A SPECIAL START

Overbrook's royally bred **Jump Start** (A.P. Indy) reared in the gate prior to the start of the GI Saratoga Special S. yesterday, but rallied in the stretch to maintain his perfect record. The dark bay homebred debuted as the favorite at Churchill June 23, dueling early before drawing away to a clear score. Off since then, he signaled his readiness with a bullet five-panel drill in 1:00 2/5 over the Oklahoma track Aug. 9 and was sent off as the crowd's choice. He acted up just before the gates opened, but was quickly away in stride and raced a few lengths back in third as **Heavyweight Champ** (Two Punch) tore through fractions of :21 2/5 and :44 2/5. That colt held a 2 1/2-length lead at the eighth pole, but Jump Start had started his run on the turn and closed steadily on the tiring leader, forging ahead in the final strides to give trainer D. Wayne Lukas his third winner of this event. "This was not the spot we had mind," Lukas said. "We were going to go 'other than' into the Hopeful [9-1], but we had to use this for the 'other than.' I told Pat [jockey Day], 'Don't give him too much to do, but don't abuse him either.'" The colt could be something special, according to Lukas. "I really think a lot of this horse," he added. "He's got great qualities. He's got looks, pedigree and a lot going for him. He handles things in the paddock well and he's great in the post parade. I think this one could take us to the Promised Land." In the meantime, the seven-furlong GI Hopeful S. could be next for the two-year-old, or he may await the GI Futurity S. Sept. 16 over a mile at Belmont. "The Belmont races are going to fit him," Lukas continued. "His pedigree says he's going to go longer. If he comes back bouncing and springing around, we'll consider the Hopeful." *Saratoga Special chart, p2*

LOOKING LIKE A MILLION

Twenty years ago, the inaugural Arlington Million featured a thrilling finish as John Henry nipped The Bart at the wire of the world's first million-dollar race. This year, an international field of 11 runners have been entered for Saturday's GI Arlington Million XIX, headed by American runners **Bienamado** (Bien Bien) and **Hap** (Theatrical {Ire}). Bienamado finished fourth as the favorite last year, but has been unstoppable on turf in 2001 and has been pointing for Arlington since a sharp victory in the GI Whittingham H. June 10 at Hollywood. Second that day was **Senure** (Nureyev), who was subsequently awarded victory in the GI United Nations H. July 1 at Monmouth. A victory by this horse would be the second straight for Juddmonte, who won last year with Chester House. Unbeaten in three starts this year, Hap will be trying 10 furlongs for the first time. The flashy chestnut has been a star at nine panels, winning his last seven tries at the distance, including the GI Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga July 27. Born in Brazil but now based in California, **Redattore (Brz)** (Roi Normand) earned a Million berth with a good-looking victory in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 28. The peripatetic **Silvano** has shipped from his German home to win in both Hong Kong and Singapore in 2001 and will be making his North American debut.

KINANE MAY MISS MOZART Michael Kinane may miss the ride on **Mozart (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) in Thursday's G1 Nunthorpe S. at York as the saga surrounding his suspension continues. Kinane received a two-day ban which would have ruled him out of the July 28 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., but was awarded an interim injunction on the ban so that he could ride Galileo (Ire) to victory at Ascot that day. Nevertheless, the Irish Turf Club will decide whether to contest the injunction on Tuesday before the hearing at the Dublin High Court on Wednesday. This critical judgement will determine at the last minute whether Kinane can ride Mozart, the highly impressive G1 July Cup winner at Newmarket July 12, in the five-furlong sprint championship at York.

RELISH THE THOUGHT RETIRED **Relish The Thought (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) has been retired, her connections announced yesterday. The Barry Hills-trained filly was second in the G3 Musidora S. at York May 15 before finishing under 1 1/2 lengths third to Imagine (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 8. Disappointing when tenth in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 15, she was then fifth in the Listed Chalice S. at Newbury Aug. 8. Joe Mercer, racing manager to owner Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum, told the *Racing Post*, "There is nothing at all wrong with her but she has just lost her way a bit--she ran disappointingly in Ireland and she ran disappointingly at Newbury--and we thought we would call it a day. She is a beautifully bred mare who is Group 1-placed and Group 2-placed, and is a Listed winner." That win came in the Listed Radley S. at Newbury last October.

JOHANNESBURG MAY HAVE BATTLE IN MORN Yesterday's conditions winner **War Zone (USA)** (Danzig {USA}) threw down the gauntlet to G1 Phoenix S. winner Johannesburg with his highly impressive conditions victory over the Deauville course yesterday. Owned and bred by Prince Khalid Abdullah, War Zone was made 2-5 following a dandy run at Maisons-Laffitte July 25 and had no problem taking his score to a perfect two-for-two under Olivier Peslier. Both he and Johannesburg are both on track to meet in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 26.

Premier Prize was a shock winner here for all but her trainer David Elsworth. She was 15th in last year's G1 Epsom Oaks in June and only made her re-appearance in the Listed Aphrodite S. at Newmarket July 21 when tenth to Ranin (GB). Last of five behind Slickly (Fr) in a Sandown conditions event Aug. 8 on her last start, she went un-noticed by punters here. Held up in fourth early as Sauterne (GB) (Rainbow Quest {USA}) led, she was moved up between that filly and Katy Nowaitee with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining. Taking command from there, she lengthened away for a comfortable first stakes success. Elsworth explained, "She was beaten by four or five lengths at Sandown by a Group One/Group Two horse of Godolphin's so I thought she was remarkably generous odds. It's not unrealistic to believe that she was going to be a very good filly and she is. She's had all sorts of problems but she's overcome these injuries--We've run her rather quickly and there's still improvement in her."

NEW RECORDS AT DEL MAR SALE A pair of yearlings brought bids of \$100,000 to top Tuesday's session of the Del Mar Yearling Sale as the auction concluded with new records for average and gross. The first to hit the mark was Hip 80, an End Sweep colt purchased by Craig Lewis for Kirkwood Thoroughbreds. Out of the Vigors mare Tamworth Lass, the chestnut colt is a half-brother to stakes-placed Storm Lass (Storm Creek). He was followed by Hip 95, a colt by In Excess (Ire) out of MSW Above the Table (Never Tabled). Stanley Fulton signed the ticket for the dark bay Cal-bred. In all, 55 yearlings grossed \$2,238,000 on Tuesday for an average price of \$35,418. Despite 27 fewer yearlings selling this year, the total gross increased 10 percent from last year, while the cumulative average of \$43,663 easily bested the previous record of \$36,798. "It's very gratifying to see the continued growth of this sale," said Doug Burge, general manager of California Thoroughbred Breeders Association Sales. "The records we set are a clear sign that the Thoroughbred breeding program in California is healthy and strong, and we will continue our work to keep it that way."

EXCHANGE RATE TO PADUA Padua Stables has announced that their recently retired **Exchange Rate** (Danzig--Sterling Pound, by Seeking the Gold) will enter stud at the Sanans' Ocala, Florida farm in 2002. 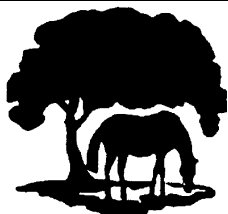

The plague of short fields in California was evident as only three horses started in the Del Mar feature yesterday, but nothing could take away from Officer's open-company debut as the Bertrando colt won with consummate ease under a motionless Victor Espinoza. With Werblin (Unbridled's Song) a late scratch, the three colts broke sharply, and Espinoza settled Officer into third as Metatron showed the way. Officer came to his shoulder through a half in :44 1/5, put a head in front turning for home and easily widened his advantage while never getting out of a high gallop, setting a new stakes record in the process. "It's the easiest I've ever won on any horse," Espinoza enthused. "I'll tell you right now, I think he's a champion. I just let out a little bit on the reins and he did the rest. Have you ever seen one like him?" A \$700,000 purchase this March at Barretts, Officer started things off with a six-length victory against fellow Cal-breds July 6, then took the Graduation S. over this surface July 25 by eight lengths. "Those Cal-breds that ran second and third to him [last out] shouldn't feel too bad now," said trainer Bob Baffert. As for the scratch of stablemate Ecstatic (Rahy), Baffert said, "We worked the horses together the other day and we gave Ecstatic an eight-length head start and this horse just galloped by him, so I didn't want to do that to [Ecstatic]. I don't think he's ever been asked to run. I don't know what he'll do when we ask him."
