LUCKY LUCKY LUCKY

He may be the luckiest horse in Europe. **Vahorimix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), who was awarded the victory in the May 13 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains after the original winner, **Noverre (Rahy)**, was disqualified for a drug positive, was handed his second Group 1 score yesterday despite crossing the finish line second once again. The 3-1 third choice in the G1 Prix du Haras de Fresnay-Le-Buffard-Jacques Le Marois at Deauville, Vahorimix was a half-length behind **Proudswings (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) at the wire, but the German mare had swerved in front of both second choice **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill) and favored Noverre 50 yards from home and ultimately was disqualified and placed last, leaving Vahorimix in the winner's enclosure. "Certainly it is not the best way to win a race, but the horse is not responsible for what happens," Roland de Longueville, racing manager for winning owner Jean-Luc Lagardere, said. "He is certainly a lucky horse, but he is also a very good horse. He has run his race again, showing one more time that there is very little between him and Noverre." Beaten only a neck in the French Classic, Vahorimix was coming off a fourth-place finish in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 19. The three-year-old was settled at the back of the field early as **Royal Dragon (Danehill)**, tracked by Proudswings, set the pace. Proudswings took over a furlong and a half out, but there were seven horses, all strung across the course, still in with a chance. Jockey Olivier Peslier maneuvered Vahorimix to the wide outside and the two avoided the trouble, but Proudswings impeded a rallying Noverre, who in turn bothered Banks Hill. Banks Hill recovered to beat Noverre by a short head, with **Chichicastenango (Fr)** (Smadoun {Fr}) just behind them. Simon Crisford, racing manager for Godolphin, did not blame the interference for Noverre's defeat. "There was not enough pace for him, and the ground proved too soft for his liking," Crisford said. Jockey Christophe Soumillon, who was aboard Vahorimix in the French 2000 Guineas, but had the mount on Proudswings here, also received a four-day ban for the disqualification.

SKIMMING REMAINS PERFECT AT DEL MAR

Skimming (Nureyev) went into the gate for yesterday's \$1 million GI Pacific Classic with a record of three wins from three starts at Del Mar and earnings of \$900,000 at the seaside track. Less than two minutes later, he was four for four and had \$1.5 million in earnings, becoming the second Juddmonte Farms owned horse, along with **Tinners Way**, to take back to back runnings of the Pacific Classic. The second betting choice's tactics were no surprise, as he broke sharply and went straight to the front. Pace pressure expected from **Dixie Dot Com (Dixie Brass)** never materialized, but Skimming cut out fractions of :22 4/5 and :45 4/5 while under mild pressure from longshot **Dig For It (Digamist)**. Dig For it remained a length off of the winner through a split of 1:10 flat, but Skimming began to get away from the field on the far turn. He opened up three lengths entering the stretch and drew off to win comfortably by 5 1/2 lengths. The late challenge expected from slight post-time favorite **Futural (Future Storm)** never materialized as that one had nothing left on the far turn and finished last, beaten almost 20 lengths. "It felt like instant replay," said winning jockey Garret Gomez. "He felt so good. We had some pressure going around that first turn and he muscled up a bit, but once we went around the turn he let go of the bridle and relaxed." Trainer Bobby Frankel, who watched the race on television from New York, won the Classic for the sixth time minutes after sending out **Aptitude** to win the GI Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. "As soon as they went around the first turn, I felt real comfortable," said Frankel, who has a trio of top handicap horses in Lido Palace (Chi), **Aptitude** and **Skimming**. Because he is so loaded with older stars, Frankel plans to give Skimming some time off. "I don't think I'll bring Skimming for the Breeders' Cup. He doesn't like these sandy racetracks in the east," said Frankel. Skimming finished well back in the GI Woodward and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup last year at Belmont Park, site of this year's Breeders' Cup. "I'll probably lay him up and get him ready for next year," added the trainer. **Chart p. 2**

DETTORI'S SAKHEE WARNING

Medicean (GB) (Machiavellian {USA}) heads a field of nine declared yesterday for Tuesday's £450,000 G1 Juddmonte International S. at York. Sir Michael Stoute's four-year-old remains unbeaten this term after successes in the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. at Newbury May 19, G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 19 and G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 7. In the latter he had James Fanshawe's **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge {USA}) and Aidan O'Brien's **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}) and **Black Minnaloushe (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) less than a length back in second, third and fifth, respectively. Fanshawe's colt and the O'Brien pair may renew rivalry in Tuesday's 10-furlong contest, but one horse who is yet to meet Medicean is **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}). The four-year-old was a length runner-up to Sinndar (Ire) in last year's G1 Epsom Derby before finishing fourth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown last July. He was then off the track until returning to take the Listed Steventon S. at Newbury July 21. Jockey Frankie Dettori expects the Godolphin challenger to put it up to the likely favourite, telling the *Mail* yesterday, "Sakhee was second to Sinndar in last year's Derby, but people had half forgotten about him this season because he was out of action. He then gave me all the right signals when he won at Newbury. We know we can get more out of the horse and he is coming good now."

Monnavanna is more accustomed to racing at Deauville, but she was directed at Pontefract for her second stakes success. Seventh in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 22, she was then the emphatic five-length winner in the Listed Prix Amandine at Deauville July 13. That form places her amongst the best fillies in Europe over seven furlongs to a mile. Although she was eighth last time in the G2 Prix d'Astarte at that track Aug. 5, she finished less than three lengths behind the winner Ascension (Ire) in a muddling race. Here she was taken to the front early by Darryl Holland, where she travelled well to take the field along. Challenged and headed by Perfect Peach at the distance, she battled back well to lead on the line.

The footing is better for Aptitude." Aptitude was unhurried at the break and raced sixth early behind the honest pace set by Gander. He got closer to the front of the pack heading into the far turn and made a sweeping move four wide for the lead. Taking over on the turn, he drew off in the stretch to win in dominating fashion. "He really accelerated turning for home and opened up pretty easily," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "I didn't want to take any chances. I kept pretty busy on him."

Generic kept his supporters waiting until the last second to take this race and establish himself near the top of the stayer's division in Europe. He always seems to save his best for the final straight, as he showed when winning the G2 Prix Maurice de Nieuil at Maisons-Laffitte from Romantic Affair (Ire) with a late thrust July 14. He had done the same to another of John Dunlop's charges, Pairumani Star (Ire), in the Listed Prix la Moskowa at Chantilly June 27. He again denied Dunlop in the final strides here as the game Samsaam almost made all under an enterprising ride from Richard Hills. But Generis, held up seven lengths off the pace while fourth early, was always travelling well. As Hills kicked off the final turn into a clear lead, Generic plunged forward to eat into his lead and, showing fine acceleration to reach the leader's flanks with 100 yards remaining, he gave a final burst to drive past the game runner-up in the shade of the post. Winning trainer Jean-Paul Gallorini said, "He had spent two years in the paddocks because of leg problems. When that happens, they also rest their heart and their head." He added, "Mr. Dunlop is a great trainer and if I beat him three times, maybe it shows that I am not a bad trainer either."

Noroit was beaten a total of 8 3/4 lengths by Tareno in the Listed Moet & Chandon Cup at Hamburg July 1, but bounced back here to comprehensively reverse form with that rival. Held up in sixth early by Christian Czachary, he was keen as the pace was slowed by front-running Street Poker. Brought steadily up the rail, the winner took control at the top of the straight. Ridden from three-sixteenths of a mile out, the colt sailed clear for an authoritative success at humongous odds.

UPTREND CONTINUES AT DEAUVILLE For the second day running, it was good business at the Deauville August Yearling Sale. Following yesterday's session, the gross was up a total of 17 percent at FF147,470,000, while the average rose 18 percent to FF1,460,099. It didn't take long for the action to start as agent Peter Doyle secured hip 80, a Baratheia (Ire) colt from the family of champion Nashwan, for FF4.2 million from the Haras des Capucines consignment. Ten minutes later, Demi O'Byrne had to go to FF6.5 million, the top price on the day, to buy Hip 82, a Sadler's Wells colt out of a sister to top sire Linamix (Fr), also sold by Haras des Capucines. And just 15 minutes after that, Sheikh Maktoum Al Maktoum's Gainsborough Stud Management picked up the co-second-highest priced yearling of the day, paying FF5 million for Hip 86, an Octagonal (NZ) half sister to G1 Atto Mile winner Riviera (Fr) from the family of Grade I winners Maximova (Fr), Septieme Ciel, Macoumba and Nonoalco, consigned by Haras d'Etreham. His brother, Hamdan, paid the same price for hip 113, a Zafonic colt out of the stakes-winning Sadler's Wells mare Reine Wells (Ire), consigned by the Haras du Mezeray. Kilboy Estates also had to pay FF5 million for hip 118, a filly by hot sire Danehill who is the first foal of G1 Epsom Oaks winner Shatoush (Ire), from the consignment of Haras d'Etreham. The day ended on a high note with the last lot, hip 138, a Danehill colt going to O'Byrne for FF4.9 million. From the consignment of Knocktoran Stud, the yearling is out of Grade III winner Truly A Dream and so from the family of Grade I winner Arctique Royale. Philippe Augier, general manager of the Agence Française said, "We are delighted that the progression of yesterday's session was confirmed today. Over the two days it was a very strong, deep market, which allowed the sale to progress significantly." **Top lots p. 7**

However, her running style was compromised by the slow pace of that race and she will find a more favorable scenario today.
