SECOND TO NUN

Nothing can stop Mozart (Ire) (Danehill). Not the fastest sprinters in Europe and not even, it seems, a moving saddle. For that was the drama that unfolded at the start of yesterday's G1 Nunthorpe S. at York as the 4-9 choice gave the freewheeling Repertory (GB) (Anshan {GB}) a three-length start. "I just jumped very awkwardly and even the saddle moved on the jump and he found himself in third, but he doesn't have to lead," said winning rider Mick Kinane. After two furlongs of anxious glances down, Kinane was happy that his tack would not fly off into the orbit of the Knavesmire and asked his colt to race. The Ballydoyle sprinting supremo rallied from third to overtake Repertory at halfway and spat him out along with the rest of the field that were in the end led home in second place by last year's impressive winner Nuclear Debate (Germany Counter) two lengths adrift. Although it appeared that Mozart was not travelling with total ease, as soon as he reached the leader the contest was his. Pushed out and subjected to no more than three flicks with the whip in the final stages, he was entirely in command at the business end. "His last two bits of work had been on very soft ground and I just said to Michael [Kinane] he may be a bit lazy and sleepy," explained winning conditioner Aidan O'Brien. "Michael said he had to ride him and keep the saddle up at the one time, so it was great." This marks 12 Group 1 victories for O'Brien so far in 2001, while the horse was gaining his second success at the highest level after a demonstrative display of sprinting finesse in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 12. That performance warranted comparisons with some of the greatest of the division in recent years, including the stable's Stravinsky, who completed the same double in 1999. O'Brien is looking to the G1 Breeders' Cup Sprint, for which he is rated a 10-1 chance by Coral Eurobet, now. "I would imagine if he is going to run again it will be in the Breeders' Cup," O'Brien said. "And if he is going to America I would like to give him some work on an artificial surface first." Both Nuclear Debate and Bishops Court (GB) (Clantime {GB}) will head for the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp Oct. 7. Chart p. 2

THEATRICAL MOVES TO HILL 'N' DALE

Top sire Theatrical (Ire) (Nureyev--Tree Of Knowledge {Ire}), by Sassafras {Fr}) will be relocated to John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm, it was announced yesterday. The 19-year-old syndicated sire of 58 stakes winners and the earners of over \$50 million is coming off a successful weekend in Chicago where he sired of GI Secretariat S. winner Startac and GI Arlington Million runner-up Hap. He previously stood as part of the Brookside Stallion division of Diamond Farms. "We are extremely excited to stand a stallion of this caliber," said John Sikura. "Our objective is to reach out to the leading international breeders and assure that Theatrical receives the best book in the world. We feel that the Paulson Living Trust's continued support, coupled with our client base and a greater accessibility to the stallion, will distinguish him as one of the elite proven sires in the world." Hill 'n' Dale also announced that a few shares in the stallion will be offered to a select group of the world's leading breeders. In addition to Theatrical, the Allen Paulson Living Trust moved 17-year-old stallion Jade Hunter (Mr. Prospector--Jadana {Ire}), by Pharly {Fr}) and 18 of the Trust's mares to Hill 'n' Dale.

THIRTEEN REMAIN IN PRK MORNY Johannesburg (USA)

(Hennessy {USA}) yesterday headed the 13 entries which stood their ground for Sunday's G1 Prix Morny-Casinos Barrère at Deauville. Johannesburg, so impressive when winning the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21, G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14 and G1 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 12, heads the ante-post betting for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, being quoted as low as 6-1 by most bookmakers. The unbeaten colt may be accompanied by stablemates **Wiseman's Ferry (USA)** (Hennessy {USA}) and **Line Rider (USA)** (Danzig {USA}) as he was last time at Leopardstown. He will face Andre Fabre's unbeaten colt **War Zone (USA)** (Danzig {USA}), highly impressive on his two starts so far, including a conditions event at the track Aug. 15. Also among the entries yesterday was the David Loder-trained **Meshaheer (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}), successful in the G3 July S. at Newmarket July 11 and **Silent Honor (Ire)** (Sunday Silence {USA}), who is doubtful after finishing third in yesterday's G2 Lowther S. at York. The field also includes Robert Collet's **Ziping (Ire)** (Zafonic {USA}), winner of the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte July 29, Ian Balding's **Firebreak (GB)** (Chamwood Forest {Ire}), winner of the G3 Prix de Cabourg at this track Aug. 4, and Rod Millan's **Whitbarrow (Ire)** (Royal Abjar {USA}), successful last time in the G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood Aug. 2. The ground at Deauville is currently good.

Here everything fell right for the filly who benefits greatly from being held up. Reserved in last place early by Franny Norton as Isadora (GB) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) set a strong pace, she made smooth progress in the straight towards the inner, but soon ran out of room past the quarter-mile pole. She was switched before the distance to challenge Panna and Darryl Holland who looked to have it won there with a decisive swoop. Quickening once free, Inchiri got in front where it counted, denying the game runner-up in the final strides.

SONGANDAPRAYER TO MARABLU Doug Henderson's Marablu Farm has purchased an interest in GI Fountain of Youth S. winner **Songandaprayer** (Unbridled's Song--Alizea, by Premier'ship) and will stand him at its Reddick, Florida facility after the colt is retired later this year. Purchased as a FISAUG yearling for \$470,000 and pinhooked for \$1 million as an FIFEB two-year-old, Songandaprayer won both his starts at two including a maiden victory at Monmouth and the Huntington S. at Aqueduct for owners Devil Eleven Stable and DJ Stable. Following an out-of-the-money finish in the GIII Holy Bull S. in his three-year-old debut, he won the Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Park by 2 1/2 lengths, then faltered to fifth in the GI Florida Derby. He rebounded to run second in the GI Bluegrass before finishing 13th in the Kentucky Derby after setting a record half-mile pace. He was most recently third in the GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S. at Monmouth Park. A winner of three races from eight starts and \$380,480 in earnings, the half-brother to MSW's Island Emperor and Lifeisawhirl is currently in training at Belmont Park with Juan Serey while former trainer John Dowd serves out a 120-day suspension.

END SWEEP COLT TOPS OBS SALE Thursday's penultimate session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's August Open Yearling Sale was topped by Hip 930, an End Sweep colt who brought a bid of \$95,000 from Marion G. Montanari. Out of Susie Smile (Smile), a half-sister to MSW Lady Summerhill, the bay colt was consigned by Cloverleaf Farms. Overall, the session's numbers were a shade above those posted in 2000, as 175 yearlings grossed \$1,562,800 for an average price of \$8,930. The sale concludes today, with bidding starting at 11 a.m.

SAME PATTERN; BUT IS SHE THE SAME HORSE?

John Oxley's Beautiful Pleasure (Maudlin) enters today's GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga off of a familiar pattern: she has rebounded from defeat in the last two runnings of the GI Go for Wand H. to win the last two runnings of the Personal Ensign. However, questions abound about whether she is the same horse she was during her championship season of 1999 or last year. In her only two starts of the year, she set the pace and faded to finish seventh in the GI Hempstead H. at Belmont June 23 and fifth in the July 29 Go for Wand. "Mentally and physically, she's all set for Friday," assured trainer John Ward, Jr. "She's done well since the Go for Wand. I absolutely loved her breeze last Friday." Ward was referring to a five-furlong move that Beautiful Pleasure put in last Friday, going 1:02 over the training track. Beautiful Pleasure looked like her old self for the first six furlongs of the Go For Wand H., where she opened up 12 lengths on the field. Ward thinks that she'll be able to carry her speed farther today. "We wanted her to go out there and run her race [in the Go for Wand]," said the trainer. "She held on pretty well until the last part of it. She's been in charge over the last few weeks. She's fit and sound...I think she'll be up to it." Serra Lake (Seattle Slew), the winner of the Go for Wand, is looking for her fourth win in five starts this year. "She's really gotten good," said trainer Shug McGuaghey. "She ran a big race last time, but it's going to be tougher this time around." GI Hempstead H. winner Critical Eye (Dynaformer) ran a disappointing sixth last time in the Go For Wand. Her connections still haven't been able to explain the poor performance. "I guess they're not machines," said owner and breeder Herbert Schwartz. "She had been doing really well before that race. Its still a mystery. I think it says a lot that Jerry [Bailey] wants to ride her back."

BRAY LOSES PAULSON HORSES Horses owned by The Allen E. Paulson Living Trust, including GISW Astra and Startac, have been removed from trainer Simon Bray's barn and will be transferred to the barn Laura de Seroux and other trainers, Narvick International Inc. announced Wednesday. No specific grounds were given for the switch, but Michael Paulson said in a statement that the change was necessary for the best interest of his father's Trust and of their horse operation. "I got a call to meet Mike Paulson and Emmanuelle de Seroux at 1 p.m. at the barn," Bray told Thoroughbred Times. "I was then told they were removing all their horses. No reason was given." Startac, off since the Kentucky Derby, rallied to win the GI Secretariat on Saturday at Arlington. "I'm in a state of total shock," Bray continued. "I was assured by Mike that it had nothing to do with my performance or the results of the last couple of years. It's tough when you win the biggest race of your career with one of those horses four days earlier." Bray will continue to train for a partnership headed by Allen Paulson's widow Madeleine. "I've got to thank Mr. Paulson for giving me the opportunity he did and for jump-starting my career," added Bray. "But the reasons for this action are still not clear."

Like Bint Allayl (GB) before her in 1998, Queen's Logic followed up success in the G3 Queen Mary S. with victory here for Mick Channon. In doing so she confirmed Ascot form, handing a beating to G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner Silent Honor in the process. Queen's Logic had always been considered a filly of real potential by her trainer, who started her off over five furlongs in a Newbury conditions event May 18 on soft ground. Dettori went for gold at the quarter-mile marker but was instantly under pressure to shrug off the attentions of the penalty-free Sophisticat, who grabbed the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Steven Drowne was getting to work on Queen's Logic who was responding all the time to deliver a strong run on the outside, taking her to the front with 75 yards to race before lengthening away for the prize. Queen's Logic, who was quoted as low as 8-1 as favourite for next year's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, heads next to the G1 Cheveley Park S. at that course Oct.2 on her final outing of
