SKIMMING SEEKS SEASIDE REPEAT

With his sterling pedigree--by Nureyev out of a Lyphard mare--**Skimming** seemed destined for success on the European turf, but has instead found a special home on the American dirt; specifically, the Del Mar main track. In 2000, the Juddmonte homebred earned his first stakes win with an eight-length triumph in the GIII San Diego H., then wired the field in the GI Pacific Classic. This year, he traded decisions with **Futural** (Future Storm) in Hollywood's handicap series before defending his title in the San Diego July 29 and maintaining his unbeaten Del Mar record. Usually seen at the head of affairs, he may have company today in the form of **Dixie Dot Com** (Dixie Brass). The lightly raced six-year-old was the daylight winner of a pair of graded stakes earlier this year at Lone Star before finishing second in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H. July 7. DQ'd from first in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup, Futural couldn't get by Skimming in the San Diego, but would certainly benefit from a speed duel here. **Until Sundown** is following the same path that Tiznow took to last year's second in the Pacific Classic: a win in the GIII Affirmed H. followed by a second in the GI Swaps S. July 15. The three-year-old has been training strongly at San Luis Rey and lures Gary Stevens from **Captain Steve** (Fly So Free).

WUNDERBAR!!!

The German-based **Silvano (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) took his game to a new continent with an impressive score in the GI Arlington Million XIX yesterday and now has designs on Australia. A 10-furlong specialist, he was making just his fifth start of the year, having started things off with a 5 1/2-length victory in the Singapore Cup-G1-Sin at Kranji before finishing a good third in the G2 Dubai Sheema Classic (2400m) at Nad al Sheba. In April, he travelled to Hong Kong and won the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin, but failed to handle the Singapore heat in the G1 Singapore International Airlines Cup May 12, finishing fifth. The third choice here, Silvano secured a ground-saving position behind **Redattore (Brz)** (Roi Normand) heading into the first turn as favored **Bienamado** (Bien Bien) was carried wide while fighting his rider. The Brazilian-bred was still in front as they turned for home, but Silvano angled out in the straight and quickly opened up on his rivals. "What an unbelievable day," exclaimed winning trainer Andreas Wohler. "This is such a prestigious race to win. We were a little worried when it started to rain, but it stopped raining and the ground wasn't too bad. He likes it a bit soft, not too soft." Wohler indicated that Silvano's next two races could be the 11-furlong GI Man O'War S. at Belmont Sept. 8 followed by Australia's G1 Carlton Draught Cox Plate at Moonee Valley (2040m, 10-27); the latter is also part of the Emirates World Series. "[Breeders' Cup Turf] is too far for him and we don't want to run him on the dirt [in the Classic]," Wohler said. "This win today was even better than in Hong Kong and he beat very good horses in impressive style." Second-choice **Hap** (Theatrical {Ire}), who waited for room entering the stretch and decided to go around Redattore, finished well without threatening the winner in his first try at 10 furlongs. Bienamado failed as the favorite for the second year running. The big chestnut never looked comfortable over the ground and packed it in on the far turn, finishing seventh. "I got to the middle of the turn and I knew it wasn't his day," said jockey Chris McCarron. *Million chart, p2*

MOZART HEADS NUNTHORPE FIELD Mozart (Ire) (Danehill {USA}) heads 15 entries at the five-day stage for Thursday's £185,000 G1 Victor Chandler Nunthorpe S. at York. Jockey Michael Kinane may miss the ride on the brilliant G1 July Cup winner at Newmarket July 12 if the Irish Turf Club contests the interim injunction placed on them enforcing a two-day ban handed out at the end of July. Included on the list of possible entries for the five-furlong contest are Mozart's stable companions **Ishiguru (USA)** (Danzig {USA}), **Modigliani (USA)** (Danzig {USA}) and **Dietrich (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}). The latter was an authoritative winner of the G3 King George S. at Goodwood July 31 last time. Last year's winner **Nuclear Debate (USA)** (Geiger Counter {USA}) has been left in by trainer John Hammond, while last year's G1 Haydock Park Sprint Cup winner **Pipalong (Ire)** (Pips Pride {GB}) may also contest the event. York's Clerk of the course John Smith said yesterday, "It's absolutely spot-on at the moment. We had some rain last weekend--quite a lot of heavy rain--then it dried out and then we had a heavy shower on Wednesday. But, my ground at the moment is spot in the middle of good and we didn't have any rain last night."

GOODWOOD CELEBRATION AHEAD

Goodwood, featuring £80,000 G2 Celebration Mile, will host a racecard offering over £175,000 in prizemoney this coming Saturday. Won last year by the Sir Michael Stoute-trained **Medicean (GB)**, entries for this year's contest are headed by Stoute's **No Excuse Needed (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}), runner-up in the G1 Sussex S. at this venue Aug. 1. Also featured is the £25,000 Listed San Miguel March S., a recognised trial for the G1 Rothmans Royals St Leger S. at Doncaster Sept. 15. Next Sunday's highlight is the £40,000 G3 Touchdown In Malaysia Prestige S. for two-year-old fillies over seven furlongs with the entire card offering over £110,000 in prizemoney. Clerk of the Course Rod Fabricius commented, "The weekend of August 25 and 26 at Goodwood combines first-class horseracing and entertainment. Racegoers may get to see this year's top miler, top St Leger contenders and a fillies classic candidate for next season over the weekend."

LIMERICK GIVEN GO-AHEAD

Ireland's Turf Club Inspector of Courses gave the go-ahead yesterday to the new Greenmount Park racecourse in Limerick to open Oct. 14. The new course represents the first opening of a racetrack in Ireland in the last 50 years. The last course to open was Wexford in 1951. Costs of over £10 million and problems regarding grass growth have delayed the opening which is a year behind schedule. Greenmount is four miles from the old Greenpark track in Limerick city, that closed in March 1999. It boasts an extensive four storey, glass fronted stand. Meanwhile, Leopardstown has announced that planning for a new all-weather racetrack will begin during the redevelopment caused by the extension of the nearby motorway.

HA HA LAUGHS OFF COMPETITION

Ha Ha (Aus) (Danehill {USA}) made history yesterday at Warwick Farm by becoming the first filly to complete the Golden Slipper-Silver Shadow S. double after she blitzed 11 rivals. The Gai Waterhouse-trained filly settled in third place while traveling three wide before scooting home effortlessly to beat **Hosannah (Aus)** (Octagonal {NZ}) by 2 1/4 lengths with **Oomph (Aus)** (Flying Spur {Aus}) 1 1/2 lengths back third. "She is a real racehorse," said jockey Jim Cassidy of the filly. "She was very relaxed, I had to dig at her once or twice." Waterhouse revealed Ha Ha had suffered a minor setback by knocking herself and catching a cold. "She has a stack of improvement, of all the horses in my stable she is the one with the most scope for improvement," Waterhouse said. Ha Ha's main goal is the Group 1 A\$350,000 Flight S. at Randwick on Sept. 29, but part-owner Rob Ferguson is less than enthusiastic about racing on Randwick's controversial inner track. "Ha Ha will contest the Princess series and the next leg is the Furious S. at Randwick on Sept. 1," he said. "But how she goes there is anybody's guess because the track is a joke." The A\$100,000 Furious S. is the second leg of the series with the G2 Tea Rose S. the penultimate leg before the Flight S.

NEWQUAY'S COMING OUT PARTY

Trainer Gai Waterhouse issued a midweek warning to racegoers not to overlook **Newquay (Aus)** (Last Tycoon {Ire}) as stablemate **Excellerator (Aus)** (Marscay {Aus}) hogged the spotlight--and she was proven right when the A\$100,000 Inglis Easter graduate took the G2 Up And Coming S. at Sydney's Warwick Farm. Newquay led for most of the way and held off the late charge of **Perfect Crime (Aus)** (Marauding {NZ}) with stablemate Excellerator further back in third. "A firm track made all the difference; he always had the ability and the thing on his inside made him work and that took the gas out

of him," said jockey Brian York. Waterhouse said Newquay, runner-up to subsequent dual G1 winner Viscount (Aus) (Quest For Fame {GB}) in the L. Breeders' Plate early in his juvenile campaign, had been under-estimated. "I always go back to the Breeders' Plate as a guide and this horse was the best thing beaten in that race," she said. "He'll be kept to sprint races, but Excellerator raced to me like a mile horse and he could go to the Ascot Vale [in Melbourne] or stay in Sydney for the Ming Dynasty," she said. Viscount, winner of the G1 Champagne S. in his last appearance in April, was fifth.

Flute staked her claim as the nation's best three-year-old filly with a dominating performance in the prestigious Alabama S. yesterday. Heroine of the GI Kentucky Oaks in May, she missed the GI Mother Goose with a foot abscess, but got her Alabama prep with a nine-furlong, second-level allowance win over this surface July 27. Although the Juddmonte homebred had never previously gone straight to the front in any of her five starts, she was away alertly under new pilot Edgar Prado and held a slight lead over Queen's Plate victress Dancethruthedawn (Mr. Prospector) after a quarter in :23 3/5. The Canadian filly backed off down the backstretch, and Flute ran her rivals into the ground with steady strides, drawing away impressively in the stretch while equalling the fifth-fastest Alabama in history behind Go for Wand's record of 2:00 4/5. "It didn't seem like anyone wanted the lead, that's why we went to the front," Prado said. "She felt comfortable the whole time; I just took a long, nice hold of her. She took off on the second turn and she did it so easily. When they took a run at her, she spurted clear." Flute's number one fan, trainer Bobby Frankel, said that the bay filly would stay in New York and point for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff Oct. 27. "I was really nervous the whole day," he said. "I didn't want to be wrong. I'm in love with this filly."

Bred in France with a name evoking the country across the Channel, England's Legend earned the biggest win of her brief career in America with an overpowering effort at Arlington yesterday. After taking her first two starts in France for trainer Andre Fabre, including the Listed Prix Bagatelle, the homebred bay failed to make an impact in Group company and was sent to the U.S. following a seventh to Lady of Chad in the G2 Prix d'Astarte last July at Deauville. Fourth in her American bow at Gulfstream, she was sent to California and was an impressive winner of a Santa Anita allowance Mar. 14, covering nine furlongs in 1:46 4/5. She reappeared at Belmont three months later and got her first graded victory in the GII New York H. July 14. With the presence of West Coast star Astra (Theatrical), England's Legend was a generous 9-2 second choice. She tugged her way to the front under Corey Nakatani and led by five through a :49 1/5 half over the yielding ground. The field got a bit closer approaching the stretch, but Nakatani let out a notch and England's Legend quickly opened up for a daylight victory. "She's a very special filly," Nakatani said. "I was trying to get them to bring her out to California and run against Astra earlier. You can throw anything at her and she can handle it. She's a filly with a lot of style." The 3-5 chalk, Astra struggled over the surface and finished last of nine.

"I needed every inch of the stretch to get up," said Solis. "I just wanted to be patient early. I was sitting back with Stevens' horse [Aldwych] and the Canadian horse [Strut the Stage], and thought I'd need to go around the field. But I saw an opportunity to save a little ground and I decided to go for it." Strut the Stage had taken charge with a five-wide move on the home turn and looked like a sure winner at the eighth pole, but was unlucky to lose the decision.

Sunline, recently crowned New Zealand champion racehorse for the third consecutive year, suffered her third-straight loss yesterday when 20-1 outsider Piavonic charged down the outside to score by two lengths in the Manikato S. Australasia's turf darling, with nine Group 1 wins and more than A\$8 million prize money, was considered invincible by the most astute pundits, but Piavonic, whose previous best was a long neck win in the G2 Carlyon S. (over the same trip and track four starts back) brushed past her effortlessly. Although Sunline was previously unbeaten while making her seasonal debut, in the past she's tended to contest lesser events first up in her home country compared with today's classy field. Sunline's rider, Greg Childs, warned the reigning Australian Horse of the Year was getting older and would possibly take a little longer to reach her peak. Despite Piavonic's creditable record at the trip and at Moonee Valley, she hardly entered into pre-race discussions. "Sunline and Moonee Valley go together like peaches and cream," declared bookmaker Col Tidy, while Rob Waterhouse said "she will win, why wouldn't she?" Sunline's next outing is likely to be the G2 Memsie S. at Caulfield on September 1. Piavonic's Melbourne trainer Tony Noonan celebrated his first Group 1 win.

He was a creditable fourth behind Galileo (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby June 9 before finishing a fair sixth to that colt in the Irish version at The Curragh July 1. Here, jockey Michael Hills was determined not to give his colt too much to do in front as he had at The Curragh and his patient tactics paid off. He was restrained early as the free-running Dalampour (Shernazar {Ire}) was allowed to stride into a lead of over 10 lengths. Millenary was the first to seize the advantage in the straight when grabbing the lead from the tiring front-runner at the quarter-mile marker. Mr Combustible was always travelling well and arrived as a real threat soon after. Passing the game favourite at the distance, he was pushed out all the way to the line for a convincing success. Trainer Barry Hills said, "The plan is the St Leger, as it has been for a long time. He stays really well. He was a bit fresh today--he will be spot-on for Doncaster."

He has done virtually nothing since his last run at Goodwood, just cantered and watched the others gallop. I didn't think he should be a 33-1 chance, when you have a horse who is in such good form you never really know what he is going to be able to do."

Deauville's showpiece looks an intriguing contest this year, with the best milers from France, Britain and Germany locking horns. Godolphin, successful in the last two runnings with Muhtathir and Dubai Millennium, again hold the aces with **Noverre**. Last time, he looked better than ever when winning the G1 Sussex S. by two lengths at Goodwood Aug. 1. He also defeated Black Minnaloushe that day, thereby avenging his neck defeat to that colt in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot. Now, his connections have another score to settle as their colt was disqualified from first place in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains in May. Having beaten **Vahorimix** by a head, he was stripped of the Classic after failing post-race drug testing. Vahorimix ran fourth behind Noverre at Royal Ascot and must improve here to reverse placings. His greatest threat may come from **Banks Hill**. She stamped herself a filly of the highest order when beating the solid yardstick Crystal Music by 1 1/2 lengths in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot last time, with **Lethals Lady** back in fourth. Previously, she was a head second in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches in May. Fascinatingly, **Chichicastenango** steps back to a mile here, having plied his trade over longer distances earlier this summer. Successful over 10 furlongs in the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp May 13, he was beaten a half length by Anabaa Blue in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly June 3. Last time, he left Mizzen Mast and **Bonnard** behind when winning the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp June 26, but he has it all to do back in trip against crack milers. Trainer Andreas Schutz sends the respectable **Royal Dragon** from Germany, winner of the G2 Mehl-Muhlens-Rennen and G2 Berlin Brandenburg Trophy at Hoppegarten July 8.

NUMBERS UP AT DEAUVILLE SALE Attracted by the quality of a truly international catalogue, buyers from all over the world were very active at the first day of this year's edition of the Deauville August Yearling Sale. The first yearlings of Arc hero Peintre Celebre were well received, with a colt out of Gracie Lady (Ire) (Generous {Ire}) topping the first session for FF5,000,000 for the account of Wafic Said. The bay colt, out of a half sister to French classic winner No Pass No Sale, will likely be trained by Pascal Bary. The highest-priced filly was a daughter of Sadler's Wells--Encens (GB) (Common Grounds {GB}) purchased by Horse France for FF3,700,000. A three-quarters sister to G1SW Scenic (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), she is from the family of Rainbow Quest and Slightly Dangerous. As during the last few years the gross was up by 15 percent at FF69,880,000, with the average also rising by 13 percent at FF1,370,196. Horses sold to a wide range of buyers, from bloodstock agents usually active in Deauville to Arab interests such as Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum and Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum, as well as Japanese, French and Irish buyers. Many new buyers were active on the day, like Vinery, who purchased a FF1,000,000 daughter of King of Kings (Ire)--Vilikaia (Nureyev). Philippe Augier, general manager of the Agence Française said, "With a lot of new buyers, the sale has got off to a great start. The number of horses sold for 1 million francs or more rose from 19 to 26 which demonstrates the depth of the market. We are delighted that the Deauville Sale continues to grow and to attract new clients." The sale continues today at 5:30 p.m. *Top Lots, p10*
