## SPIN CITY

A field of seven two-year-old fillies will go postward in the 110th running of the GI Spinaway S. today at Saratoga, headlined by **Cashier's Dream** (Service Stripe). Having set a track record at Churchill in winning the GIII Debutante S. July 7, the chestnut filly lost her unbeaten record when second by a neck to You in the GII Adirondack S. Aug. 13 over this surface while conceding seven pounds to the runner-up. That stakes-record setting effort earned Cashier's Dream a 106 Beyer Speed Figure, which is 27 points higher than any of the other entrants have posted. The Michigan-bred drops a pound and stretches out an extra sixteenth just 18 days after the Adirondack, but seems likely to get her first Grade I victory here. "For a two-year-old, she's very professional both mentally and physically," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "I think she can run five lengths slower and win this race. We were very proud of her the other day." Fourth in her debut at Churchill, **Spirit and Soul** (Saint Ballado) battled gamely to break her maiden over course and distance Aug. 3. The dark bay drilled a bullet half in :48 4/5 over the Oklahoma track Aug. 24 and should do her best running in the stretch. **Smok'n Frolic** (Smoke Glacken) looked sharp in winning the Astoria S. at Belmont by 5 3/4 lengths, but flipped her palate when a distant fifth in the Adirondack.

## GODOLPHIN MAY SKIP BELMONT RACES

Godolphin may not send some of its horses to run in Belmont Park's major fall races because of strict quarantine regulations put in place to keep foot-and-mouth disease out of the United States, the *Racing Post* reported. The United States has denied a request by the stable for private quarantine facilities in New York. Currently, horses imported into the United States are kept in a facility where they have no contact with accompanying staff for up to 48 hours. Unless the procedure is changed, **Mutafaweq** (Silver Hawk), winner of

last year's GI Canadian International, could be forced to miss the Sept. 8 GI Man o' War and G1 Irish Oaks winner **Lailani** (GB) (Unfuwain) could miss the Sept. 29 GI Flower Bowl Invitational. "There are problems but I'm still hoping we will be able to arrange private quarantine for the international group races at Belmont this fall," explained James MacEwan, the shipping manager for Godolphin. "I don't see why Arlington and the Breeders' Cup should have preferential treatment and the Man o' War and Flower Bowl don't have the same status. If they want international runners, they've got to accommodate us. The present arrangement jeopardizes everyone's plans."

With a foreign flavour to it this year, the Maurice Lacroix Trophy may prove hard for Germany to keep at home. Heading the domestic defence is the unbeaten **Stolzing**, who took the G3 Premio Primi Passi in Milan June 17 and is a course winner here. **Flying Dash** ran a great race when beaten only a neck by Firebreak (GB) in the G3 Prix de Cabourg at Deauville Aug. 4, form which was boosted by the winner's subsequent fourth behind Johannesburg in Saturday's G1 Prix Morny. The overseas challenge is led by **Funfair Wane**, who battled well to land the Listed Washington Singer S. at Newbury Aug. 17. **Agnetha**, bought as a yearling here last year, won the Listed Silver Flash S. at Leopardstown July 18 before running third to Johannesburg in the G1 Phoenix S. there Aug. 12.

**HIGHTORI OUT** Just hours after Coral Eurobet made him its 7-4 favorite, **Hightori (Fr)** (Vettori {Ire}) was yesterday withdrawn from Sunday's G1 UAE Grosser Preis von Baden at Baden Baden. The colt, third last time behind Galileo (Ire) in the G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28, suffered from a bout of toothache. Hightori's absence leaves **Sabiango (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}) as the 2-1 favourite, with G1 Deutsches Derby winner **Boreal (Ger)** (Java Gold {USA}) at 7-2 and G1 Derby Italiano winner **Morshdi (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}) at odds of 9-2. Sabiango will be ridden by Andreas Suborics, who told *PA Sport* yesterday: "We were very pleased with his last piece of work, which I rode him in, everything is prepared for Sunday. He will have no problem with the big field as it means there will be a good pace. The ground at Baden-Baden yesterday was firm and, with the rain today, it will become good. However, if there is any more rain, he may not run."

**GOLAN TO ARC?** **Golan (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), winner of the Newmarket 2000 Guineas in May, could be on track for a start in the Oct. 7 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, according to *Racing Post*. The colt has been entered in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp on Sept. 16. He has been off since finishing third in the July 1 Irish Derby. Coral Eurobet introduced Golan at 16-1 for the Arc. The current favorite for the race, at 7-2, is Fantastic Light (USA). Golan's two-year-old half sister **Mount Street (Ire)** (Pennekamp {USA}) debuted yesterday at Salisbury, finishing second as the favorite. (*For more information, see today's British report*).

**BADEN BADEN SALE STARTS SATURDAY** Baden Baden's Yearling Sale has been a reliable source of some of the very best racehorses in recent years, including multiple Group 1 winners Monsun (Ger) and Tiger Hill (Ire). Last year, Erika Huber offered her bay filly **Agnetha (Ger)** (Big Shuffle {USA}) for sale and the full sister to the G2 Goldene Peitsche winner Areion (Ger) became the first graduate to win at stakes level in Britain and Ireland. Agnetha's own sister is due to enter the ring as lot 199 in Saturday's 2001 edition of the auction, and it would be no surprise to see her as the sales topper. A total of 218 colts and fillies are catalogued, with all the top class national sires represented, including Acatenango (Ger), Big Shuffle, Dashing Blade (GB), Lando (Ger), Law Society (USA), Lomitas (GB), Monsun (Ger), Platini (Ger), Sternkonig (Ire) and Java Gold (USA). Yearlings from the final crop of Surumu (USA) will also be going through the ring. International sires represented include Alzao (USA), Be My Guest (USA), Bluebird (USA), Desert King (Ire), Efisio (GB), Grand Lodge (USA), Halling (USA), Highest Honor (Fr), Mtoto (GB), Trampolino (USA) and Unfuwain (USA), as well as the promising King's Theatre (Ire), Royal Applause (GB) and Peintre Celebre (USA). Pick of the lots are lot 64, a colt by Platini (Ger) out of Listed winner and stakes-producing mare Arionette (GB), a full sister to Allegretta (GB); lot 118, a half sister to smart sprinter Call Me Big (Ger) by Acatenango (Ger); lot 193, a half sister to Salonblue (Ger) by Dashing Blade (GB); and lot 204, a full sister to **Peu a Peu (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}). **FALLON'S DOUBLE EXTENDS LEAD**

Kieren Fallon rode a double at Salisbury yesterday to extend his lead over Kevin Darley in the jockey's championship to eight. Darley rode a double at Catterick to close the gap on Wednesday, but Fallon responded in kind yesterday with success on **Noon Gun (GB)** (Ashkalani {Ire}) and **Bethesda (GB)** (Distant Relative {Ire}). Fallon, who gave up his mount in the last race at Catterick on Wednesday suffering from dehydration, almost made it a treble on **Mount Street (Ire)** (Pennekamp {USA}) in the maiden, but the pair ran second to **Brown Eyes (GB)** (Danehill {USA}). Mount Street, a half sister to this year's G1 2000 Guineas winner Golan (Ire), raced greenly before staying on well to fill second. Fallon said of her: "She's a very well-made filly and she's quite laid back. This filly is more or less in the same mould [as Golan] because she doesn't do a lot at home but what she's done you'd be happy with." Fallon now sits on 121 winners for the season.

**TWO-YEAR-OLD REVIEW** by Tom Frary

Unusually for early September, there is a clear favourite for next year's G1 2000 Guineas in the shape of **Johannesburg** (Hennessy). Aidan O'Brien's colt has barely raced off the bridle in winning the G3 Anglesey S., G1 Pheonix S. and G1 Prix Morny. His trainer and jockey believe he will stay further and he has already shown sufficient speed to win over five furlongs in the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot. Quoted now as low as 3-1 for the Newmarket Classic, he looks undisputed as the best of his generation at present. The only doubt, it appears, surrounding his chances in the Classics next year emanate from the question of stamina. Last year Minardi (USA) was arguably as impressive as Johannesburg in the Leopardstown Group 1 yet his failure to see out a mile this year serves as a timely reminder that juvenile precocity can be misread. As Andrew Caulfield said in the *TDN* Aug. 14, "The question now is how much Johannesburg will continue to follow in Minardi's footsteps." Johannesburg is likely to take in the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket Oct. 4 as Minardi did last year. However, connections are talking of the G1 Dewhurst S. there Oct. 20 or G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Belmont Park Oct. 27. Should he take the latter, comparisons with the great Arazi (USA), who also won the Prix Morny, are bound to be bandied about. At present he looks more in the stamp of another Morny victor in Zafonic (USA), champion juvenile of 1992.

Apart from Johannesburg, the story of the year regarding two-year-olds so far has been the more-than-successful return to Newmarket of David Loder. Having saddled the smart **Meshaheer (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}) to win the G3 July S. and **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) to win the G3 Vintage S., Loder has already hit the board when it matters. He may have better prospects of troubling Johannesburg with the extremely

well-touted **Dubai Destination (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}), who took a hot Newmarket maiden July 10 in fine style. Loder also has **Official Flame (USA)** (Deputy Minister {Can}), who took the important Convivial maiden at York Aug. 22. That win followed the G2 Gimcrack S. success an hour earlier of **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}), also from Ballydoyle. An exciting colt, he too has not been truly extended in winning his Group races and was unlucky to not get a run at all in the G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot won by stable companion **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill {USA}). Of the fillies, **Gossamer (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) followed up a debut success in another hot Newmarket maiden July 12 to win the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood by seven lengths. Mick Channon holds a strong hand in this department, with **Ya Hajar (GB)** (Lycius {USA}), who finished third behind Gossamer at Newmarket before going on to win the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville Aug. 21. Channon also trains **Queen's Logic (Ire)** (Grand Lodge {USA}), who very much sets the standard having won the G3 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot June 20 and G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 23, as the trainer's Bint Allayl (GB) did in 1998.

**TRIPPI RETIRED** Dogwood Stable's Trippi (End Sweep--Jealous Appeal, by Valid Appeal) has been retired from racing and will enter stud at Vinery Kentucky in 2002, it was announced yesterday. During his career, the four-year-old won races from six to nine furlongs, including the GI Vosburgh S. over older horses during his three-year-old season. Trippi finished his career in the care of trainer Todd Pletcher with seven wins from 14 starts and earnings of \$666,220. "After a superb 2000, Trippi began his campaign this year in the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint H. and sustained a serious injury to his heel when he stumbled at the break and finished a close second," said Dogwood president Cot Campbell. "When it was clear he was not able to compete at his previous top-class level...the retirement decision was made." Details of Trippi's syndication and stud fee will be announced in September. Vinery bought 25 percent of Trippi before his Vosburgh victory.

**BROKEN VOW TO STAND AT PIN OAK** Sunday's GII Iselin H. winner **Broken Vow** (Unbridled--Wedding Vow, by Nijinsky II) will stand at Pin Oak Stud after his racing career is over, farm owner Josephine Abercrombie announced today. The four-year-old has won nine of 12 career starts for trainer H. Graham Motion. He owns graded victories in the Iselin and the GIII Ben Ali S. and finished third in the GI Gulfstream Park H. and GII Massachusetts H. "He's a lovely individual who also has a top pedigree behind him," said Abercrombie. "Obviously, he's special to us because he's a homebred, but we also think he will be a nice compliment to the breeding business and we've already gotten a lot of interest in him from outside breeders." A stud fee for Broken Vow will be determined at a later date.

**TIZNOW WORKS FOR WOODWARD** Horse of the Year **Tiznow** (Cee's Tizzy) worked seven furlongs yesterday at Del Mar in 1:25 4/5 with Chris McCarron aboard.
