GO EAST YOUNG MAN

Offered three times at auction with no takers, **Came Home** (Gone West) maintained his unbeaten record with a stakes-record setting victory in the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga yesterday afternoon. Bought back for \$650,000 as a weanling at Keeneland November, \$300,000 as a Keeneland September yearling and most recently for \$145,000 at Barretts March, the dark bay colt debuted June 3 for breeders John Toffan and Trudy McCaffery and romped home by eight lengths at Hollywood. He handled the rise to stakes company with aplomb, shrugging off early challenges to win the GII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S. by four lengths July 15. With fellow California sensation Officer heading towards Wednesday's GII Del Mar Futurity, **Came Home's** connections opted for this Grade I test 3,000 miles away instead. He broke well from post four, but allowed California shipper **Roman Dancer** (Polish Numbers) to show the way through a :22 2/5 quarter as **Mayakovsky** (Matty G) ranged up on his outside. **Came Home** moved to the front turning for home and was immediately challenged by **Mayakovsky** as they clicked off 1:09 2/5 for three-quarters, but shook free and was drawing away at the finish while stopping the clock at 1:21 4/5. "I was a little bit worried at the eighth-pole, but when I saw Chris get after him, I told John [Toffan] that he left **Mayakovsky**," said winning trainer Paco Gonzalez. "He's a little horse, but he puts his head down and he's got a nice, long stride." The Hopeful was the first race in the Bessemer Trust Two-Year-Old Challenge, and **Came Home** may stick around in New York for his next start. "We're thinking very hard about staying East," Gonzalez continued. "The Champagne [GI, Oct. 6, 8.5f] might be next." **Mayakovsky**, who set a track record in winning his Saratoga debut, may also go next in the Champagne. The next race in the Bessemer Trust Challenge is the GII Del Mar Futurity Sept. 5, followed by the GI Futurity Sept. 16. *Hopeful chart, p2*

SWEET SEVENTEEN AT THE CURRAGH

A field of 17 two-year-olds will line up for the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh this afternoon. Having won the event last year with **Sequoyah** (Ire), trainer Aidan O'Brien shows his intent to follow up by saddling four runners this time. The choice among them is **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat), who has been the runner-up to **Queen's Logic** (Ire) twice, missing by a half length in the G3 **Queen Mary S.** at Royal Ascot and by 1 1/4 lengths in the G2 **Lowther S.** Aug. 23 when receiving three pounds. In between those runs she was beaten a length by **Agnetha** (Ire) in the Listed **Silver Flash S.** at Leopardstown July 18 after experiencing a luckless passage. The doubt surrounding her will be the step up to seven furlongs here, as she has shown such speed so far in her races. Stable companion **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) created a highly favourable impression when a fast-finishing head runner-up to **Saranac Lake** in the G3 **Debutante S.** here Aug. 19 on her debut. The overseas challenge is spearheaded by David Loder's **Seba (GB)** (Alzao), not seen since retaining her unbeaten record in the Listed **Chesham S.** at Royal Ascot June 20. She suffered through a troubled trip that day, yet still overcame some talented opposition. Loder took this prize in 1996 with **Bianca Nera (GB)**.

AGNETHA'S SISTER TOPS BADEN BADEN SALE

Last Friday, Baden Baden sale graduate Agnetha (Ger) was handed a narrow defeat by Flying Dash (Ger) in the G2 Maurice Lacroix Trophy, but her bloodlines ruled supreme at this year's sale when her full sister, a daughter of Aerleona (Ire) (Big Shuffle {USA}), lit up the pavilion as the bidding escalated to an unprecedented level. At the fall of the gavel, it was Paul Collins who spent a sales record DM820,000 to secure the flashy chestnut over Roger Alles. Foreign interests were active at the top end of the market, including Cheveley Park Stud, Newselles Park Stud and Ivan Allan, who purchased Flying Dash here last year for DM35,000. A Lomitas (GB) colt out of the young mare Bandeira, purchased by Roger Alle's German Bloodstock, earned the distinction as the top-priced colt. At the end of the day, 28 lots sold for DM100,000 or more; however, the downside of the day was that the middle of the market appeared somewhat weak and a high percentage of lots went through the ring unsold. Baden Baden Sales Manager Axel Donnerstag said, "The market at the top end was strong, but many vendors had their expectations set too high and foreign buyers were very selective. Also, one should not compare this sale to the 2000 sale which was outstanding in every respect, but rather to the sales in previous years." Of the 202 lots catalogued this year, 150 lots found new owners. The median price fell from DM54,000 last year to DM39,000 this time and average price also dipped from DM72,022 to DM64,127. Total aggregate for the sale reached DM9,619,000, a decrease from the DM11,955,000 spent one year ago. The two-day auction continues today.

Intrepidous was the subject of a substantial pre-race gamble and gave profit to her large band of supporters. Her claims for victory were not obvious on paper, but those with inside knowledge benefited from jockey Brett Doyle's enterprising riding tactics. Doyle soon had his mount at the fore, where he dictated at his own pace over Sayedah in second. Intrepidous came under pressure at the two-furlong pole as Sayedah tried to mount a challenge, but the former kept pulling out more each time her jockey asked for extra. Sayedah kept on gamely in the closing stages and was denied as Intrepidous held on gamely. Peaceful Paradise emerged from the pack late to take third.

A consistent Listed-race performer over the past two seasons, Flossy had yet to add stakes success to her tally of eight handicap wins. She set things straight here with an impressive display, defeating a competitive field in convincing fashion. The home-bred filly tracked the early leaders in fourth as the Norwegian-trained Charles Spencelayh (Ire) (Tenby {GB}) led from Samsaam (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}). Samsaam weakened rapidly with a half mile to run, and then it was Jalousie's turn to make her presence felt at the head of affairs. Jalousie's marriage with the lead was brief, however as Flossy cruised ominously to the front at the eighth pole. Jockey Robert Winston shook the reins at the filly and she surged clear inside the final furlong for a deserved win. Jalousie kept on determinedly close home to hold second from the late run of Garden Society.

{GB}) assumed his customary role of pacemaker as Ultimately Lucky was positioned fourth in the single file of six. Ultimately Lucky made stealthy headway once in the straight and quickened into the lead at the eighth pole. The result was never in doubt from that point on and he ran on strongly to easily hold off Kappa King.

TWO-YEAR-OLD REVIEW

It's somewhat unusual for early September, but **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) has established himself the clear favourite for next year's G1 2000 Guineas. The Aidan O'Brien-trained colt barely raced off the bridle in winning the G3 Anglesey S., G1 Phoenix S. and G1 Prix Morny, and his trainer and jockey believe he will stay further although he has shown sufficient speed to win over five furlongs in the G3 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot.

Quoted now as low as 3-1 for the Newmarket Classic, he looks undisputed as the best of his generation at present. The only doubt, it appears, surrounding his chances in the Classics next year emanate from the question of stamina.

Last year, Minardi (USA) was arguably as impressive as Johannesburg in the Leopardstown Group 1 yet his failure to see out a mile this year serves as a timely reminder that juvenile precocity can be misread. As Andrew Caulfield said in the *TDN* Aug. 14, "The question now is how much Johannesburg will continue to follow in Minardi's footsteps." Johannesburg is likely to contest the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket Oct. 4, as Minardi did last year and follow with the G1 Dewhurst S. there Oct. 20 or The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Belmont Park Oct. 27. Should he take the latter, comparisons with the great Arazi (USA), also a winner of the G1 Prix Morny, are bound to be bandied about. Apart from Johannesburg, the story of the year regarding two-year-olds so far has been the more-than-successful return to Newmarket of trainer David Loder. He saddled the smart **Meshaheer (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}) to win the G3 July S. and **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) to win the G3 Vintage S. He may have better prospects of upsetting Johannesburg with the extremely well-touted **Dubai Destination (USA)** (Kingmambo {USA}), impressive winner of a hot Newmarket maiden July 10. By far the most experienced juvenile in the field, Redback belied his status as the complete outsider to score a shock win in impressive fashion and provided trainer Richard Hannon with consecutive winners of this race following King's Ironbridge (Ire)'s success in last season's renewal. With two wins from seven previous starts and carrying a penalty for his victory in the Listed Weatherbys Superlative S. at Newmarket July 12, Redback was not considered by punters as the likely winner following a below par display behind Naheef (Ire) in the G3 Champagne Lanson S. at Goodwood Aug. 1. He showed complete disdain for his detractors with an impressive four-length success, paving the way for a possible start in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster Oct. 27. Jockey Jimmy Fortune never had Redback out of the top two and allowed Doc Holiday (Ire) (Dr Devious {Ire}) to lead until the final quarter. It was here that Redback took over and as the field entered the final furlong and he drew clear of his rivals. He ran on in great style to record his first group race win from the promising Tholjanah. Winning trainer Richard Hannon told *PA Sport*, "I think that was a good performance under a three-pound penalty. The easing in the ground has probably made a difference to him here. I would now be inclined to keep him going and aim for the Racing Post Trophy as he'll get his ground there."

HAP TRIP UP IN THE AIR Trainer Bill Mott will defer a decision on whether **Hap** (Theatrical {Ire}), second to **Silvano (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) in the G1 Arlington Million Aug. 18, makes the pilgrimage to Australia for the G1 Cox Plate until after his next scheduled start, the GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. at nine furlongs Sept. 16. The Cox Plate is one of three Emirates World Series Championship races to be held Oct. 27, the same day as the Breeders' Cup. Connections would have to pay a late-entry fee of \$29,095 if he is to contest the race. Racing Victoria Manager Greg Nichols is, however, reasonably confident Silvano will participate in the carnival. "We've kept in touch with Silvano's trainer for a couple of years and it finally looks like coming to fruition," Nichols said. "The horse has been very competitive in Singapore and Hong Kong and his form is best at 1 1/4 miles. If he goes on to Hong Kong, he is in a very strong position to take home the \$1 million bonus [as the winner of the Emirates World Series Championship]."

SUNLINE BACK ON TOP Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}), defeated by Piavonic (Aus) (Scenic {Ire}) in her first start of the season, turned the tables on that rival in the G2 Memsie S. at Caulfield in Melbourne yesterday. But the grand mare didn't win as authoritatively as connections may have hoped. Still a little burly, Sunline beat Piavonic and an average field by 1 1/2 lengths, tracking early leader **Desert Sky (Aus)** (Hurricane Sky {Aus}) to the top of the straight before easing outside to draw clear. Piavonic closed to be second on the heavy track, while 100-1 outsider **Rum (Aus)** (Umatilla {NZ}) took third. Sunline will meet a serious rival in G1 Australian Cup winner **Northerly (Aus)** (Serheed) in the G2 Feehan S. Sept. 15 at Moonee Valley; she'll run in the G2 Turnbull S. two weeks later and then attempt a third straight Cox Plate win. After yesterday's win, jockey Greg Childs conceded Sunline had "lost a bit of her sharpness," saying, "She probably can't be as dominant as she's been, but she's so much more relaxed and is taking time to reach her best, which suggests [trainer Trevor McKee's] plan for her to peak on Cox Plate day is spot-on."

Now that it is part of the Emirates World Series, the Grosser Preis von Baden is bound to attract healthy overseas interest. That may make life hard for the domestic trainers who until now have enjoyed a successful run in this prestigious event. Only two foreign raiders managed to grab the glory in the 1990s, including the top-class Pilsudski (Ire), but competition is becoming fiercer. That said, **Sabiango** will be making a bold bid to keep the prize at home this year. Scratched from the G1 Deutsches Derby won by **Boreal** July 1 when the ground was softened by a momentous thunderstorm, he showed the benefit of that policy by taking the G1 Credit Suisse Private Banking Pokal at Cologne Aug. 12, where Boreal was the rallying half-length runner-up. Previously he had found only Anzillero (Ger) too good when second in the WGZ Bank-Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf July 22. Italian Derby hero **Morshdi** mystified connections when a well-beaten eighth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. last time. Previously, he had finished second in the G1 Irish Derby July 1. Michael Jarvis will be hoping that he proves the Ascot form an aberration and returns to his best on this likely sound surface. Sabiango's stable companion **Paolini** also commands respect here as a dual Group 1 winner. Successful in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica in Rome May 13, he followed up with success in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano June 17, beating Ela Athena (GB) by a short head with subsequent Group 1 winner Super Tassa (Ire) four lengths back in third. Andreas Suborics, who rides Sabiango over Paolini, said this week, "It was hard to choose which horse I was going to ride. I eventually went for Sabiango as I love the horse and I discovered him as a two-year-old."
