TRULY GLOBAL FESTIVAL OF RACING

The Arlington International Festival of Racing has a long history of drawing some of the best horses from Europe, but Saturday's trio of Grade I races at the Chicago track features a truly global cast. The GI Arlington Million, the GI Beverly D. and the GI Secretariat S. have participants who have competed in Europe, Canada, Brazil, South Africa, Australia, Singapore, Hong Kong and Dubai. In the Million, the German-based, globetrotting **Silvano (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) appears to be the best foreign threat. He has traveled to Hong Kong, Dubai and Singapore twice for his four starts this year. The winner of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong two back worked in 1:02 4/5 Wednesday at Arlington from a standing start. "Every thing is well with the horse," said racing manager Simon Stokes. "I think he's in the sort of form he was in when he won in Singapore." **Redattore (Brz)** (Roi Normand) seeks to become the first Brazilian bred to win the Arlington Million. He most recently won the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 28. Beverly D. participant **Kalatiara (Aus)** (Metal Storm {Fr}) came to the United States after she ran seventh of 18 against the boys in the G1 Western Australia Derby at Ascot Racecourse near Perth. In her first U.S. start, she made a strong late move to get up and win the GIII Royal Heroine S. at Hollywood July 7. Trainer Ron McAnally wasn't surprised by the win. "She'd been training so good, I kind of expected it," said the Hall of Fame trainer. **Spook Express (SAf)** (Comic Blush) will be the first South African-bred horse to ever participate in the festival. The winner of eight of nine in her native land several years ago, the seven-year-old Tom Skiffington trainee owns victories in the GIII Honey Fox H. and GIII Suwanee River H. at Gulfstream earlier this year. Three European three-year-olds will invade for the GI Secretariat S., with **Mizzen Mast** (Cozzene) sporting the best credentials. Trained in France by Criquelette Head-Maarek, the grey colt was Group 3-placed as a juvenile and won the G3 Prix de Guiche at Longchamp May 17. He most recently finished second, beaten only 1 1/2 lengths, to Chichicastenango (Fr) in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris June 26. Mizzen Mast worked six furlongs from the gate Thursday over a muddy main track in 1:13 4/5.

HOME CONTINGENT FOR MILLION TOUGH

This year's American contingent for the Arlington Million may be strong enough to shut out foreign interests for any of the top three spots. Probable favorite **Bienamado** (Bien Bien) has won six of his last seven turf starts, three of them Grade I, and deserves favoritism. He most recently won the GI Whittingham H. going this distance at Hollywood June 10. However, GI United Nations H. winner **Senure** (Nureyev) is in the best form of his career and should appreciate the drop from 11 furlongs to 10 furlongs. **White Heart (GB)** (Green Desert) owns a victory in the GI Whittingham H. last year and won the GI Woodford Reserve H. at Churchill May 5 two back. He most recently finished a close fourth in Bienamado's Whittingham.

NINE IN YORKSHIRE OAKS

Mot Juste (GB) (Mtoto {GB}) heads the nine entries which have been left in Wednesday's G1 Aston Upton Yorkshire Oaks at York. The Ed Dunlop-trained filly was a neck runner-up to stable companion Lailani (GB) last time in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 15, where **Karsavina (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) was a length back in third. Karsavina and stablemate **Snowflake (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}), who chased Lailani home in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 4, are the two from trainer Aidan O'Brien still in the race. Also included in the mile-and-a-half contest are Henry Cecil's **Sacred Song (USA)** (Diesis {GB}), winner of the G3 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock July 7, **Head in the Clouds (GB)** (Rainbow Quest {USA}), runner-up in the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville Aug. 5, and **Super Tassa (Ire)** (Lahib {USA}), who was five lengths further back in third in that contest.

DARLEY CLOSES IN

Kevin Darley yesterday closed the gap on leading jockey Kieren Fallon with an afternoon double at Newbury. Now only four behind Fallon on 105, the defending champion scored on **Swiss Lake (USA)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in the Listed St Hugh's S. and with **Shamail (Ire)** (Lycius {USA}) in the fourth race. He said at Newbury yesterday, "It's obviously there at the back of my mind, with the championship being so close again, but there's a long way to go."

HUNGERFORD BOOSTS QUALITY SATURDAY CARD

Newbury racecourse yesterday explained the move of the G3 Stan James Hungerford S. to Saturday from its original slot on Friday. The seven-furlong contest now precedes the G2 Stan James Geoffrey Freer S. on this afternoon's card. Newbury's General Manager Mark Kershaw commented, "The two day's racing were really good last year, but with quality group races we thought we'd put them on Saturday for the widest possible audience, for those racegoers here and those watching at home."

Swiss Lake looked to have a bright future when smoothly accounting for a Sandown maiden July 8, but did not show her true colours when stretched out to six furlongs in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Ascot July 28. Keen early in that event, she did not appear to stay and finished sixth. This time, Kevin Darley made no mistake, tracking Pastel for a furlong before letting his mount stride into an uncontested lead. After using her speed to burn the challengers off, the winner never looked in danger of relinquishing her advantage despite idling in front in the final 100 yards. Willie Carson, racing manager to The Thoroughbred Corporation, said, "At halfway last time at Ascot, I knew we'd made a mistake because she was fighting her jockey. First time she ran at Sandown, she did exactly the same as she did here--she kills horses with speed. She's got so much speed--obviously over time she will get six furlongs, but we're hoping maybe she'll make into a Guineas filly if she gets the trip." Trainer Gerard Butler added, "She was idling in front...that's the way she is at home. We always expected she was going to be a very nice filly. It was my fault at Ascot--I've been trying to stretch her out over a distance she wasn't suited for. My thanks to Prince Ahmed for giving me the opportunity to have a filly like this. It's a big responsibility, but I don't mind having it." Butler could aim his filly at the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Oct. 7.

Funfair Wane met the smart Class Leader on his debut back in June and was beaten by 3/4 of a length in a Newmarket maiden. Taken to York for a similar event June 16, he powered away to win by seven lengths, and was due for a run in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 11, but was cast in his box the night before and was pulled out. Here he overcame the 62-day absence to deny the well-backed Mamool in a thrilling finish. The winner was settled off the pace set by Scottish River (USA) (Thunder Gulch {USA}) as Mamool sat at the rear. With the leader's stamina waning, Funfair Wane was sent on with 300 yards remaining. Despite drifting left, he gave more when asked and had enough to hold the runner-up, who was steadily eating into his advantage in the final 50 yards. Funfair Wane, who was bred by the former England soccer manager Kevin Keegan and wife Jean, is quoted as low as 16-1 for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket by Coral Eurobet. Winning trainer Mick Channon commented, "We've always thought a fair bit of him--he's a bit of a character, but he's a good horse. I think he's quite a nice colt, but we've got a long way to go--he's got bags of speed and we'll just see how he goes on from here." According to Jean Keegan, "It's amazing--I can't explain it. It's Kevin that's the racing man and I just love horses, so I do the TLC work at home."

SILVANO (GER) (h, 5, Lomitas {GB}--Spirit Of Eagle {USA}, by Beau's Eagle {USA}), twice a Group 2 winner in his native Germany, ended 2000 with a solid fifth-place finish in the G1 Hong Kong Vase. He returned to hand fellow Million hopeful Caitano (GB) a 5 1/2-length defeat in the Mar. 3 Singapore Cup at Kranji, then shipped to the Middle East and was third in the Mar. 24 G2 Dubai Sheema Classic. Back in Hong Kong for his next start, the bay captured the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup, but could do no better than fifth when hampered by a bruised foot for the May 12 G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup and went to the sidelines. He makes his U.S. bow after a three-month vacation. Lifetime Record: 14-6-1-2, \$1,562,530.

FLUTE IS FOCUS OF FRANKEL'S WEEKEND

With Six Grade I races being run this weekend, most trainers would be happy to have one runner with a chance to win. Bobby Frankel is in the enviable position of sending out four legitimate shots. He will be in New York to saddle GI Kentucky Oaks winner **Flute** (Seattle Slew) in the GI Alabama, but he'll be keeping an eye on simulcast monitors from Arlington, where he sends out GI United Nations H. winner **Senure** (Nureyev) in the GI Arlington Million and **The Seven Seas** (El Gran Senor) in the GI Beverly D. The next day, he will send **Skimming** (Nureyev) for a repeat in the GI Pacific Classic. Because of the early post time of the race, he said that he would probably be unable to get back to California in time to see the race. He has chosen to be in New York for the GI Alabama because he has a special place in his heart for the filly. "If I win two of these races this weekend, I'll be in a good mood," he said. "If I win three, I'll be in a great mood. But the one race that I want to win is the Alabama. Mostly, because of the filly." She would have contested the GI Mother Goose June 30, but skipped the race because of a minor foot abscess. With a clean bill of health, she came back to July 27 to score an easy allowance victory over the track and appears primed for a big run here. "She doesn't let you down," said Frankel. "She doesn't show any weaknesses. Even when she got beat, she kept running." Flute will have to beat two other Oaks winners to get the job done in the Alabama. **Dancethruthedawn** (Mr. Prospector), a daughter of Champion filly and Canadian Horse of the Year Dance Smartly, has improved markedly since she was soundly beaten in the Kentucky Oaks. She rebounded to win the Woodbine Oaks June 9, then beat males in the Queen's Plate June 24. She was most recently a close second in the Prince Of Wales S. at Fort Erie July 22. **Tweedside** (Thunder Gulch) has been steadily improving for trainer Todd Pletcher. She won the GI Coaching Club American Oaks by 7 3/4 lengths last time out July 21.
