MIDSUMMER DREAMS

Winner of two Classics, **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) will meet foes both old and new in the \$1,000,000 GI Travers S. this afternoon at Saratoga. He defeated **Scorpion** (Seattle Slew) in the GI Santa Anita Derby before trouncing both **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy) and **Dollar Bill** (Peaks and Valleys) in his Preakness and Belmont victories. Given some time off after the Belmont, the big chestnut showed grit in winning the GI Haskell H. at Monmouth Aug. 5 despite chronic hoof problems. He will wear a bar shoe behind again for the Travers. "The Haskell is perhaps his best race," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He showed a lot of heart and determination. He has also never been that tired [after a race] in his life." On Monday, Point Given breezed five panels in :59 1/5 before leaving his Del Mar summer base and shipped into Saratoga the next day. Even-money on the morning line, he will meet several new rivals here, including Godolphin's speedy **E Dubai** (Mr. Prospector), who has been pointing for the Travers since winning the GII Dwyer S. July 8 over a sloppy Belmont strip. The front-running bay set a hot pace--six furlongs in 1:07 4/5--before drawing off that day, and will likely be on the lead in his first try at 10 furlongs. "He's very athletic and takes the turns well," said jockey Jerry Bailey. "I don't think the extra furlong will pose a problem as long as we don't go three-quarters in 1:07 1/5." Hoping that Saratoga once again proves to be the Graveyard of Favorites is the dark horse **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance), who vaulted into the Travers picture with a 13 1/2-length allowance victory July 30 which earned him a 110 Beyer Speed Figure. His only previous career victory was in the GIII Pilgrim S. on the turf at Belmont last fall. Jockey Richard Migliore, who was aboard **Free of Love** (Meadow Flight) in that colt's second in the GI Jim Dandy S. Aug. 4, opted for Volponi. "I've always scrapped to get decent mounts in races like this," said Migliore. "This year, I had to choose between two. What it came down to was right after Volponi's race, I felt strongly about him. The feeling he gave me, I couldn't shake it. When the other colt ran so well in the Jim Dandy, I was impressed with his effort, but it didn't exceed the feeling Volponi gave me. I was kind of hoping those two would get separated." *Travers field, p2*

POMPEII'S BIG DAY

Making her final start for breeder Robert Clay and trainer John Kimmel, **Pompeii** (Broad Brush) took advantage of the gaping hole on the rail left by **Beautiful Pleasure** (Maudlin) and outslugged that two-time defending champion to earn her first Grade I victory in the Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga yesterday. Pompeii raced yesterday for the partnership of Clay and WinStar Farm, but the latter purchased the remaining interest in the filly earlier this week and will now send her to the barn of Elliott Walden. "It's hard to see her leave, but business is business in this game," said Kimmel. "I hope she continues her success with her new owners." The dark bay progressed through her conditions last fall and won the GIII Rare Treat H. at Aqueduct in February. She prepped for this outing in the GI Go for Wand H. July 29 at Saratoga, where she held the lead in midstretch before **Serra Lake** (Seattle Slew) ran her down in the final strides. As Beautiful Pleasure showed the way through dawdling fractions of :49 and 1:13 2/5, Pompeii raced in third on the outside, but switched to the inside as the big favorite began to drift badly turning for home. Pompeii crossed a wire a length to the good of Beautiful Pleasure, who was within spitting distance of the Chipwich stand near outside rail.

His best effort was a second-place finish to Invincible Spirit (Ire) in the Listed Hackwood S. at Newbury July 21. Here, Mugharreb stayed back early as Eastern Purple led and found a gap between the fading pacesetters with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, went to the lead soon after and drew away late. Angus Gold, Racing Manager to owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum, said: "We decided today to drop him out and luckily they went a good pace up front which helps."
