POINT GIVEN LEAVES NO DOUBT IN TRAVERS

When **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) struggled to win the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth Aug. 5, there was plenty of doubt as to whether the big colt would make another trip across the country to contest today's GI Travers S. at Saratoga. In a word, the skeptics were wrong. Point Given delivered a strong message in front of a record Spa crowd of 60,486 with a sharp 3 1/2-length victory over second choice **E Dubai** (Mr. Prospector) in the Midsummer Derby and placed himself at the forefront of the battle for Horse of the Year. "I've always read and heard about the Travers," said winning trainer Bob Baffert, who nailed the big prize with his first Travers starter. "It's such a great race. Especially to come off the Triple Crown road, it shows you how tough and durable this horse is. He just keeps amazing me. I've never seen anything like him." Lured to the Jersey shore with a \$500,000 addition to the \$1 million purse, the Preakness and Belmont winner's training for that race had been interrupted by a foot abscess. Running in a bar shoe at what Bob Baffert then estimated to be 80-percent fitness, the big chestnut showed determination to get up late for the win. A battle of words between trainer Bob Baffert and jockey Gary Stevens overshadowed the gutsy victory, but after a couple of days all was right between trainer and jockey. More importantly, all was right with Point Given. He was sent back to Del Mar to avoid the oppressive heat and humidity at Saratoga and turned in two sharp workouts, including five furlongs in :59 1/5 Aug. 20. Still wearing the bar shoe, Point Given broke a half-step slow and race wide in fifth around the far turn as **Free of Love** (Meadow Flight) and E Dubai cut out the running. Steadily advancing toward the leaders on the outside, he was on E Dubai's flank coming out of the turn. Stevens set him down for the drive at the top of the stretch and he passed the leader with ease and drew off to an effortless victory, receiving no challenge from the late runners. "I didn't want to go to the front entering the stretch, because I know my horse has a tendency to fool around a little bit when he gets in front," said Stevens. "Once I made the lead, he was a little late in switching leads. I kind of had to throw him over to the right lead, and once he did the acceleration was there and he opened up a nice lead." *Travers cont. page 2*

JOHANNESBURG TOP CHOICE IN MORN

While Galileo (Ire) and Mozart (Ire) have established themselves the clear leaders of their divisions, another Ballydoyle colt will try to stamp his authority on the juvenile ranks with a win in today's G1 Prix MornyCasinos Barriere at Deauville. The latest Ballydoyle star is **Johannesburg** (Hennessy), who has grown in stature with each success this year. From a lowly Fairyhouse maiden May 30 to the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21, on to the G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14 through to the G1 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 12, he has taken on an aura of invincibility. Such was the hysteria that surrounded his last performance that bookmakers were not keen to lay him for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, cutting him to 6-1 as the clear favourite. Trainer Aidan O'Brien said after the colt's last start, "There is no doubt that this is a brilliant two-year-old. He has two extra gears and acceleration that is electric. He's a very serious horse and has never been extended." This is likely to prove by far his toughest test, with opponents of real merit lining up alongside. David Loder's **Meshaheer** (Nureyev), a half-brother to O'Brien's Group 1 winner King Charlemagne, was impressive winning the G3 July S. at Newmarket July 11 last time. He was denied a true run in the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 19, yet still finished within two necks of Landseer (GB) and **Firebreak (GB)** (Charnwood Forest {Ire}). The latter then took the G3 Prix de Cabourg here Aug. 4.

IMAGINE STRAIGHT TO ARC? Dual classic heroine **Imagine (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) may head straight to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7, it was revealed yesterday. The winner of the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner at The Curragh May 27 has not been seen since following up in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 8, but is on course for the French championship race. Although Imagine was expected to run in the G1 Prix Vermeille there Sept. 16, trainer Aidan O'Brien told *Irish Racing online* yesterday: "Imagine is back cantering and is very well, but we don't want to risk anything by rushing her. It could be that a race like the Prix Vermeille might come too soon and I wouldn't be surprised if she went straight for the Arc."

Ishiguru has been unlucky not to win a stakes race so far in his career, but he finally gained compensation here. Seventh in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 12 last time, he was overshadowed that day by the impressive performance of his stable companion Mozart (Ire). Previously, he had been beaten a head by Reperatory (GB) in the Listed Richard H. Faught Memorial S. here July 1. Here, he settled in mid-division early as Bouncing Bowdler (GB) (Mujadil {USA}) assumed command. After challenging the leader inside the final quarter mile, he hit the front with 300 yards remaining and held off the fast-finishing D'Anjou in the closing stages. For trainer Aidan O'Brien and jockey Michael Kinane, this win completed a stakes double after the success of Hawk Wing (USA) earlier in the afternoon. Aidan O'Brien said of Ishiguru: "He would appreciate really fast ground, and this six furlongs is probably as far as he wants to go. The plan is to go back to five furlongs for the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp [Oct. 7]."

Jerry Bailey, jockey of runner-up E Dubai, had no excuses for his horse and only praise for the winner. "My horse ran a huge race today," said Bailey, who won four on the card. "We gave [Point Given] a good battle today, but he is an awesome horse and proved to be the best." The only blemish on Point Given's record in seven starts this year is his fifth-place finish as the favorite in the Kentucky Derby. "I've learned never to look back," philosophized Baffert. "Look forward and enjoy the horse. I have to thank the Prince [Ahmed bin Salman] for letting me run this horse so much. We really enjoy watching this horse run. The fans enjoy it. Everywhere we go, he picks up a following. When they brought Cigar to Del Mar, I said, 'If I ever have a horse like this I want to share him.' There are few owners that would let me do that." Prince Ahmed bin Salman was on hand to enjoy the victory, which he dedicated to his late brother Prince Fahd Salman, who died of a heart attack last month. "I'm extremely grateful and this comes at a perfect time," said Salman. "Unfortunately, I lost my best friend, my brother, last month. I wanted to win this race to dedicate it to him. I'm sure he's watching us from heaven now and he'll be pleased. This is the best race I have ever won in my life." Point Given, whose sire Thunder Gulch won this race in 1995, became the first horse to win the Preakness, Belmont and Travers since Damascus in 1967.

Squirtle Squirt was switched to Bobby Frankel's barn after concluding a juvenile campaign that saw victories in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship and the Barretts Juvenile, but he didn't make his 2001 debut until May 2. He defeated a good allowance field that day, then came back to run a close second to Early Flyer in the GIII Laz Barrera S. at Hollywood May 28. In his most recent start, he acquitted himself well against older horses, finishing second after setting a scorching pace in the GIII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. July 1. He was shipped to New York shortly thereafter and was pointed specifically to this race. The 3-2 favorite was sent to the lead right out of the gate and bounded to the front without any significant pressure from the other speed horses. Rated by Jerry Bailey through fractions of :22 flat and :44 1/5--easy going for the freakishly fast colt--he responded when roused at the top of the stretch and won by an easy 3 1/4 lengths. "I thought he was a better horse than these," said trainer Bobby Frankel, who continued his assault on American graded stakes. "We'll take him back to Belmont and get him ready for the Breeders' Cup Sprint." Jorge Chavez, who rode second choice City Zip, said of his mount, "He ran as hard as he could. He made a nice move on the far turn, but he couldn't keep it going in the

Timboroa, a Group 1 winner in Italy in May of last year, won the GIII Carleton F Burke H. at Santa Anita in his third U.S. start, then finished 11th in the G1 Japan Cup. Given the winter off, he came back to just miss by a neck in the GIII Fastness H. at Hollywood May 13, then ran a good third to Bienamado in the GI Whittingham H. June 10. Most recently, he finished fourth, beaten four lengths, in the GI Eddie Read H. at Del Mar July 28. The British-bred broke well and raced second as a headstrong 8-5 favorite. Kudos (Kris S.) opened an early lead of six lengths. Kudos slowed the pace on the backstretch and the field closed in on him, with Timboroa holding good position on his flank. As the pacesetter began to falter, Timboroa took over on the turn, opened up a length into the stretch and maintained that advantage to the wire over the late-closing Northern Quest. Trainer Bobby Frankel trained the top three finishers of the race. "I had a perfect trip," said winning rider Laffit Pincay, Jr. "It was a good race. It feels great to ride a really good horse like this; one who tries as hard as he can. Bobby Frankel talked to my agent [Bob Meldahl] today and told him to tell me to put this horse in the race, not to let him fall back, but to make him fall like he was in it right from the start. I did it and it worked out great. He's a really nice horse." Chris McCarron, rider of the runner-up, said, "He gave me a good, honest run. He was just second best

today. With a horse like this, you have to ride him the way I did (from off the pace). That's just the way it is."

Trainer John Kimmel has had a great weekend, winning Friday's GI Personal Ensign H. with Pompeii and this event with Dr. Kashnikow. Both wins were bittersweet, however, as both horses had been sold prior to their races and will now leave the Kimmel barn. Dream Supreme, four-for-five at seven furlongs, has never been beaten at Saratoga. The four-year-old captured the GI Test S. over the track last year and came back to defeat older fillies in the 2000 Ballerina. After capping the campaign with a decent sixth-place showing in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Downs, she has come back this year to win three of five starts, including an impressive 4 3/4-length score in the July 14 GIII Princess Rooney S. at Calder last time out. Trainer Steve Young, who saddles **Imadeed** here, said, "Of course I've got a lot of respect for Dream Supreme. She's a great horse. She could probably win the Breeders' Cup Sprint if it were run at Saratoga." But he added, "I think we've got the quickest horse from the gate in [the Ballerina]. She'll be very tough if she can shake loose and open up a length or two in midstretch." Young has an outstanding record at the current Saratoga meet, winning with four of his five starters and running third with the other. Imadeed has done her part for the stable, wiring the field in a six-furlong allowance test July 30 to win by an eye-catching 6 1/4 lengths.
