## “STARINE” ROLE FOR VELAZQUEZ

It wasn't quite enough to earn him the riding title, but jockey John Velazquez finished a stellar Saratoga meeting with a flourish, becoming the first rider ever to post six wins on a single Saratoga card during yesterday's finale at the Spa. Velazquez had the crowd's attention after taking five of the first eight races on the day and he made the most of the spotlight in the GII Diana H., driving **Starine (Fr)** (Mendocino) through a narrow opening between horses in the stretch in an eye-catching display of race-riding. The gray filly burst through the hole at the eighth pole and kept on running to earn her first graded-stakes score by a widening 5 1/4 lengths. Commenting on his history-making afternoon, Velazquez said, "I'm very proud right now. It was difficult for me at Saratoga last year because I was sitting on the sidelines [with a broken collarbone]. I would say I made up for it this summer. I want to thank all of the owners and trainers who were behind me." Starine, who at one time raced in the claiming ranks in France, won a Listed race in her final start at two and was three times second at that level while going winless in six starts last year. The French-bred filly finally returned to the winner's circle in her last appearance in her native country, capturing a race for apprentice jockeys by six lengths in March. She made her U.S. debut in the May 18 GIII Gallorette H. at Pimlico and was a solid second to the ill-fated License Fee, but suffered through a troubled trip in the June 9 GIII Just a Game Breeders' Cup H. and ran fifth. Freshened after that effort, she returned for a rallying 3/4-length allowance score at Saratoga Aug. 5 and was given the go-ahead for another graded-stakes try. Starine settled in seventh while saving ground all the way into the stretch and, ridden patiently, found just enough running room for her winning move. "We had a perfect trip," Velazquez said. "On the turn, I decided to stay on the rail and the horses in front of me started to bear out a bit. Sometimes you can't get through, but this horse made me look good today." Velazquez finished the meet with 52 wins, three behind Jerry Bailey, who picked up his seventh Saratoga title.

## NUMERO UNO

The top two-year-old of 2000 after his gallant nose victory over Point Given in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull) has been off the radar screen for the majority of this season. The gray was sidelined by ankle problems for half the year, then caused no more than a minor blip when he finally made his return, zig-zagging his way down the Saratoga stretch en route to a runner-up allowance finish July 25. But, adding blinkers for yesterday's GIII Pennsylvania Derby, the Eclipse winner showed up on the Dopp-ler with a handy 1 1/2-length score over **Unbridled Elaine** (Unbridled's Song), with pacesetter **Touch Tone** (Pick Up The Phone) another half-length back in third. "He did it all on his own," jockey Gary Stevens, aboard the champ for the first time, said. "[Trainer Joe Orseno] put the blinkers on him and he showed no signs of wanting to play around. We had some trouble loading, but once he got into the gate, he was very professional." Added Orseno, "My thanks to [owner Frank Stronach] for allowing me to be patient. His concerns were always the best interest of the horse. Now we can look forward to the fall season with a tremendous horse."

**CHAMPION REMATCH** Trainer Aidan O'Brien has reported **Galileo (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) on course for the G1 Ireland The Food Island Irish Champion S. Saturday at Leopardstown. The winner of the G1 Epsom Derby, G1 Irish Derby and G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. July 28 will once again face Godolphin's **Fantastic Light (USA)** (Rahy {USA}), beaten two lengths at Ascot last time. O'Brien commented, "So far, so good." Opposition to the pair is thin on the ground, prompting Coral Eurobet to offer match betting on the race yesterday. They quote the unbeaten Galileo at odds of 4-7 to beat Godolphin's five-year-old, who is available at 5-4. Galileo's stable companions **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon {USA}) and **Ice Dancer (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) may also line up in the 10-furlong contest, according to O'Brien, while Godolphin will run **Give The Slip (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}) to support their challenger.

**LOOKING AHEAD TO HAYDOCK** King **Charlemagne (USA)** (Nureyev {USA}) headed yesterday's 23 entries for the £150,000 Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup Saturday at Haydock, but trainer Aidan O'Brien said that the recent winner of the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest is doubtful for the race. O'Brien still has **Mull of Kintyre (USA)** (Danzig {USA}), **Freud (USA)** (Storm Cat {USA}) and **Minardi (USA)** (Boundary {USA}) entered, and The Tote offer odds of 13-8 for an Aidan O'Brien-trained winner of the race. "Minardi and Mull of Kintyre are the most likely runners," O'Brien told *PA Sport* yesterday. "King Charlemagne won his Group One last time and we'd like to let the others try for theirs. I don't see the six furlongs as a problem for Minardi. When he was sixth to King Charlemagne in France, he did not get the breaks. We've been happy with him since and he's working nicely. Mull of Kintyre has also come forward from his last run behind Fath at Goodwood. As for King Charlemagne, we'll just sit with him for the moment." **Three Points (GB)** (Bering {GB}), **Kier Park (Ire)** (Foxhound {USA}) and **Mount Abu (Ire)** (Foxhound {USA}), second, third and fourth respectively behind King Charlemagne at Deauville Aug. 12, also stood their ground yesterday. **Pipalong (Ire)** (Pips Pride {GB}), successful in heavy ground last year, bids to follow up for Tim Easterby, while John Hammond has last year's G1 Nunthorpe S. winner **Nuclear Debate (USA)** (Geiger Counter {USA}) still engaged.

### ROBINSON IMPRESSED WITH MORSHDI

Jockey Philip Robinson spoke yesterday of his win on **Morshdi (GB)** (Slip Anchor {GB}) in Sunday's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden at Baden Baden. The three-year-old colt beat Boreal (Ger) by 1 1/4 lengths, having been a disappointing eighth behind Galileo (Ire) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 28 previously. Robinson said, "A lot of people knocked him for his King George run, but it was just one of those occasions when everything went wrong. It was a race we totally forget. I don't know if he goes [for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 7] there or not, but he's a very good horse and he's obviously got every chance wherever he goes."

**WEIGHTY CONCERNS**

What would a Melbourne Cup be without controversy? Victoria Racing Club chief handicapper Jim Bowler has sparked fiery debate by giving Godolphin's **Mutafaweq (USA)** (Silver Hawk {USA}) 58.5kg for the A\$4 million G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 6, one less than he was allocated last year, even though he's captured two Group 1 races in the past year. The assignment for Mutafaweq, winner of the G1 Canadian International in Canada last October and the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom in June, will undoubtedly again lead to cries of favourable treatment for the foreigners. Bowler said his assessment was based on international ratings for Mutafaweq. Trainer Bede Murray has ruled out a Caulfield Cup start for triple Group 1 winner **Univeral Prince (Aus)** (Scenic {Ire}) after the runner was assigned 55.5kg, making him the top-weighted four-year-old. Murray disagreed with Universal Prince's weight, saying the horse had been "weighted on what he did against his own age group. He seems to have been weighted on what the handicapper thinks he can do in open company," but Bowler maintained his AJC Derby win by more than three lengths was the staying performance of the year. Twelve-time Group 1 winner **Tie The Knot (Aus)** (Nassipour {USA}), now seven and unsuccessful in two Cup starts with his best form being in Sydney rather than Melbourne, was the highest weighted of the Australasians on 58kg. Universal Prince and Tie The Knot will contest the G2 Craiglee S. (1600m) at Flemington on Saturday, with Murray amending Universal Prince's program to skip the Caulfield Cup to avoid incurring a penalty. Other Northern Hemisphere horses high up in the weights included French galloper **Mirio (Fr)** (Priolo {USA}) (57.5kg); **Persian Punch (Ire)** (Persian Heights {GB}) (57.5kg); 2001 Ascot Gold Cup winner **Royal Rebel (GB)** (USA) (56.5kg); Godolphin runner **Kutub (Ire)** (In the Wings {GB}) (56kg); and the Japan-based **Hot Secret (Jpn)** (Hunting Hawk {Ire}) (55.5kg).

**RECORD MEET ENDS AT THE SPA** Yesterday's closing-day crowd of 27,654 pushed the attendance at the Saratoga meet over the million mark for the first time in the track's history. A total of 1,011,669 racing fans visited the track during the 36-day season, an average of 28,102 per day. Those figures were up 3.4 percent from last year. The on-track handle and total handle also reached record levels, with on-track wagering hitting \$124,683,338, up 5 percent from the 2000 meet; and total wagering growing 3.2 percent to \$553,620,155. Jockey Jerry Bailey took his seventh riding title with a meet-record 55 wins, while Bill Mott led all trainers for the eighth time, saddling 22 winners, eight more than runner-up D. Wayne Lukas.

Making his second start after nearly nine months on the shelf, Macho Uno was sent off the 4-5 choice and lived up to his odds. The Stronach Stable homebred was allowed to settle in fourth as Touch Tone, tracked by Unbridled Elaine, led through moderate fractions. The filly made her move on the far turn, drawing even with Touch Tone and battling him head-and-head as they raced down the stretch, but Macho Uno simply galloped past the pair at the eighth pole and drew off under his own courage. "I never had to ask him," jockey Gary Stevens said. "He had plenty left in the tank." It has not yet been revealed where the winner will go next. While Unbridled Elaine acquitted herself admirably facing colts for the first time, it was a disappointing effort for Touch Tone, who was coming off a game second-place finish behind Point Given in the GI Haskell Invitational H. Aug. 5. The bay was able to set an easy pace, but couldn't hold off the top two. "The Haskell might have taken a bit out of him," jockey Robbie Albarado said. "He had control of the race up until the quarter pole, then he was empty. He pulled up good, but [trainer Ronny Werner] is going to evaluate him."

A stakes winner against fellow state-breds on the dirt in April, Romanceishope made his turf debut vs. restricted company at Hollywood June 23 and added a victory in the Manila S. Off for a month and a half after that effort, the dark bay returned to finish second, a neck behind Marine (Marju {Ire}), as the 6-5 favorite in the Aug. 11 GIII La Jolla H., but was let go at much longer odds trying his luck in a Grade II this time. The California colt was on the bit while racing fifth early, came wide around the turn and launched a bid as they headed down the stretch which carried him past Indygo Shiner and into the winner's circle. Winning jockey Chris McCarron revealed that his pre-race plans changed when jockey Tyler Baze, aboard Dr. Park (Honor Grades), had his saddle slip. "He broke alertly and I thought I was going for the lead...but then I heard Tyler shouting, 'I lost my saddle,' and I had to ease back a bit. But it turned out fine--I had a good trip and my horse ran his race. He's very honest, very consistent--he has become more effective as he has matured." Baze managed to stay aboard his mount, but finished last, 14 lengths behind the next-to-last horse. "I had no control," he said. "That's happened to me before, but never in a race like this."

When I tell you that Sadler's Wells' latest collection of juveniles contains 13 youngsters out of Shirley Heights mares and another eight out of mares by Shirley Heights' son Darshaan, you will appreciate that crossing the perennial champion sire with mares from the Mill Reef line has become one of the most popular "nicks" in European breeding.

It goes without saying that the popularity of this cross is based on some exceptionally good results, dating all the way back to Sadler's Wells' first crop. His very first stakes winner, In The Wings, is out of a Shirley Heights mare and that crop also contained Myth To Reality, a triple Listed winner out of a Mill Reef mare.

Encouraged by these early successes, breeders have sent Sadler's Wells plenty of mares from the Mill Reef line, with consistently good results. Side Of Paradise won the Prix La Camargo early this year to become his eighth stakes winner out of a Mill Reef mare; Inchiri, first in the recent Galtres S., became his ninth stakes winner out of a Shirley Heights mare, with six of the nine having scored at Group level. And when Quarter Moon won the G1 Moyglare Stud S., she became the eighth stakes winner to emerge from the first 24 foals sired by Sadler's Wells from daughters of Darshaan.

With eight of the 24 foals out of Darshaan mares still inexperienced juveniles, chances are that Sadler's Wells' figures will become even more spectacular over the next 12 months. His record with mares by his old foe, who beat Sadler's Wells into second place in the

1984 Prix du Jockey-Club, already makes sensational reading.

Group 1 winners Ebadiyla, Greek Dance and Quarter Moon head a team which also includes the Group 2 winners Crimson Tide and Milan and the Group 1-placed Election Day. Milan currently ranks among the favorites for the St Leger, the last of the season's English classics, so he may soon become the fourth Group 1 winner for the Sadler's Wells--Darshaan nick.

Breeding high-class winners isn't normally this simple, so why does Sadler's Wells work so well with the Mill Reef line? Some would suggest that the success owes a lot to the fact that the eight stakes winners out of Mill Reef mares are inbred 4x4 to the outstanding Lalun, through her sons Never Bend and Bold Reason. I am rather sceptical of this explanation because the stakes winners out of Mill Reef mares are, as a group, markedly inferior to those out of Shirley Heights or Darshaan mares, where Lalun's influence isn't as strong.

The truth is that mares by Mill Reef, Shirley Heights and Darshaan have done very well with several stallions from the Northern Dancer, not just with Sadler's Wells. Because the trio are strong influences for stamina--they all won the Derby in England or France--their daughters appreciate the element of speed possessed by so many members of the Northern Dancer male line.

Quarter Moon's seven-furlong efforts leave one wondering what she might achieve once she gets the chance to tackle longer distances--her family has recently produced two fillies which developed into leading middle-distance performers after they had gained their first Group success over seven furlongs at two. The first, Last Second, won the Nassau S. a few years before it attained Group 1 status; the second, Alborada, won the G1 Dubai Champion S. in 1998 and 1999.

Alborada is out of Alouette, a stakes-winning sister to Quarter Moon's dam, Jude. Having cost IR150,000gns yearling, Jude proved a big disappointment on the track, but her powerful bloodlines ensured that there was still plenty of demand for her at Tattersalls' 1997 December Sales, where she was bought for 92,000gns. She has visited Sadler's Wells in each of her first four

seasons at stud and her owners, Premier Bloodstock, are in the enviable position of having yearling and weanling sisters to Quarter Moon.
