She took the Listed Middleton S. at York May 16, which was a belated first stakes success, before finishing a fair fifth to Sacred Song (USA) in the G3 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock July 7. Here she was settled in sixth early as Rainshine (GB) (Rainbow Quest {USA}) and Denise Margaret (Ire) (Flying Spur {Aus}) disputed the early lead. Taken off the rail entering the final straight, Kevin Darley was able to creep closer as the leaders started to fade in the straight. Hitting the front with quarter of a mile remaining, she was driven out to hold It's a Secret, under a 17 pounds lighter burden. Victoria Cross, the well-backed favourite, could not find racing space when it was required and stayed on at the one pace once in the clear.

Here he was taken to the far side early by Murtagh to join the group of five. He passed the leader travelling easily at halfway before asserting from Million Percent and Fergal Lynch. Trainer Peter Harris said: "We planned to go the far side as the first two races were won over there. We think a lot of him--hope he's on the upgrade. We go next for the G2 Mill Reef S. [at Newbury Sept. 22] and obviously he'll have to improve to win that but I think he is improving so we go there with every hope."

**KINANE BAN CONFIRMED**

Michael Kinane's second appeal against his two-day ban was dismissed yesterday by the Irish Turf Club's Appeals & Referrals Committee. The hearing concluded that the ban, picked up for "careless" riding on Sophisticat (USA) in the Listed Silver Flash S. at Leopardstown July 18, was to be enforced for today and tomorrow. The jockey was successful in obtaining an interim injunction on the Turf Club from imposing the ban on July 27-28, which would have caused him to miss the winning ride on Galileo (Ire) in the G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot.

**HIGHTORI ON WORLD SERIES TRAIL**

**Hightori (Fr)** (Vettori {Ire}) was yesterday supplemented for Sunday's DM1.7 million G1 Grosser Preis von Baden. The four-year-old was added at a cost of DM195,500 to the 12-furlong feature of the Baden Baden meeting, which serves as the fourth leg of the Emirates World Series. **PEDIGREE INSIGHTS**

**RIVERMAN RUNS DEEP**

As a sire of broodmares, the much-missed Riverman has established an enviably good record, siring the dams of such major European performers as Spinning World, Erhaab, Carnegie, Bosra Sham and Anabaa Blue. Unfortunately, he doesn't command the same respect as a sire of sires, despite the best efforts of his dependable son Irish River (sire of such as Paradise Creek, Hatoof, Brief Truce and Irish Prize). Others, such as Group 1 winners Rousillon, Policeman and Dowsing, largely failed to live up to expectations.

Perhaps Riverman's status as a sire of sires will have to be reviewed after last week's three-day meeting at York. The opening day's feature, the Juddmonte International, produced a spectacular display from Sakhee, who became the first Group 1 winner to represent Riverman's son Bahri. On the second day, the Aston Upthorpe Yorkshire Oaks produced a surprise win by Super Tassa, who became the second Group 1 winner to represent Lahib, another son of Riverman.

Coincidentally, Lahib and Bahri were bred and raced by Hamdan al Maktoum and both were trained by John Dunlop to win the Queen Elizabeth II S., one of Europe's best mile races. Lahib won the race in 1992 to earn a place at Derrinstown Stud, Sheikh Hamdan's Irish stallion station. Bahri's emergence three years later caused something of a problem for the Shadwell team. Could they stand two similar sons of Riverman in Europe without compromising the prospects of each of them? Apparently, the team came to the conclusion that it made more sense to stand the two stallions on opposite sides of the Atlantic and Bahri was sent to Kentucky, beginning his stallion career at a fee of \$20,000 in 1996.

Sadly, Bahri found it very hard to gain support from U.S. breeders, who could be forgiven for being wary of a turf son of Riverman--even one as good as Bahri, who

was officially rated the second-best European three-year-old of 1995, just one pound below Lammtarra.

That Bahri is from the same Myrtlewood family as Seattle Slew and Mr. Prospector didn't help much.

Bahri's first four seasons saw him cover 36 mares in 1996, 39 in 1997, 18 in 1998 and 24 in 1999, when Shadwell supplied as many as 11 of his visitors. Even Bahri's very promising results in the spring of 2000 appear to have come a little too late, because his book for that year still fell below 40 mares.

Still, the fact that his first three crops numbered fewer than 70 named foals hasn't stopped him hitting the target with encouraging regularity.

Two members of his first crop were good enough to be placed in hotly contested European classics, with Alshakr finishing a close third in the French 1000 Guineas and Sakhee finishing well clear of the rest when a length second to Sinndar in the Derby.

Bahri's second crop contains some talented turf winners, including the Group-placed English filly Khulan and the American colt River God, who was a possible runner in the Epsom Derby until injury intervened. Bahri's small third crop, which is largely based in Europe, has already produced a nice juvenile winner.

The chances are that Bahri's big chance will come with his 2002 crop. Shadwell rewarded him for his excellent early results by sending him a strong team of mares this year, headed by Lahan, winner of last year's G1 1000 Guineas, and Saffaanh, dam of the '95 1000 Guineas winner Harayir. The Shadwell squad also included Sakhee's Group-winning dam Thawakib.

Thawakib, a Group 2 winner over 1 1/2 miles, is proving just as effective as a broodmare. Sakhee is her third foal and third winner, the second being Riverman's daughter Nasheed, a Listed winner over 1 1/4 miles. The appeal of sending Thawakib to Riverman and his son Bahri may have been that these matings produced two lines to Lalun, but Riverman had already made his mark on this family, siring the dual Grade I winner River Memories from a half-sister to Thawakib.

Sakhee's fourth dam is the celebrated Dangerous Dame, who numbers Broad Brush, Capote, and Exceller among her descendants. This is an impressive collec-
