## LAILANI HEADED TO AMERICA

Three-year-old filly **Lailani (GB)** (Unfuwain), who capped a six-race winning streak with a 1 1/2-length victory in the Aug. 4 G1 Vodafone Nassau S. at Goodwood, will head to the U.S. to continue her racing career, *Sporting Life* on-line reports. The Maktoum Al Maktoum runner, unplaced in two starts last year, has been unbeatable this season, climbing from the maiden and handicap ranks to win the G1 Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks by a neck prior to her Nassau score. She had been considered a possible for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October, but instead will be pointed for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Belmont Park Oct. 27. "The owner is keen to run in the Breeders' Cup, so we are looking at the Flower Bowl (GI, Belmont Park, Sept. 29) as a prep race," trainer Ed Dunlop told the *Daily Mail*. The bay will be retired after the Breeders' Cup, remaining in the States to be bred.

Vision of Night has been a consistent stakes performer from two to five, but he gained his most important success to date here under a fine ride from Pat Eddery. Third in the G1 Middle Park S. in October 1998, he won the G3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville in August 1999. Transferred to the U.S. soon after, he failed to make an impact and was sent back to Britain. In his first start after returning home, he captured the Listed Hopeful S. at Newmarket last July. This term he has looked like the force of old, running creditably when second to Cassandra Go in the G2 Temple S. at Sandown May 28. Here, Vision of Night was tucked away in the early stages as Call Me Big showed the way. After the leader gamely fought off the challenges of Tertullian and Rolo Tomasi, it was Sartorial who posed the biggest threat, while Vision of Night kicked it into top gear. That trio battled it out inside the final furlong, with Vision of Night getting the call on the line in a desperate finish. Eddery commented, "I was drawn wide and couldn't get in, otherwise he would have won by a length." The winner survived a stewards' inquiry after hanging in slightly on the runner-up.

### 19 LEFT IN ST LEGER

After yesterday's forfeit stage, **Alexius (Ire)** (Rainbow Quest {USA}) heads the 19 remaining entries for the 225th running of the £350,000 G1 Rothmans Royals St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 15. Sir Michael Stoute's colt joins **Mr Combustible (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) and **Milan (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) at the head of William Hills' current ante-post market at odds of 7-2 on the basis of his impressive last-to-first score in Goodwood's G3 Gordon S. July 31. Mr Combustible, winner of the G2 Geoffrey Freer S. at Newbury Aug. 18 last time, was supported into 7-2 from 4-1 with William Hill yesterday. Milan, winner of the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York Aug. 21, is one of four from trainer Aidan O'Brien, a quartet which also includes Tote Ebor H. winner **Mediterranean (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). The sole French entry is **Roman Saddle (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}), third behind Alexius at Goodwood before winning the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. at Haydock Aug. 11, could be supplemented Sept. 8 at a cost of £20,000. Tim Betteridge, general manager at Doncaster Racecourse, said yesterday, "This year's Rothmans Royals St Leger promises to be one of the most competitive renewals of recent years. We are thrilled to see so many overseas-trained entries keen to take on the strong home challenge."

### TOTE AYR GOLD CUP DRAWS RECORD ENTRY

A record total of 180 horses have been entered for this year's Tote Ayr Gold Cup, Scotland's most valuable Flat race. The previous mark of 171 entries was set last year. The £100,000 event, for three-year-olds and up going six furlongs, will be run Saturday, Sept. 22. The ante-post favourite, at 8-1 with Tote, is the three-year-old filly **Ghazal (USA)** (Gone West {USA}), winner of a conditions race at Yarmouth Aug. 26. The field will be limited to 29 starters.

**WILHELMS TO APPEAL**

Dr Rolf Wilhelms is set to appeal the decision which saw his mare **Proudwings (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) disqualified from first in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 18. The mare was demoted after swerving in front of Banks Hill (GB) and Noverre (USA) in the final 25 yards. "I have watched the video several times and can see perfectly well that my mare veered sharply left and hampered Noverre and Banks Hill, but the incident was so close to the line that I feel that the result was not affected and the jockeys themselves confirm this," Wilhelms said. "What really annoys me is that the French stewards placed Proudwings in last position. I think that this is completely unfair and unjustified. Even if the appeals committee do not give her the race back, I hope that they at least award her a sensible placing as she was clearly the best horse on the day." The appeal will be heard in Paris Wednesday.

**Commission Approves Training Track Dorms:**

Gulfstream Park received permission from Palm Beach County Commissioners to build 500 dormitories on their Boynton Beach training track property. Chairman Doug Donn said after the day-long commission meeting, "We expect to break ground within 60 days." The constructing project is important to Florida racing because, with Hialeah closing next year, over 1,000 stalls will be eliminated from South Florida. "We've had a permit for the stables and training track for six weeks, but we wanted to wait to start construction until we got approval on the dorms," said Donn. The 320-acre Boynton Beach Training Center will accommodate nearly 2,300 horses when it is completed. Construction will take approximately a year. The property is located just west of the Boynton Beach Florida Turnpike entrance and approximately 50 miles north of Gulfstream Park. "The individual dorm rooms will be 220 square feet, each will house one person, it will be a state of the art and fully air conditioned," said Donn. "Frank Stronach [president of Magna Entertainment, Inc., which owns Gulfstream] is committed to building the best facility he can for the people who work in racing." Members from surrounding home owners association attended the commission meeting. "There were some questions, but no opposition to the project," said Donn.
