## JOHANNESBURG MAJESTIC IN THE MORNY

"Magnifique" exclaimed the race commentator and how true, as **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) won this vintage renewal of the G1 Prix Morny with ease as the odds-on favourite. After the slipped saddle on Mozart (Ire) in Thursday's G1 Nunthorpe S. at York, more bad luck haunted jockey Michael Kinane when Johannesburg lost his left front shoe during the running of the race, but that had little effect on the outcome. The colt emulated the achievement in 1999 of the brilliant, but ill-fated Fasliyev, who also came from Ballydoyle, in winning this and the G1 Phoenix S. Never asked a serious question in victory here, he has to now be ranked one of the very finest to have been trained there in recent years. He looked a league apart from his rivals in overwhelming his Phoenix foes by five lengths Aug. 12, having improved off his earlier efforts in a Fairyhouse maiden May 30 and G3 Anglesey S. at The Curragh July 14, where he was barely off the bridle to score. He even had the pace to cope over five furlongs in the the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot June 21. He used that early speed to track stablemate **Line Rider** (Danzig) in fifth, but it seemed a question of when Kinane would let his colt go. Short of room at halfway, he was edged carefully left soon after to make his move and when the gap came, he was pushed through with hands and heels to grab the lead at the furlong marker. Kinane knew he had already done enough without having to set him alight and with one wave of the whip he ensured the smooth success expected as **Zip-ping (Ire)** (Zafonic) and **Meshaheer** (Nureyev) made late progress without rating as dangers. Bookmakers were running for cover, quoting the unbeaten star at odds as short as 3-1 for next year's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket with William Hill. O'Brien, basking in his 12th Group 1 win this year, and third renewal of this race in the last four years, said, "This is a real nice horse with lots of natural speed and ability. You don't want to compare horses, but he really rates high. He deserves a small break now and we will freshen him up before thinking about races like the G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 4] and G1 Dewhurst S. [at Newmarket Oct. 20]. The G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile [at Belmont Park Oct. 27] is also under consideration. Let's wait to see how the horse does and recovers before committing to any special race." (Chart p2)

## FAVORITE OUTSHINED IN BALLERINA

The Saratoga faithful installed **Dream Supreme** (Seeking the Gold) the odds-on choice to win her second consecutive G1 Ballerina H., but she lacked the needed response in the stretch, allowing Bohemia Stables' homebred **Shine Again** (Wild Again) to dance up the rail to land the spoils. A two-length winner of the two-turn Geisha H. for Maryland bred Apr. 21, the dark bay cut back to six furlongs to finish a late-running third in the GII Genuine Risk H. May 12, but was most recently third when stretched back to a route in the GII Molly Pitcher Breeders' Cup H. at Monmouth June 30. The rank outsider in the quintet, Shine Again loped along in fourth early as **Imadeed** (Alydeed) dictated a strong pace. The latter began to retreat in upper stretch and was overtaken along the inside by Shine Again at the eighth pole before holding **Country Hideaway** (Seeking the Gold) at bay for her first graded-stakes win. "The field was coming up short and that was one of the reasons we decided to run," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "This has to be nice for Mrs. DuPont. It's always nice to win with homebred horses." Jerkens indicated that the winner is possible for the G1 Ruffian H. at Belmont Sept. 15. "If you're getting crazy, you might as well stay crazy," the "Giant Killer" mused.

The strapping bay filly will remain with her trainer Roland Dzubasz to contest the G2 Arthur Andersen Cup at Frankfurt Sept. 16 before tackling the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp Oct. 7. If the results of this year's Debutante are any indication, the West Coast will be represented by a strong contingent in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Habibty (formerly Habibaty), out of a half sister to 1995 GI Kentucky Oaks winner Gal In A Ruckus, jumped at the start of her career debut at Del Mar July 29, but rallied four wide to win by two lengths. The chestnut trained well in the interim, including a solid five eighths in :59 4/5 Aug. 21, but would have to deal with GII Sorrento S. heroine Tempera this time around. Who Loves Aleyna was quickest from the gate and was joined by Tempera from the inside, as Habibty, slow into stride, advanced along the rail into third entering the far turn. The top two raced as a team to the quarter pole, as jockey Victor Espinoza had a handful of horse and needed just a little racing luck as the field turned for home. Tempera vacated the inside and Habibty showed good courage to slip through a narrow opening at the fence before scooting clear. Who Loves Aleyna, from the family of Breeders' Cup Turf winner Prized, battled gamely through the stretch to decision Tempera for the show. "It was a little tight in there, but I had so much horse that there wasn't any doubt I was going to go in there," Espinoza explained. "She's not afraid of anything so there wasn't much question she'd get it done." The victory was the fifth in the last seven runnings of the race for trainer Bob Baffert, who returned from a successful trip to Saratoga to saddle the winner.

**TRAVERS WRAP UP** A day after his 3 1/2-length victory in Saturday's GI Travers S. at Saratoga, The Thoroughbred Corporation's **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch) was putting on a show for onlookers outside his stall yesterday morning. "It was gratifying for the fans," said exercise rider Pepe Aragon, who took time out from walking the chestnut to pose for photos. The victory was equally exciting for Aragon, who was forced to miss Point Given's victory in the GI Haskell Invitational Aug. 5. "I missed the Haskell with an injury," he explained. "You're always thrilled to win a race like that. I was jumping up and down like a little kid." Point Given was due to leave Saratoga at 7 a.m. this morning. Also ecstatic with the results of Saturday's race was Dallas Stewart, trainer of third-place finisher **Dollar Bill** (Peaks and Valleys). The colt was plagued by troubled trips in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, but was making his first start since a distant fourth-place finish behind Point Given in the June 9 Belmont S. "He did us proud," Stewart said. "Ideally we would have liked to have two more weeks to get him ready, but he ran super considering he didn't have a prep for it." Winless since his victory in the Risen Star S. in February, Dollar Bill is under consideration for the GI Super Derby at Louisiana Downs Sept. 23. **Scorpion** (Seattle Slew), winner of the GI Jim Dandy Aug. 4, emerged from his sixth-place finish on Saturday in good order and will be pointed for the GII Jerome H. at Belmont Sept. 15. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas was critical of the ride given by Mark Guidry, who had Scorpion too close to the pace, according to Lukas. "That was exactly what I did not want," the conditioner said. "I could tell we were out of it five jumps into the race." Trainer Nick Zito still feels that fourth-place finisher **A P Valentine** (A.P. Indy) is better than he has shown his last couple of efforts. "He came out of the race in pretty good shape," Zito said. "He ran as best as he could. Right now I am trying to figure out the possibilities of the future with this horse." The conditioner is considering sending the colt to Turfway Park for the Kentucky Cup Classic on Sept. 22.
