JIMMY JONES DEAD AT 94

Hall of Fame trainer Horace A. "Jimmy" Jones died yesterday at St. Francis Hospital in Maryville, Missouri, according to the *Associated Press*. He was 94. Jones, who trained horses from 1926 until 1964, won 54 stakes races and saddled seven champion horses. He trained Citation to win the final two legs of the 1948 Triple Crown. For the 1948 Kentucky Derby, Ben Jones was the trainer of record for Citation. The colt won, allowing the elder Jones to tie H. J. Thompson with a record four Derby winners and the younger Jones trained the colt for the remainder of his Triple Crown victories. Jimmy Jones saddled the 1957 and 1958 Kentucky Derby winners Iron Liege and Tim Tam. He was the top trainer in the country five times and he became the first conditioner to earn over \$1 million in purses. Jones and his Hall of Fame father Ben Jones joined Calumet Farm in 1939 and under their leadership, the legendary farm dominated racing for the next decade. During that time, Calumet Farm captured 12 leading owner titles and 14 leading breeder titles.

LA BELLA LUNA

When the gates opened for yesterday's G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh, **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) was still a maiden, but by the finish the two-year-old filly had become trainer Aidan O'Brien's 14th Group 1 winner this season. The win was the Ballydoyle maestro's second consecutive in this event, following last season's success of Sequoyah (Ire). "She's very good and we thought so from the first day and Mick [Kinane] gave her a lovely ride," O'Brien said after the race. "She's in all the right races although she may not run again this season, but I wouldn't rule anything out for the moment." Quarter Moon had only one previous start, a runner-up finish to Saranac Lake in the Aug. 19 G3 Irish National Stud Debutante S., but she started as the favourite yesterday. In the early going, Kinane employed waiting tactics in rear on the favourite. Quarter Moon launched her bid from the two-furlong pole and made good progress under pressure to challenge at the distance. Showing a willing attitude late, the daughter of Sadler's Wells finished with a tremendous flourish to beat photo-finishers **Dress To Thrill (Ire)** (Danehill) and another O'Brien inmate **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat) in the shadows of the post.

MORSHDI WINS

Sheikh Ahmed bin Rashid al Maktoum's homebred Derby Italiano winner **Morshdi (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}) struck a blow for the classic generation with his 1 1/4-length win in yesterday's G1 UAE Grosser Preis von Baden at Baden Baden. He led home a 1-2-3 finish for three-year-olds under a power-packed ride from jockey Philip Robinson. The jockey took the precaution of walking the course beforehand to assess the state of the track and his extra curricular activity proved worthwhile as Morshdi swooped wide late to secure Germany's seasonal highlight ahead of **Boreal (Ger)** (Java Gold) and **Sabiango (Ger)** (Acatenango {Ger}). "We have enjoyed the day as everything has been so well organised," said winning trainer Michael Jarvis. "I asked Philip to walk the track beforehand because I was worried about the soft ground. He assured me it was good racing ground so that was better for us. That was a good performance and I would think we will now target him at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7." Following his Italian success, Morshdi finished a gallant second to Galileo (Ire) in the G1 Irish Derby at The Curragh July 1, but disappointed when eighth in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28. Here, he settled in fifth early as Krombacher (Ger) (Lando {Ger}) led. Gradually shuffled back as the field negotiated the backstretch, Morshdi began to pick up in early stretch. Sabiango took the lead approaching the final quarter mile and was tackled by Paolini (Ger) (Lando {Ger}) and Boreal on the outside. Morshdi, now in full flight, challenged wide and quickened to the front inside the final furlong. His momentum carried him safely clear of his rivals to record his second Group 1 success. The race also served as the fourth leg of the 2001 Emirates World Series. With his win, Morshdi now joins point leaders Captain Steve, Galileo, and Silvano (Ger) with 12 points in the series.

SUCCESSFUL MONMOUTH MEET ENDS

Monmouth Park concluded its record-setting 2001 season yesterday with gains in both attendance and handle. During the 72-day meeting, total handle reached \$67 million. Average daily handle on the live card was \$934,563. With the record Haskell-day crowd of 47,127 leading the way, average daily attendance was 10,757--up 10 percent from 2000. "It was a great summer all around," commented Bob Kulina, vice president of Thoroughbred racing and general manager of Monmouth Park. "Even the weather cooperated. With the purse supplement, we were able to offer an improved racing product and better racing leads directly to better business." J. Willard Thompson was the meet's leading trainer and Eibar Coa was the leading jockey. On closing day, owner Dennis Drazin was honored as the 2001 recipient of the Virgil "Buddy" Raines Distinguished Achievement Award. Drazin has been a leading owner at the New Jersey track for over a decade.

El Corredor's only loss in his last seven starts was a second-place effort behind Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus in the GII Jerome H. last September. Since then, the bay colt won the GI Cigar Mile last November and the GII Pat O'Brien H. Aug. 12. Making just his second start of the year, the heavy favorite sat just off the pacesetter Smile Again (Wild Again) and Budroyale (Cee's Tizzy). He bid three deep on the backstretch to take a slim lead in upper stretch. Performing Magic got his head in front of El Corredor momentarily, but El Corredor battled back and held off Figlio Mio in the final stride to earn a hard-fought victory. "I had to work hard with him today; harder than I thought I would," admitted winning rider Victor Espinoza. "He didn't break that sharp, but not that slow either. So I just took him back a little bit. Then when we turned for home, he started to worry me. Those horses were coming at us and I didn't know if I could hold them off. But then he dug in and got really tough. He stuck his neck out. He was all heart. I was so proud of him. I ride this horse with a lot of confidence and he gave me more today." Trainer Bob Baffert indicated that El Corredor would now be freshened before a start in the Oct. 27 Breeders' Cup Sprint at Belmont Park.

Tenth in his lifetime bow over the Belmont turf last October, Blazing Fury resurfaced with a distant seventh on the Monmouth lawn June 14. He rebounded to score his maiden at 38-1 with blinkers and Lasix added at Belmont on Independence Day and was most recently a late-running second over this course Aug. 3. Testing stakes competition for the first time, the gelding was sent off as the fourth choice in the field of nine. Settled in eighth position for the opening half mile, Blazing Fury launched his bid entering the far turn, came wide for the stretch run and powered clear late to win going away. Proud Man (Manlove), the 19-10 favorite, was never a factor in a fourth-place finish. "I didn't expect him to run like that. That was reaching a little bit today," said a pleasantly surprised winning trainer Jimmy Toner. "This horse has shown a lot of ability, but his mind went the other way earlier in the year and we had to cut him. Lasix might have helped, but not as much as getting his mind back together." Toner indicated that the next start for the winner could come in the 12-furlong GIII Lawrence Realization H. at Belmont Park Oct. 13.

Unsuccessful in two juvenile outings, Independence broke her maiden in her fourth sophomore effort at Sandown in June. She followed up later that month to win the Listed Fern Hill S. at Ascot June 23, but could only manage third in the Listed Oak Tree S. at Goodwood Aug. 2, her most recent. The homebred stepped up in class to contest this event and provided another Irish success for trainer Ed Dunlop, following Lailani (GB)'s G1 Irish Oaks success. Jockey Frankie Dettori quickly took the daughter of Selkirk to the fore and gradually increased her advantage from the quarter-mile marker. Independence was pushed along from the eight pole and was sufficiently clear in the closing stages to allow her jockey to ease down nearing the line. Both Toroca and Danceabout ran on well from the rear, the former gaining the verdict by a head in a photo finish for the minor placings. Philip Freedman of Cliveden Stud told *PA Sport*, "We had the option of running in a Listed race at Sandown on Sunday, but we are delighted that we came here instead. The idea was to run in this race all along, but Ed [Dunlop] was worried about the soft ground and the weather forecast was for more rain last Friday. She will run next in the G2 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket [Oct. 6]."
