failure rate among young stallions is so high, many of them gradually metamorphose from hero on the racetrack into villain of the breeding world. Unfortunately, the transformation didn't take very long for Ogygian, one of the most exciting juveniles of 1985.

Even though he enjoyed the invaluable support of the Claiborne clientele and came from the same family as Fappiano, the son of Damascus was struggling for survival virtually as soon as his first crop failed to produce a graded-stakes winner. His fee slipped from its customary \$35,000 to \$20,000 in 1993, then to \$12,500 in 1994 and by the fall of 1995 he was winging his way to Japan. He never did manage to sire a Grade I winner.

The \$35,000 paid for one of Ogygian's yearling fillies at Keeneland's 1994 September Sale could be described as symptomatic of his declining popularity. This filly was the first foal of Yarn, a sister by Mr. Prospector to the Grade I winner Preach, and her female line traced back to Monarchy, a stakes-winning sister to the extraordinary Round Table.

Named Myth, the filly was a winner at two and her value was greatly boosted by events in 1997. The year got off to a very good start when Pulpit, a son of Preach, looked a potential Kentucky Derby winner, and the family's prestige soared again when Myth's half-brother Tale Of The Cat won three of his first four

starts, including the GII King's Bishop S.

Tale Of The Cat, a son of Storm Cat, had cost \$375,000 as a yearling, and Myth's owners had taken the hint, selecting Storm Cat's son Hennessy as Myth's first mate in 1997. Predictably, she made many times her yearling price when she came on the market again later that year, with Wayne G. Lyster III signing the tab at \$350,000. Sadly, Myth's Hennessy colt died as a weanling, but the mating was repeated in 1998, with Myth being sent to another of Storm Cat's sons, Tabasco Cat, in 1999.

Myth came on the market again that year, with Barronstown Stud paying \$250,000 for the mare just minutes before her Hennessy weanling realised \$240,000.

Unfortunately for the purchasers of the Hennessy weanling, Hennessy did not make as big an impact as many expected when his first runners began to race last year and he still hadn't come up with his first stakes winner, from nearly 30 starters, by the time his yearling out of Myth was offered on Sept. 12.

Demi O'Byrne must have been delighted that he was able to get him for \$200,000, compared to the \$1,650,000 he had had to pay the previous year for a Boundary colt from this family.

By the time O'Byrne bought the Hennessy--Myth colt, the Boundary colt, named Minardi, had already become a Group 1 winner, taking the six-furlong Phoenix S. by five lengths. Now history has repeated itself, with Myth's son, the exciting Johannesburg, taking the same race by the same margin. The question now is how much Johannesburg will continue to follow in Minardi's footsteps.

Although Minardi recorded another Group 1 victory and took the title of champion juvenile, he found a few too good for him in the English and Irish 2000 Guineas and has returned to sprinting. Johannesburg is now favorite to make amends for Minardi's failure in the 2000 Guineas and he's unbeaten in four races, three of them Group events.

The Japanese champion two-year-old filly of 1999, Yamakatsu Suzuran was 12th in the G1 Yasuda Kinen June 3 at Tokyo before improving off that effort to be second in the G3 Mermaid S. at Hanshin in her most recent effort July 8. The race favorite broke cleanly from the inside post, dictated the pace and was clear under the line. "I am really pleased to win a graded stakes with this filly," said winning jockey Kenichi Ikezoe, who had recently returned from France. "After coming back from France, I think I am riding with a lot of confidence."

His emergence as an outstanding juvenile provides Hennessy with a well-timed boost before the September Sales. My assessment of this stallion's career so far is that he has suffered from unrealistic expectations. These were fueled by hopes that Hennessy would prove nearly as effective as his exceptional sire Storm Cat, continuing parallels from their racing careers.

In the 1985 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, Storm Cat was in the lead after the opening three-quarters and it was only in the last strides that he was caught. Ten years later, Hennessy repeated his sire's performance. On top after six furlongs, he battled it out all the way up the stretch with Unbridled's Song, conceding victory only close home. The compilers of the Experimental Free Handicap gave Storm Cat and Hennessy identical marks of 124.

It must be remembered, though, that Hennessy retired to Ashford at a fee no higher than \$30,000, so the buyers who forced up his average price to nearly \$250,000 and his median to \$190,000 at the 1999 yearling sales could be accused of over-optimism.

Hennessy looks a good deal more promising now than he did a year ago. His first crop of over 100 foals contains the Grade II winners Keats (Lexington S.) and Distilled (Illinois Derby), the Group 3 winner Perigee Moon and the fast filly Harmony Lodge. Johannesburg heads a second crop which also contains the Phoenix S. fourth Wiseman's Ferry.

While it's still too soon to be drawing many conclusions about Hennessy's needs, it is worth mentioning that Mr. Prospector appears in the third generation of the pedigrees of Johannesburg, Distilled and Harmony Lodge and that both Johannesburg and Keats were produced by granddaughters of Damascus. As Storm Cat has a fine record with mares by Damascus and his sons, as well as with Mr. Prospector and his sons,
