SKIMMING SEEKING SECOND CLASSIC

Juddmonte Farms' **Skimming** (Nureyev) was installed as the 8-5 favorite to win his second consecutive GI Pacific Classic when he drew post three yesterday for Sunday's race at Del Mar. His favoritism is hard to argue with. The five-year-old owns the track, having won three races, all graded stakes, in three starts over the unique strip. His connections have dominated the race in the 10 years since its inception--owner Juddmonte Farms has won three of the runnings and trainer Bobby Frankel has saddled the winner five times. With Dubai World Cup winner Captain Steve still looking for his pre-Dubai form, Skimming's trainer Bobby Frankel seems most concerned about the rejuvenated **Dixie Dot Com** (Dixie Brass). "I'm glad he drew inside Dixie Dot Com," said Frankel, who will be in New York and doubts if he'll get back to California in time for the race due to the early post time. "I know Dixie Dot Com has some speed, but I don't expect him to go suicide on me." The six-year-old Dixie Dot Com, winner of the GIII Texas Mile and GIII Lone Star H., drew the outside post. "Our post is fine," assured trainer William Morey, Jr. "I just wish we were back at Lone Star. He loved it down there." **Futural** (Future Storm), who has danced every possible dance in Southern California since taking the GII San Bernadino in April, was only a length behind Skimming last time in the GII San Diego H. July 29. His trainer Craig Dollase hopes he won't have to contest with a loose-on-the-lead Skimming Sunday. "I need some pace in the race," said Dollase. "Someone who'll go with Skimming. It's going to be a very tactical race."

MEDICEAN TO MEET OLD RIVALS IN INTERNATIONAL

Sir Michael Stoute yesterday held a strong hand with two of the main protagonists among the 14 five-day entries for Tuesday's £450,000 G1 Juddmonte International S. at York. **Medicean (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}), who holds several of his rivals on the form of his win in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 7, looks likely to bid for a follow-up success alongside **No Excuse Needed (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}), second in the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 1 last time. Kieren Fallon, who will ride Medicean, stressed the importance of the ground. "You don't like to see all this rain around in the North and hopefully they've missed this at York, but it's a big factor for him," he said. "He'll get away with good ground, but he loves to hear his feet rattle and that's where he's at his best." Medicean had both Aidan O'Brien's **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}) and **Black Minnaloushe (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) under a length back in third and fifth respectively at Sandown last time. That pair are two of four left in by the Ballydoyle trainer along with **Darwin (Ire)** (Daneshill {USA}) and **Bonnard (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}). Black Minnaloushe was the winner of the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot from **Noverre (USA)** (Rahy {USA}), one of three entries for Godolphin alongside **Tobougg (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}), who was fourth in the Eclipse S. and **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}), runner-up to Sinnidar (Ire) in last year's G1 Epsom Derby. Simon Crisford, Godolphin racing manager, told the *Racing Post*: "We were pleased with the way he worked and Sakhee is heading toward the Juddmonte International. Tobougg is a possible in the Juddmonte International or the Great Voltigeur. We will take a rain-check on him closer to the time." James Fanshawe's **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge {USA}), runner-up to Medicean at Sandown, is on course for the re-match according to his trainer. Fanshawe told *PA Sport* yesterday: "My intention is to go for the Juddmonte, although we have got the option of the Great Voltigeur as well. I hope the rains keep away." The going was changed yesterday by clerk of the course John Smith to good to soft after rain yesterday morning.

After defeating King's Best (USA) in the G3 Craven S. at Newmarket last April, Umistim had looked vulnerable in stakes company. This year, however, he has matured into a consistent individual at this level and higher. Fifth to Medicean (GB) in both the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 19 and the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 19, he was sent to a conditions event at Newbury July 20 where he beat the smart Aldebaran (USA) by a neck. Here, he was held up in third early as Down to the Woods (USA) (Woodman {USA}) and King's Ironbridge (Ire) (King's Theatre {Ire}) disputed the early lead. As the former strode on before halfway, Dane O'Neill was travelling easily and as Surprise Encounter and Gary Carter moved up to lead with a quarter-mile remaining, Umistim was close behind. Shaking off that challenger at the distance, he was pushed out to hold the improving Momentum and Richard Quinn.

Chairman Peter Savill said: "His love of horseracing will be an added advantage in getting to grips quickly with his brief at this key time for both BHB and British racing."

BREW MAY BE RETIRED

The immediate future of Melbourne Cup winner Brew (NZ) (Sir Tristram {Ire}) is in doubt with an injury to his off-fore knee, making it unlikely the seven-year-old will race again. Brew was at around 25-1 in early betting to complete back-to-back Cups, but part-owner Paul Moroney said the gelding trained by his brother Mike was likely to be retired after veterinarian Dr. Jim Marks examined the horse. Brew hasn't raced for five months, and was last seen when unplaced in the G1 Ranvet S. Moroney said the injury was the same problem that ruled Brew out of the Sydney Cup. Should he not race again, he will retire with seven wins from 42 starts, and earnings of A\$2,3,83,480.

DIATRIBE TO STUD

Diatribе (Aus) (Brief Truce {USA}) was a shock omission from Saturday's Group 1 Manikato S. at Moonee Valley in Melbourne, after New Zealand-based owner John Thompson notified veteran Geelong trainer George Hanlon the horse would be retired immediately. Hanlon said the five-year-old Caulfield Cup winner would go to stud, but plans are yet to be announced. Diatribе is out of Gabbing Gloria (USA), a half-sister to SW Lady's Delight, Daphne Donnelly and Youthful Legs, and his third dam is Spring Adieu, a half-sister to Northern Dancer and the granddam of Danehill (USA). Diatribе retires with A\$2,321,230 in earnings and five wins from 33 appearances, including the G1 Rosehill Guineas.

SUNLINE READY FOR DEBUT

Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) arrived to a barrage of media at Tullamarine airport Tuesday morning in Melbourne to contest the first Group One race of the new Australasian season, Saturday's A\$253,000 Manikato S. over 1200m at Moonee Valley. She is scheduled to meet 11 rivals, including sprint star **Falvelon (Aus)** (Alannon {Aus}), and dual Group One-winning sprinters **Desert Sky (Aus)** (Hurricane Sky {Aus}) and **Sports (Aus)** (Zeditave {Aus}). The race is a launching pad for Sunline's bid to emulate Kingston Town (Aus) (Bletchingly {Aus}) who won the Cox Plate in 1980, 1981 and 1982--the only horse to win Australia's premier weight-for-age race three times.
