POINT GIVEN RETIRED

The Thoroughbred Corporation's **Point Given** (Thunder Gulch--Turko's Turn, by Turkoman), the leading candidate for Horse of the Year honors, has been retired after a tendon strain in his left foreleg was discovered Thursday morning. The injury surfaced five days after the big chestnut scored an effortless victory in the GI Travers S. at Saratoga. According to trainer Bob Baffert, Point Given's groom noticed some heat in the colt's tendon just below the left knee. Initially, the injury didn't seem to be too serious. "When the groom asked me to take a look at something, I had a knot in my stomach," said Baffert. "When I looked at it, though, I thought maybe it's not that big of a deal." An ultrasound examination performed by Dr. Vince Baker several hours later proved otherwise, indicating a larger problem. "Dr. Baker said he strained [the tendon]," said Baffert. "I called [Thoroughbred Corporation racing manager] Richard Mulhall and let him know, and the Prince came to my barn and we talked about it. With a horse like him, the Prince said, 'Why continue on, why take a chance?'" Baffert said that the injury has left all of the colt's connections in a state of shock. "Right now, everyone in my barn is devastated," added the silver-haired trainer. "You wait all your life for a horse like this, and boom, they're snatched away and you feel cheated. I'm just thankful he did it after he made \$4 million and did what he did. He's going out a winner. What he did was remarkable." Along with his trainer, Point Given had a flare for the media spotlight and always drew a crowd. He missed winning the Breeders' Cup Juvenile by a nose, but stamped himself a contender for the Classics in the process. Following two excellent prep races, Point Given was sent off the 9-5 favorite in the Kentucky Derby, but turned in the only poor performance of his career, running fifth. "The Derby was always a puzzler to me," said Baffert. Making the Derby defeat ever more hard to swallow, he rebounded to take the Preakness, then humiliated his opponents with a 12 1/4-length romp in the Belmont. After a summer rest and training setbacks which forced him to wear a bar shoe for the Aug. 5 GI Haskell, he made the trip cross country and scored a workmanlike victory that prepared him for Saturday's Travers S.

Cashier's Dream had every right to bounce to the moon when attempting her first Grade I stakes. Only 18 days prior, she had engaged in a spirited duel and run second by a neck to You in the GII Adirondack S., earning a Beyer Speed Figure of 107 in the process. Prior to this event, trainer Steve Asmussen told the *Daily Racing Form*, "I feel great about how she's doing both mentally and physically." He couldn't have been more correct. Made the heavy favorite by the Saratoga crowd, Cashier's Dream broke sharply and took command by two lengths, cutting fractions of :21 4/5 and :44 4/5. Several competitors tried to challenge on the turn, but none of them got even close, as the chestnut filly rolled home to a six-length romp. "That should definitely get the memories of the loss out of her head," said Asmussen. "It's nice to know this is a filly that can dig down deep. I get nervous every time I run her because she's special. She'll go to Belmont with the rest of the stable. That's a good place for her and there are a lot of possibilities." Jockey Donnie Meche added, "This is one of the biggest wins of my career and I couldn't be here without Steve (Asmussen). She's a

With the outcome never in doubt, the big red machine won the Midsummer Derby by 3 1/2 lengths over E Dubai. Baffert is not sure whether the injury occurred during the running of that race or if it was the result of something Point Given did when he had a spell of bad behavior Wednesday. "I really think it probably happened in that race and when he was playing around he aggravated it," he said. While the injury is mild in nature, Baffert and Prince Ahmed Salman, who was in town and at Del Mar soon after the problem was detected, decided that the five or six months of recovery time and the prospect of Point Given not being able to return to top form were reason enough to call it a career. "If he hadn't done what he has already accomplished, we might have brought him back. But a big horse like him, it takes a lot to get him ready and bring him back around," said Baffert. "I've never had a horse like that," he added. "He was just going to get better and better with time. [The Prince] was looking forward to taking him to Dubai next year. It's a big blow not only for us, but for the racing community." Point Given will remain in Baffert's care in Southern California until further notice. No immediate plans for the horse have been made regarding a stallion career, but Baffert speculated that a lot of farms would be courting him. "I really enjoyed watching him run," added Baffert. Point Given retires with a record of nine wins and three second from 13 starts and earnings of \$3,968,500.
